

anoint 1472 # Expanded Dictionary Study

anoint 1472 # egchrio {eng-khree'-o}; from 1722 and 5548; to rub in (oil), i.e. besmear: -- {anoint}. [ql]

anoint 2025 # epichrio {ep-ee-khree'-o}; from 1909 and 5548; to smear over: -- {anoint}. [ql]

anoint 5548 # chrio {khree'-o}; probably akin to 5530 through the idea of contact; to smear or rub with oil, i.e. (by implication) to consecrate to an office or religious service: -- {anoint}. [ql]

anointing 5545 # chrisma {khris'-mah}; from 5548; an unguent or smearing, i.e. (figuratively) the special endowment ("chrism") of the Holy Spirit: -- {anointing}, unction. [ql]

Christ 5547 # Christos {khris-tos'}; from 5548; anointed, i.e. the Messiah, an epithet of Jesus: -- {Christ}. [ql]

unction 5545 # chrisma {khris'-mah}; from 5548; an unguent or smearing, i.e. (figuratively) the special endowment ("chrism") of the Holy Spirit: -- anointing, {unction}. [ql]

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
