forbear 5339 # pheidomai {fi'-dom-ahee}; of uncertain affinity; to be chary of, i.e. (subjectively) to abstain or (objectively) to treat leniently: -- {forbear}, spare. [q]

neglecting 0857 # apheidia {af-i-dee'-ah}; from a compound of 1 (as a negative particle) and 5339; unsparingness, i.e. austerity (ascetism): -- {neglecting}. [q]

spare 5339 # pheidomai {fi'-dom-ahee}; of uncertain affinity; to be chary of, i.e. (subjectively) to abstain or (objectively) to treat leniently: -- forbear, {spare}. [q]

sparingly 5340 # pheidomenos {fi-dom-en'-oce}; adverb from participle of 5339; abstemiously, i.e. stingily: -- {sparingly}. [q]

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
