

neck 5137 # Expanded Dictionary Study

neck 5137 # trachelos {trakh'-ay-los}; probably from 5143 (through the idea of mobility); the throat (neck), i.e. (figuratively) life: -- {neck}. [q]

opened 5136 # trachelizo {trakh-ay-lid'-zo}; from 5137; to seize by the throat or neck, i.e. to expose the gullet of a victim for killing (generally, to lay bare): -- {opened}. [q]

stiffnecked 4644 # sklerotrachelos {sklay-rot-rakh'-ay-los}; from 4642 and 5137; hardnaped, i.e. (figuratively) obstinate: -- {stiffnecked}. [q]

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
