

feeble 3886 # Expanded Dictionary Study

feeble 3886 # paraluo {par-al-oo'-o}; from 3844 and 3089; to loosen beside, i.e. relax (perfect passive participle, paralyzed or enfeebled): -- {feeble}, sick of the (taken with) palsy. [q]

had 3885 # paralutikos {par-al-oo-tee-kos'}; from a derivative of 3886; as if dissolved, i.e. "paralytic": -- that {had} (sick of) the palsy. [q]

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
