Compare 5568 # psalmos {psal-mos'}; from 5567; a set piece of music, i.e. a sacred ode (accompanied with the voice, harp or other instrument; a "psalm"); collectively, the book of the Psalms: -- psalm. {Compare} 5603. [q]

harper 2790 # kitharoidos {ki-th-ar-o'-dos}; from 2788 and a derivative of the same as 5603; a lyre-singer(-player), i.e. harpist: -- {harper}. [q]

psalm 5568 # psalmos {psal-mos'}; from 5567; a set piece of music, i.e. a sacred ode (accompanied with the voice, harp or other instrument; a "psalm"); collectively, the book of the Psalms: -- {psalm}. Compare 5603. [q]

song 5603 # oide {o-day'}; from 103; a chant or "ode" (the general term for any words sung; while 5215 denotes especially a religious metrical composition, and 5568 still more specifically, a Hebrew cantillation): -- {song}. [q]
