- 13_1CH_04_10 And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep [me] from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested.
- 13_1CH_04_11 And Chelub the brother of Shuah begat Mehir, which [was] the father of Eshton.

- 13_1CH_04_33 And all their villages that [were] round about the same cities, unto Baal. These [were] their habitations, and their genealogy.

- 13_1CH_05_06 Beerah his son, whom Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria carried away [captive]: he [was] prince of the Reubenites.
- 13_1CH_05_07 And his brethren by their families, when the genealogy of their generations was reckoned, [were] the chief, Jeiel, and Zechariah,
- 13_1CH_05_08 And Bela the son of Azaz, the son of Shema, the son of Joel, who dwelt in Aroer, even unto Nebo and Baalmeon:
- 13_1CH_05_09 And eastward he inhabited unto the entering in of the wilderness from the river Euphrates: because their cattle were multiplied in the land of Gilead.
- 13_1CH_05_10 And in the days of Saul they made war with the Hagarites, who fell by their hand: and they dwelt in their tents throughout all the east [land] of Gilead.
- 13_1CH_05_11 And the children of Gad dwelt over against them, in the land of Bashan unto Salcah:
- 13_1CH_05_12 Joel the chief, and Shapham the next, and Jaanai, and Shaphat in Bashan.
- 13_1CH_05_13 And their brethren of the house of their fathers [were], Michael, and Meshullam, and Sheba, and Jorai, and Jachan, and Zia, and Heber, seven.
- 13_1CH_05_14 These [are] the children of Abihail the son of Huri, the son of Jaroah, the son of Gilead, the son of Michael, the son of Jeshishai, the son of Jahdo, the son of Buz;
- 13_1CH_05_15 Ahi the son of Abdiel, the son of Guni, chief of the house of their fathers.
- 13_1CH_05_16 And they dwelt in Gilead in Bashan, and in her towns, and in all the suburbs of Sharon, upon their borders.
- 13_1CH_05_17 All these were reckoned by genealogies in the days of Jotham king of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam king of Israel.
- 13_1CH_05_18 The sons of Reuben, and the Gadites, and half the tribe of Manasseh, of valiant men, men able to bear buckler and sword, and to shoot with bow, and skilful in war, [were] four and forty thousand seven hundred and threescore, that went out to the war.

- 13_1CH_09_28 And [certain] of them had the charge of the ministering vessels, that they should bring them in and out by tale.
- 13_1CH_09_29 [Some] of them also [were] appointed to oversee the vessels and all the instruments of the sanctuary, and the fine flour, and the wine, and the oil, and the frankincense, and the spices.
- 13_1CH_09_30 And [some] of the sons of the priests made the ointment of the spices.

- 13_1CH_09_43 And Moza begat Binea; and Rephaiah his son, Eleasah his son, Azel his son.
- 13_1CH_09_44 And Azel had six sons, whose names [are] these, Azrikam, Bocheru, and Ishmael, and Sheariah, and

- 13_1CH_10_01 Now the Philistines fought against Israel; and the men of Israel fled from before the Philistines, and fell down slain in mount Gilboa.

- 13_1CH_10_10 And they put his armour in the house of their gods, and fastened his head in the temple of Dagon.
- 13_1CH_10_11 And when all Jabeshgilead heard all that the Philistines had done to Saul,

- 13_1CH_11_01 Then all Israel gathered themselves to David unto Hebron, saying, Behold, we [are] thy bone and thy flesh.
- 13_1CH_11_02 And moreover in time past, even when Saul was king, thou [wast] he that leddest out and broughtest in Israel: and the LORD thy God said unto thee, Thou shalt feed my people Israel, and thou shalt be ruler over my people Israel.
- 13_1CH_11_03 Therefore came all the elders of Israel to the king to Hebron; and David made a covenant with them in Hebron before the LORD; and they anointed David king over Israel, according to the word of the LORD by Samuel.
- 13_1CH_11_04 And David and all Israel went to Jerusalem, which [is] Jebus; where the Jebusites [were], the inhabitants of the land.
- 13_1CH_11_05 And the inhabitants of Jebus said to David, Thou shalt not come hither. Nevertheless David took the castle of Zion, which [is] the city of David.
- 13_1CH_11_06 And David said, Whosoever smiteth the Jebusites first shall be chief and captain. So Joab the son of Zeruiah went first up, and was chief.

- 13 1CH 11 08 And he built the city round about, even from Millo round about: and Joab repaired the rest of the city.

