commune 3656 # homileo {hom-il-eh'-o}; from 3658; to be in company with, i.e. (by implication) to converse: -- {commune}, talk. [q]

communication 3657 # homilia {hom-il-ee'-ah}; from 3658; companionship ("homily"), i.e. (by implication) intercourse: -- {communication}. [q]

company 3658 # homilos {hom'-il-os}; from the base of 3674 and a derivative of the alternate of 138 (meaning a crowd); association together, i.e. a multitude: -- {company}. [q]

talk 3656 # homileo {hom-il-eh'-o}; from 3658; to be in company with, i.e. (by implication) to converse: -- commune, {talk}. [q]

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
