all 3833 # panoplia {pan-op-lee' -ah}; from a compound of 3956 and 3696; full armor ("panoply"): -- {all} (whole) armour. [q]

arm 3695 # hoplizo {hop-lid' -zo}; from 3696; to equip (with weapons [middle voice and figuratively]): -- {arm} self. [q]

armour 3696 # hoplon {hop' -lon}; probably from a primary hepo (to be busy about); an implement or utensil or tool (literally or figuratively, especially offensive for war): -- {armour}, instrument, weapon. [q]

armour 3833 # panoplia {pan-op-lee' -ah}; from a compound of 3956 and 3696; full armor ("panoply"): -- all (whole) {armour}. [q]