- 13_1CH_11_13 He was with David at Pasdammim, and there the Philistines were gathered together to battle, where was a parcel of ground full of barley; and the people fled from before the Philistines.
- 13_1CH_11_14 And they set themselves in the midst of [that] parcel, and delivered it, and slew the Philistines; and the LORD saved [them] by a great deliverance.
- 13_1CH_11_15 Now three of the thirty captains went down to the rock to David, into the cave of Adullam; and the host of the Philistines encamped in the valley of Rephaim.
- 13_1CH_11_16 And David [was] then in the hold, and the Philistines' garrison [was] then at Bethlehem.
- 13_1CH_11_17 And David longed, and said, Oh that one would give me drink of the water of the well of Bethlehem, that [is] at the gate!
- 13_1CH_11_18 And the three brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that [was] by the gate, and took [it], and brought [it] to David: but David would not drink [of] it, but poured it out to the LORD,
- 13_1CH_11_19 And said, My God forbid it me, that I should do this thing: shall I drink the blood of these men that have put their lives in jeopardy? for with [the jeopardy of] their lives they brought it. Therefore he would not drink it. These things did these three mightiest.

- 13_1CH_12_01 Now these [are] they that came to David to Ziklag, while he yet kept himself close because of Saul the son of Kish: and they [were] among the mighty men, helpers of the war.
- 13_1CH_12_02 [They were] armed with bows, and could use both the right hand and the left in [hurling] stones and [shooting] arrows out of a bow, [even] of Saul's brethren of Benjamin.

- 13 1CH 12 06 Elkanah, and Jesiah, and Azareel, and Joezer, and Jashobeam, the Korhites,
- 13 1CH 12 07 And Joelah, and Zebadiah, the sons of Jeroham of Gedor.
- 13_1CH_12_08 And of the Gadites there separated themselves unto David into the hold to the wilderness men of might, [and] men of war [fit] for the battle, that could handle shield and buckler, whose faces [were like] the faces of lions, and [were] as swift as the roes upon the mountains;
- 13_1CH_12_09 Ezer the first, Obadiah the second, Eliab the third,
- 13_1CH_12_10 Mishmannah the fourth, Jeremiah the fifth,

- 13_1CH_12_15 These [are] they that went over Jordan in the first month, when it had overflown all his banks; and they put to flight all [them] of the valleys, [both] toward the east, and toward the west.
- 13_1CH_12_16 And there came of the children of Benjamin and Judah to the hold unto David.
- 13_1CH_12_17 And David went out to meet them, and answered and said unto them, If ye be come peaceably unto me to help me, mine heart shall be knit unto you: but if [ye be come] to betray me to mine enemies, seeing [there is] no wrong in mine hands, the God of our fathers look [thereon], and rebuke [it].

- 13_1CH_12_20 As he went to Ziklag, there fell to him of Manasseh, Adnah, and Jozabad, and Jediael, and Michael, and Jozabad, and Elihu, and Zilthai, captains of the thousands that [were] of Manasseh.
- 13_1CH_12_21 And they helped David against the band [of the rovers]: for they [were] all mighty men of valour, and were captains in the host.
- 13_1CH_12_22 For at [that] time day by day there came to David to help him, until [it was] a great host, like the host of God.
- 13_1CH_12_23 And these [are] the numbers of the bands [that were] ready armed to the war, [and] came to David to Hebron, to turn the kingdom of Saul to him, according to the word of the LORD.
- 13_1CH_12_24 The children of Judah that bare shield and spear [were] six thousand and eight hundred, ready armed
- 13_1CH_12_25 Of the children of Simeon, mighty men of valour for the war, seven thousand and one hundred.
- 13_1CH_12_26 Of the children of Levi four thousand and six hundred.

- 13_1CH_12_27 And Jehoiada [was] the leader of the Aaronites, and with him [were] three thousand and seven hundred;

- 13_1CH_12_33 Of Zebulun, such as went forth to battle, expert in war, with all instruments of war, fifty thousand, which could keep rank: [they were] not of double heart.
- 13 1CH 12 34 And of Naphtali a thousand captains, and with them with shield and spear thirty and seven thousand.
- 13_1CH_12_35 And of the Danites expert in war twenty and eight thousand and six hundred.
- 13_1CH_12_36 And of Asher, such as went forth to battle, expert in war, forty thousand.
- 13_1CH_12_37 And on the other side of Jordan, of the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and of the half tribe of Manasseh, with all manner of instruments of war for the battle, an hundred and twenty thousand.
- 13_1CH_12_38 All these men of war, that could keep rank, came with a perfect heart to Hebron, to make David king over all Israel: and all the rest also of Israel [were] of one heart to make David king.
- 13 1CH 12 39 And there they were with David three days, eating and drinking: for their brethren had prepared for
- 13_1CH_12_40 Moreover they that were nigh them, [even] unto Issachar and Zebulun and Naphtali, brought bread on asses, and on camels, and on mules, and on oxen, [and] meat, meal, cakes of figs, and bunches of raisins, and wine, and oil, and oxen, and sheep abundantly: for [there was] joy in Israel.

