murder 5407 # phoneuo {fon-yoo'-o}; from 5406; to be a murderer (of): -- kill, do {murder}, slay. [q]

murderer 0443 # anthropoktonos {anth-ro-pok-ton'-os}; from 444 and kteine (to kill); a manslayer: -- {murderer}. Compare 5406. [q]

murderer 4607 # sikarios {sik-ar'-ee-os}; of Latin origin; a dagger-man or assassin; a freebooter (Jewish fanatic outlawed by the Romans): -- {murderer}. Compare 5406. [q]

murderer 5406 # phoneus {fon-yooce'}; from 5408; a murderer (always of criminal [or at least intentional] homicide; which 443 does not necessarily imply; while 4607 is a special term for a public bandit): -- {murderer}. [q]

slay 5407 # phoneuo {fon-yoo'-o}; from 5406; to be a murderer (of): -- kill, do murder, {slay}. [q]

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
