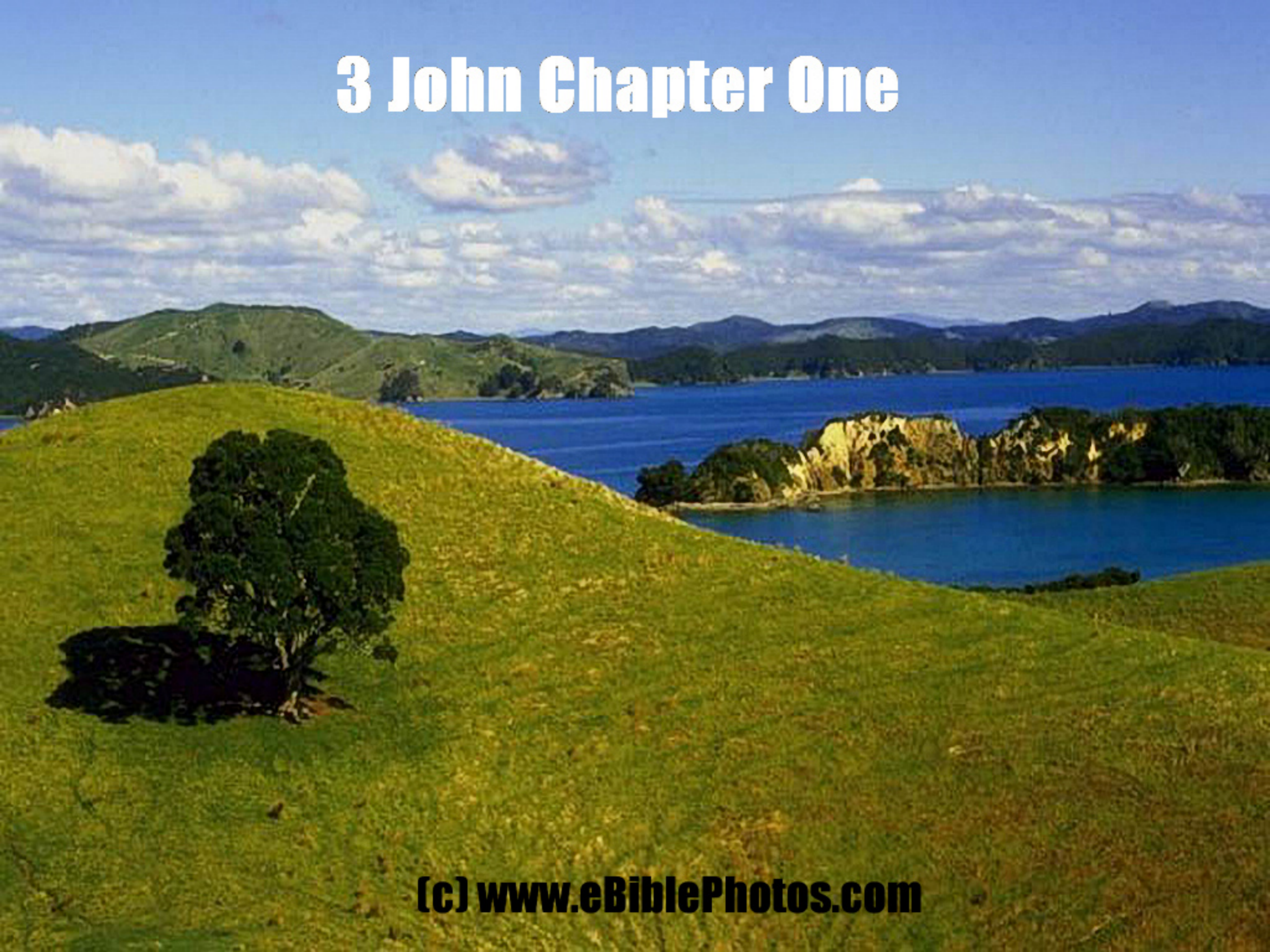



3 John Chapter One





**3Jo 01:01 The elder unto the
wellbeloved Gaius, whom I love in the
truth.**

3Jo 01:02 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.



**3Jo 01:03 For I rejoiced greatly, when
the brethren came and testified of the
truth that is in thee, even as thou
walkest in the truth.**