- 13_1CH_13_09 And when they came unto the threshingfloor of Chidon, Uzza put forth his hand to hold the ark; for the oxen stumbled.
- 13_1CH_13_10 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzza, and he smote him, because he put his hand to the ark: and there he died before God.
- 13_1CH_13_11 And David was displeased, because the LORD had made a breach upon Uzza: wherefore that place is called Perezuzza to this day.

- 13_1CH_15_09 Of the sons of Hebron; Eliel the chief, and his brethren fourscore:
- 13_1CH_15_10 Of the sons of Uzziel; Amminadab the chief, and his brethren an hundred and twelve.
- 13_1CH_15_11 And David called for Zadok and Abiathar the priests, and for the Levites, for Uriel, Asaiah, and Joel, Shemaiah, and Eliel, and Amminadab,
- 13_1CH_15_12 And said unto them, Ye [are] the chief of the fathers of the Levites: sanctify yourselves, [both] ye and your brethren, that ye may bring up the ark of the LORD God of Israel unto [the place that] I have prepared for it.
- 13_1CH_15_13 For because ye [did it] not at the first, the LORD our God made a breach upon us, for that we sought him not after the due order.
- 13 1CH 15 14 So the priests and the Levites sanctified themselves to bring up the ark of the LORD God of Israel.
- 13_1CH_15_15 And the children of the Levites bare the ark of God upon their shoulders with the staves thereon, as Moses commanded according to the word of the LORD.
- 13_1CH_15_16 And David spake to the chief of the Levites to appoint their brethren [to be] the singers with instruments of music, psalteries and harps and cymbals, sounding, by lifting up the voice with joy.
- 13_1CH_15_17 So the Levites appointed Heman the son of Joel; and of his brethren, Asaph the son of Berechiah; and of the sons of Merari their brethren, Ethan the son of Kushaiah;
- 13_1CH_15_18 And with them their brethren of the second [degree], Zechariah, Ben, and Jaaziel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehiel, and Unni, Eliab, and Benaiah, and Maaseiah, and Mattithiah, and Elipheleh, and Mikneiah, and Obededom, and Jeiel, the porters.
- 13_1CH_15_19 So the singers, Heman, Asaph, and Ethan, [were appointed] to sound with cymbals of brass;
- 13_1CH_15_20 And Zechariah, and Aziel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehiel, and Unni, and Eliab, and Maaseiah, and Benaiah, with psalteries on Alamoth;
- 13_1CH_15_21 And Mattithiah, and Elipheleh, and Mikneiah, and Obededom, and Jeiel, and Azaziah, with harps on the Sheminith to excel.
- 13_1CH_15_22 And Chenaniah, chief of the Levites, [was] for song: he instructed about the song, because he [was] skilful.
- 13 1CH 15 23 And Berechiah and Elkanah [were] doorkeepers for the ark.
- 13_1CH_15_24 And Shebaniah, and Jehoshaphat, and Nethaneel, and Amasai, and Zechariah, and Benaiah, and Eliezer, the priests, did blow with the trumpets before the ark of God: and Obededom and Jehiah [were] doorkeepers for the ark.
- 13_1CH_15_25 So David, and the elders of Israel, and the captains over thousands, went to bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the house of Obededom with joy.
- 13_1CH_15_26 And it came to pass, when God helped the Levites that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, that they offered seven bullocks and seven rams.
- 13_1CH_15_27 And David [was] clothed with a robe of fine linen, and all the Levites that bare the ark, and the singers, and Chenaniah the master of the song with the singers: David also [had] upon him an ephod of linen.
- 13_1CH_15_28 Thus all Israel brought up the ark of the covenant of the LORD with shouting, and with sound of the cornet, and with trumpets, and with cymbals, making a noise with psalteries and harps.
- 13_1CH_15_29 And it came to pass, [as] the ark of the covenant of the LORD came to the city of David, that Michal the daughter of Saul looking out at a window saw king David dancing and playing: and she despised him in her heart.



