habitation 4633 # skene {skay-nay'}; apparently akin to 4632 and 4639; a tent or cloth hut (literally or figuratively): -- {habitation}, tabernacle. [q]

overshadow 1982 # episkiāzo {ep-ee-skee-ad'-zo}; from 1909 and a derivative of 4639; to cast a shade upon, i.e. (by analogy) to envelope in a haze of brilliancy; figuratively, to invest with preternatural influence: -- {overshadow}. [q]

shadow 0644 # aposkiasma {ap-os-kee'-as-mah}; from a compound of 575 and a derivative of 4639; a shading off, i.e. obsuration: -- {shadow}. [q]

shadow 2683 # kataskiāzo {kat-as-kee-ad'-zo}; from 2596 and a derivative of 4639; to overshadow, i.e. cover: -- {shadow}. [q]
