

darkness 4655 # Expanded Dictionary Study

darkness 4655 # skotos {skot'-os}; from the base of 4639; shadiness, i.e. obscurity (literally or figuratively): -- {darkness}. [q]

habitation 4633 # skene {skay-nay'}; apparently akin to 4632 and 4639; a tent or cloth hut (literally or figuratively): -- {habitation}, tabernacle. [q]

overshadow 1982 # episki azo {ep-ee-skee-ad'-zo}; from 1909 and a derivative of 4639; to cast a shade upon, i.e. (by analogy) to envelope in a haze of brilliancy; figuratively, to invest with preternatural influence: -- {overshadow}. [q]

shadow 0644 # aposkiasma {ap-os-kee'-as-mah}; from a compound of 575 and a derivative of 4639; a shading off, i.e. obsuration: -- {shadow}. [q]

shadow 2683 # kataski azo {kat-as-kee-ad'-zo}; from 2596 and a derivative of 4639; to overshadow, i.e. cover: -- {shadow}. [q]

shadow 4639 # skia {skee'-ah}; apparently a primary word; "shade" or a shadow (literally or figuratively [darkness of error or an adumbration]): -- {shadow}. [q]

tabernacle 4633 # skene {skay-nay'}; apparently akin to 4632 and 4639; a tent or cloth hut (literally or figuratively): -- habitation, {tabernacle}. [q]

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