- 13_1CH_16_01 So they brought the ark of God, and set it in the midst of the tent that David had pitched for it: and they offered burnt sacrifices and peace offerings before God.
- 13_1CH_16_02 And when David had made an end of offering the burnt offerings and the peace offerings, he blessed the people in the name of the LORD.
- 13_1CH_16_03 And he dealt to every one of Israel, both man and woman, to every one a loaf of bread, and a good piece of flesh, and a flagon [of wine].
- 13_1CH_16_04 And he appointed [certain] of the Levites to minister before the ark of the LORD, and to record, and to thank and praise the LORD God of Israel:
- 13_1CH_16_05 Asaph the chief, and next to him Zechariah, Jeiel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehiel, and Mattithiah, and Eliab, and Benaiah, and Obededom: and Jeiel with psalteries and with harps; but Asaph made a sound with cymbals;
- 13_1CH_16_06 Benaiah also and Jahaziel the priests with trumpets continually before the ark of the covenant of God.
- 13_1CH_16_07 Then on that day David delivered first [this psalm] to thank the LORD into the hand of Asaph and his brethren.
- 13_1CH_16_08 Give thanks unto the LORD, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the people.
- 13_1CH_16_09 Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him, talk ye of all his wondrous works.
- 13_1CH_16_10 Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD.
- 13_1CH_16_11 Seek the LORD and his strength, seek his face continually.
- 13 1CH 16 12 Remember his marvellous works that he hath done, his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth;
- 13_1CH_16_13 O ye seed of Israel his servant, ye children of Jacob, his chosen ones.
- 13_1CH_16_14 He [is] the LORD our God; his judgments [are] in all the earth.
- 13_1CH_16_15 Be ye mindful always of his covenant; the word [which] he commanded to a thousand generations;
- 13_1CH_16_16 [Even of the covenant] which he made with Abraham, and of his oath unto Isaac;
- 13_1CH_16_17 And hath confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, [and] to Israel [for] an everlasting covenant,
- 13_1CH_16_18 Saying, Unto thee will I give the land of Canaan, the lot of your inheritance;
- 13_1CH_16_19 When ye were but few, even a few, and strangers in it.
- 13_1CH_16_20 And [when] they went from nation to nation, and from [one] kingdom to another people;
- 13_1CH_16_21 He suffered no man to do them wrong: yea, he reproved kings for their sakes,
- 13_1CH_16_22 [Saying], Touch not mine anointed, and do my prophets no harm.
- 13_1CH_16_23 Sing unto the LORD, all the earth; show forth from day to day his salvation.
- 13_1CH_16_24 Declare his glory among the heathen; his marvellous works among all nations.
- 13_1CH_16_25 For great [is] the LORD, and greatly to be praised: he also [is] to be feared above all gods.
- 13_1CH_16_26 For all the gods of the people [are] idols: but the LORD made the heavens.
- 13_1CH_16_27 Glory and honour [are] in his presence; strength and gladness [are] in his place.
- 13_1CH_16_28 Give unto the LORD, ye kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD glory and strength.
- 13_1CH_16_29 Give unto the LORD the glory [due] unto his name: bring an offering, and come before him: worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.
- 13_1CH_16_30 Fear before him, all the earth: the world also shall be stable, that it be not moved.
- 13_1CH_16_31 Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice: and let [men] say among the nations, The LORD reigneth.
- 13_1CH_16_32 Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof: let the fields rejoice, and all that [is] therein.
- 13_1CH_16_33 Then shall the trees of the wood sing out at the presence of the LORD, because he cometh to judge the earth.
- 13_1CH_16_34 O give thanks unto the LORD; for [he is] good; for his mercy [endureth] for ever.
- 13_1CH_16_35 And say ye, Save us, O God of our salvation, and gather us together, and deliver us from the heathen, that we may give thanks to thy holy name, [and] glory in thy praise.
- 13_1CH_16_36 Blessed [be] the LORD God of Israel for ever and ever. And all the people said, Amen, and praised the LORD.
- 13_1CH_16_37 So he left there before the ark of the covenant of the LORD Asaph and his brethren, to minister before the ark continually, as every day's work required:
- 13_1CH_16_38 And Obededom with their brethren, threescore and eight; Obededom also the son of Jeduthun and Hosah [to be] porters:
- 13_1CH_16_39 And Zadok the priest, and his brethren the priests, before the tabernacle of the LORD in the high place that [was] at Gibeon,
- 13_1CH_16_40 To offer burnt offerings unto the LORD upon the altar of the burnt offering continually morning and
- evening, and [to do] according to all that is written in the law of the LORD, which he commanded Israel;

 13 1CH 16 41 And with them Heman and Jeduthun, and the rest that were chosen, who were expressed by name, to
- give thanks to the LORD, because his mercy [endureth] for ever;

 13 1CH 16 42 And with them Heman and Jeduthun with trumpets and cymbals for those that should make a sound,
- and with musical instruments of God. And the sons of Jeduthun [were] porters.

13 1CH 16 43 And all the people departed every man to his house: and David returned to bless his house.



- 13_1CH_17_01 Now it came to pass, as David sat in his house, that David said to Nathan the prophet, Lo, I dwell in an house of cedars, but the ark of the covenant of the LORD [remaineth] under curtains.
- 13_1CH_17_02 Then Nathan said unto David, Do all that [is] in thine heart; for God [is] with thee.
- 13 1CH 17 03 And it came to pass the same night, that the word of God came to Nathan, saying,
- 13_1CH_17_04 Go and tell David my servant, Thus saith the LORD, Thou shalt not build me an house to dwell in:
- 13_1CH_17_05 For I have not dwelt in an house since the day that I brought up Israel unto this day; but have gone from tent to tent, and from [one] tabernacle [to another].
- 13_1CH_17_06 Wheresoever I have walked with all Israel, spake I a word to any of the judges of Israel, whom I commanded to feed my people, saying, Why have ye not built me an house of cedars?
- 13_1CH_17_07 Now therefore thus shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, [even] from following the sheep, that thou shouldest be ruler over my people Israel:
- 13_1CH_17_08 And I have been with thee whithersoever thou hast walked, and have cut off all thine enemies from before thee, and have made thee a name like the name of the great men that [are] in the earth.
- 13_1CH_17_09 Also I will ordain a place for my people Israel, and will plant them, and they shall dwell in their place, and shall be moved no more; neither shall the children of wickedness waste them any more, as at the beginning,
- 13_1CH_17_10 And since the time that I commanded judges [to be] over my people Israel. Moreover I will subdue all thine enemies. Furthermore I tell thee that the LORD will build thee an house.
- 13_1CH_17_11 And it shall come to pass, when thy days be expired that thou must go [to be] with thy fathers, that I will raise up thy seed after thee, which shall be of thy sons; and I will establish his kingdom.
- 13_1CH_17_12 He shall build me an house, and I will stablish his throne for ever.
- 13_1CH_17_13 I will be his father, and he shall be my son: and I will not take my mercy away from him, as I took [it] from [him] that was before thee:
- 13_1CH_17_14 But I will settle him in mine house and in my kingdom for ever: and his throne shall be established for evermore.
- 13_1CH_17_15 According to all these words, and according to all this vision, so did Nathan speak unto David.
- 13_1CH_17_16 And David the king came and sat before the LORD, and said, Who [am] I, O LORD God, and what [is] mine house, that thou hast brought me hitherto?
- 13_1CH_17_17 And [yet] this was a small thing in thine eyes, O God; for thou hast [also] spoken of thy servant's house for a great while to come, and hast regarded me according to the estate of a man of high degree, O LORD God.
- 13 1CH 17 18 What can David [speak] more to thee for the honour of thy servant? for thou knowest thy servant.
- 13_1CH_17_19 O LORD, for thy servant's sake, and according to thine own heart, hast thou done all this greatness, in making known all [these] great things.
- 13_1CH_17_20 O LORD, [there is] none like thee, neither [is there any] God beside thee, according to all that we have heard with our ears.
- 13_1CH_17_21 And what one nation in the earth [is] like thy people Israel, whom God went to redeem [to be] his own people, to make thee a name of greatness and terribleness, by driving out nations from before thy people, whom thou hast redeemed out of Egypt?
- 13_1CH_17_22 For thy people Israel didst thou make thine own people for ever; and thou, LORD, becamest their God.
- 13_1CH_17_23 Therefore now, LORD, let the thing that thou hast spoken concerning thy servant and concerning his house be established for ever, and do as thou hast said.
- 13_1CH_17_24 Let it even be established, that thy name may be magnified for ever, saying, The LORD of hosts [is] the God of Israel, [even] a God to Israel: and [let] the house of David thy servant [be] established before thee.
- 13_1CH_17_25 For thou, O my God, hast told thy servant that thou wilt build him an house: therefore thy servant hath found [in his heart] to pray before thee.
- 13 1CH 17 26 And now, LORD, thou art God, and hast promised this goodness unto thy servant:
- 13_1CH_17_27 Now therefore let it please thee to bless the house of thy servant, that it may be before thee for ever: for thou blessest, O LORD, and [it shall be] blessed for ever.



- 13_1CH_18_01 Now after this it came to pass, that David smote the Philistines, and subdued them, and took Gath and her towns out of the hand of the Philistines.
- 13_1CH_18_02 And he smote Moab; and the Moabites became David's servants, [and] brought gifts.
- 13_1CH_18_03 And David smote Hadarezer king of Zobah unto Hamath, as he went to stablish his dominion by the river Euphrates.
- 13_1CH_18_04 And David took from him a thousand chariots, and seven thousand horsemen, and twenty thousand footmen: David also hocked all the chariot [horses], but reserved of them an hundred chariots.
- 13_1CH_18_05 And when the Syrians of Damascus came to help Hadarezer king of Zobah, David slew of the Syrians two and twenty thousand men.
- 13_1CH_18_06 Then David put [garrisons] in Syriadamascus; and the Syrians became David's servants, [and] brought gifts. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.
- 13_1CH_18_07 And David took the shields of gold that were on the servants of Hadarezer, and brought them to Jerusalem.
- 13_1CH_18_08 Likewise from Tibhath, and from Chun, cities of Hadarezer, brought David very much brass, wherewith Solomon made the brazen sea, and the pillars, and the vessels of brass.
- 13 1CH 18 09 Now when Tou king of Hamath heard how David had smitten all the host of Hadarezer king of Zobah;
- 13_1CH_18_10 He sent Hadoram his son to king David, to inquire of his welfare, and to congratulate him, because he had fought against Hadarezer, and smitten him; [for Hadarezer had war with Tou;] and [with him] all manner of vessels of gold and silver and brass.
- 13_1CH_18_11 Them also king David dedicated unto the LORD, with the silver and the gold that he brought from all [these] nations; from Edom, and from Moab, and from the children of Ammon, and from the Philistines, and from Amalek.
- 13 1CH 18 12 Moreover Abishai the son of Zeruiah slew of the Edomites in the valley of salt eighteen thousand.
- 13_1CH_18_13 And he put garrisons in Edom; and all the Edomites became David's servants. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.
- 13 1CH 18 14 So David reigned over all Israel, and executed judgment and justice among all his people.
- 13 1CH 18 15 And Joab the son of Zeruiah [was] over the host; and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud, recorder.
- 13_1CH_18_16 And Zadok the son of Ahitub, and Abimelech the son of Abiathar, [were] the priests; and Shavsha was scribe;
- 13_1CH_18_17 And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada [was] over the Cherethites and the Pelethites; and the sons of David [were] chief about the king.



- 13_1CH_19_01 Now it came to pass after this, that Nahash the king of the children of Ammon died, and his son reigned in his stead.
- 13_1CH_19_02 And David said, I will show kindness unto Hanun the son of Nahash, because his father showed kindness to me. And David sent messengers to comfort him concerning his father. So the servants of David came into the land of the children of Ammon to Hanun, to comfort him.
- 13_1CH_19_03 But the princes of the children of Ammon said to Hanun, Thinkest thou that David doth honour thy father, that he hath sent comforters unto thee? are not his servants come unto thee for to search, and to overthrow, and to spy out the land?
- 13_1CH_19_04 Wherefore Hanun took David's servants, and shaved them, and cut off their garments in the midst hard by their buttocks, and sent them away.
- 13_1CH_19_05 Then there went [certain], and told David how the men were served. And he sent to meet them: for the men were greatly ashamed. And the king said, Tarry at Jericho until your beards be grown, and [then] return.
- 13_1CH_19_06 And when the children of Ammon saw that they had made themselves odious to David, Hanun and the children of Ammon sent a thousand talents of silver to hire them chariots and horsemen out of Mesopotamia, and out of Syriamaachah, and out of Zobah.
- 13_1CH_19_07 So they hired thirty and two thousand chariots, and the king of Maachah and his people; who came and pitched before Medeba. And the children of Ammon gathered themselves together from their cities, and came to battle.
- 13 1CH 19 08 And when David heard [of it], he sent Joab, and all the host of the mighty men.
- 13_1CH_19_09 And the children of Ammon came out, and put the battle in array before the gate of the city: and the kings that were come [were] by themselves in the field.
- 13_1CH_19_10 Now when Joab saw that the battle was set against him before and behind, he chose out of all the choice of Israel, and put [them] in array against the Syrians.
- 13_1CH_19_11 And the rest of the people he delivered unto the hand of Abishai his brother, and they set [themselves] in array against the children of Ammon.
- 13_1CH_19_12 And he said, If the Syrians be too strong for me, then thou shalt help me: but if the children of Ammon be too strong for thee, then I will help thee.
- 13_1CH_19_13 Be of good courage, and let us behave ourselves valiantly for our people, and for the cities of our God: and let the LORD do [that which is] good in his sight.
- 13_1CH_19_14 So Joab and the people that [were] with him drew nigh before the Syrians unto the battle; and they fled before him.
- 13_1CH_19_15 And when the children of Ammon saw that the Syrians were fled, they likewise fled before Abishai his brother, and entered into the city. Then Joab came to Jerusalem.
- 13_1CH_19_16 And when the Syrians saw that they were put to the worse before Israel, they sent messengers, and drew forth the Syrians that [were] beyond the river: and Shophach the captain of the host of Hadarezer [went] before them.
- 13_1CH_19_17 And it was told David; and he gathered all Israel, and passed over Jordan, and came upon them, and set [the battle] in array against them. So when David had put the battle in array against the Syrians, they fought with him.
- 13_1CH_19_18 But the Syrians fled before Israel; and David slew of the Syrians seven thousand [men which fought in] chariots, and forty thousand footmen, and killed Shophach the captain of the host.
- 13_1CH_19_19 And when the servants of Hadarezer saw that they were put to the worse before Israel, they made peace with David, and became his servants: neither would the Syrians help the children of Ammon any more.

- 13_1CH_20_01 And it came to pass, that after the year was expired, at the time that kings go out [to battle], Joab led forth the power of the army, and wasted the country of the children of Ammon, and came and besieged Rabbah. But David tarried at Jerusalem. And Joab smote Rabbah, and destroyed it.
- 13_1CH_20_02 And David took the crown of their king from off his head, and found it to weigh a talent of gold, and [there were] precious stones in it; and it was set upon David's head: and he brought also exceeding much spoil out of the city.
- 13_1CH_20_03 And he brought out the people that [were] in it, and cut [them] with saws, and with harrows of iron, and with axes. Even so dealt David with all the cities of the children of Ammon. And David and all the people returned to Jerusalem.
- 13_1CH_20_04 And it came to pass after this, that there arose war at Gezer with the Philistines; at which time Sibbechai the Hushathite slew Sippai, [that was] of the children of the giant: and they were subdued.
- 13_1CH_20_05 And there was war again with the Philistines; and Elhanan the son of Jair slew Lahmi the brother of Goliath the Gittite, whose spear staff [was] like a weaver's beam.
- 13_1CH_20_06 And yet again there was war at Gath, where was a man of [great] stature, whose fingers and toes [were] four and twenty, six [on each hand], and six [on each foot]: and he also was the son of the giant.
- 13_1CH_20_07 But when he defied Israel, Jonathan the son of Shimea David's brother slew him.
- 13_1CH_20_08 These were born unto the giant in Gath; and they fell by the hand of David, and by the hand of his servants.



- 13 1CH 21 01 And Satan stood up against Israel, and provoked David to number Israel.
- 13_1CH_21_02 And David said to Joab and to the rulers of the people, Go, number Israel from Beersheba even to Dan; and bring the number of them to me, that I may know [it].
- 13_1CH_21_03 And Joab answered, The LORD make his people an hundred times so many more as they [be]: but, my lord the king, [are] they not all my lord's servants? why then doth my lord require this thing? why will he be a cause of trespass to Israel?
- 13_1CH_21_04 Nevertheless the king's word prevailed against Joab. Wherefore Joab departed, and went throughout all Israel, and came to Jerusalem.
- 13_1CH_21_05 And Joab gave the sum of the number of the people unto David. And all [they of] Israel were a thousand thousand and an hundred thousand men that drew sword: and Judah [was] four hundred threescore and ten thousand men that drew sword.
- 13_1CH_21_06 But Levi and Benjamin counted he not among them: for the king's word was abominable to Joab.
- 13_1CH_21_07 And God was displeased with this thing; therefore he smote Israel.
- 13_1CH_21_08 And David said unto God, I have sinned greatly, because I have done this thing: but now, I beseech thee, do away the iniquity of thy servant; for I have done very foolishly.
- 13 1CH 21 09 And the LORD spake unto Gad, David's seer, saying,
- 13_1CH_21_10 Go and tell David, saying, Thus saith the LORD, I offer thee three [things]: choose thee one of them, that I may do [it] unto thee.
- 13_1CH_21_11 So Gad came to David, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Choose thee
- 13_1CH_21_12 Either three years' famine; or three months to be destroyed before thy foes, while that the sword of thine enemies overtaketh [thee]; or else three days the sword of the LORD, even the pestilence, in the land, and the angel of the LORD destroying throughout all the coasts of Israel. Now therefore advise thyself what word I shall bring again to him that sent me.
- 13_1CH_21_13 And David said unto Gad, I am in a great strait: let me fall now into the hand of the LORD; for very great [are] his mercies: but let me not fall into the hand of man.
- 13_1CH_21_14 So the LORD sent pestilence upon Israel: and there fell of Israel seventy thousand men.
- 13_1CH_21_15 And God sent an angel unto Jerusalem to destroy it: and as he was destroying, the LORD beheld, and he repented him of the evil, and said to the angel that destroyed, It is enough, stay now thine hand. And the angel of the LORD stood by the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.
- 13_1CH_21_16 And David lifted up his eyes, and saw the angel of the LORD stand between the earth and the heaven, having a drawn sword in his hand stretched out over Jerusalem. Then David and the elders [of Israel, who were] clothed in sackcloth, fell upon their faces.
- 13_1CH_21_17 And David said unto God, [Is it] not I [that] commanded the people to be numbered? even I it is that have sinned and done evil indeed; but [as for] these sheep, what have they done? let thine hand, I pray thee, O LORD my God, be on me, and on my father's house; but not on thy people, that they should be plagued.
- 13_1CH_21_18 Then the angel of the LORD commanded Gad to say to David, that David should go up, and set up an altar unto the LORD in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.
- 13_1CH_21_19 And David went up at the saying of Gad, which he spake in the name of the LORD.
- 13_1CH_21_20 And Ornan turned back, and saw the angel; and his four sons with him hid themselves. Now Ornan was threshing wheat.
- 13_1CH_21_21 And as David came to Ornan, Ornan looked and saw David, and went out of the threshingfloor, and bowed himself to David with [his] face to the ground.
- 13_1CH_21_22 Then David said to Ornan, Grant me the place of [this] threshingfloor, that I may build an altar therein unto the LORD: thou shalt grant it me for the full price: that the plague may be stayed from the people.
- 13_1CH_21_23 And Ornan said unto David, Take [it] to thee, and let my lord the king do [that which is] good in his eyes: lo, I give [thee] the oxen [also] for burnt offerings, and the threshing instruments for wood, and the wheat for the meat offering; I give it all.
- 13_1CH_21_24 And king David said to Ornan, Nay; but I will verily buy it for the full price: for I will not take [that] which [is] thine for the LORD, nor offer burnt offerings without cost.
- 13 1CH 21 25 So David gave to Ornan for the place six hundred shekels of gold by weight.
- 13_1CH_21_26 And David built there an altar unto the LORD, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings, and called upon the LORD; and he answered him from heaven by fire upon the altar of burnt offering.
- 13 1CH 21 27 And the LORD commanded the angel; and he put up his sword again into the sheath thereof.
- 13_1CH_21_28 At that time when David saw that the LORD had answered him in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite, then he sacrificed there.
- 13_1CH_21_29 For the tabernacle of the LORD, which Moses made in the wilderness, and the altar of the burnt offering, [were] at that season in the high place at Gibeon.
- 13_1CH_21_30 But David could not go before it to inquire of God: for he was afraid because of the sword of the angel of the LORD.



- 13_1CH_22_01 Then David said, This [is] the house of the LORD God, and this [is] the altar of the burnt offering for Israel.
- 13_1CH_22_02 And David commanded to gather together the strangers that [were] in the land of Israel; and he set masons to hew wrought stones to build the house of God.
- 13_1CH_22_03 And David prepared iron in abundance for the nails for the doors of the gates, and for the joinings; and brass in abundance without weight;
- 13_1CH_22_04 Also cedar trees in abundance: for the Zidonians and they of Tyre brought much cedar wood to David.
- 13_1CH_22_05 And David said, Solomon my son [is] young and tender, and the house [that is] to be builded for the LORD [must be] exceeding magnifical, of fame and of glory throughout all countries: I will [therefore] now make preparation for it. So David prepared abundantly before his death.
- 13_1CH_22_06 Then he called for Solomon his son, and charged him to build an house for the LORD God of Israel.
- 13_1CH_22_07 And David said to Solomon, My son, as for me, it was in my mind to build an house unto the name of the LORD my God:
- 13_1CH_22_08 But the word of the LORD came to me, saying, Thou hast shed blood abundantly, and hast made great wars: thou shalt not build an house unto my name, because thou hast shed much blood upon the earth in my sight.
- 13_1CH_22_09 Behold, a son shall be born to thee, who shall be a man of rest; and I will give him rest from all his enemies round about: for his name shall be Solomon, and I will give peace and quietness unto Israel in his days.
- 13_1CH_22_10 He shall build an house for my name; and he shall be my son, and I [will be] his father; and I will establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel for ever.
- 13_1CH_22_11 Now, my son, the LORD be with thee; and prosper thou, and build the house of the LORD thy God, as he hath said of thee.
- 13_1CH_22_12 Only the LORD give thee wisdom and understanding, and give thee charge concerning Israel, that thou mayest keep the law of the LORD thy God.
- 13_1CH_22_13 Then shalt thou prosper, if thou takest heed to fulfil the statutes and judgments which the LORD charged Moses with concerning Israel: be strong, and of good courage; dread not, nor be dismayed.
- 13_1CH_22_14 Now, behold, in my trouble I have prepared for the house of the LORD an hundred thousand talents of gold, and a thousand thousand talents of silver; and of brass and iron without weight; for it is in abundance: timber also and stone have I prepared; and thou mayest add thereto.
- 13_1CH_22_15 Moreover [there are] workmen with thee in abundance, hewers and workers of stone and timber, and all manner of cunning men for every manner of work.
- 13_1CH_22_16 Of the gold, the silver, and the brass, and the iron, [there is] no number. Arise [therefore], and be doing, and the LORD be with thee.
- 13 1CH 22 17 David also commanded all the princes of Israel to help Solomon his son, [saying],
- 13_1CH_22_18 [Is] not the LORD your God with you? and hath he [not] given you rest on every side? for he hath given the inhabitants of the land into mine hand; and the land is subdued before the LORD, and before his people.
- 13_1CH_22_19 Now set your heart and your soul to seek the LORD your God; arise therefore, and build ye the sanctuary of the LORD God, to bring the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and the holy vessels of God, into the house that is to be built to the name of the LORD.



- 13 1CH 23 01 So when David was old and full of days, he made Solomon his son king over Israel.
- 13 1CH 23 02 And he gathered together all the princes of Israel, with the priests and the Levites.
- 13_1CH_23_03 Now the Levites were numbered from the age of thirty years and upward: and their number by their polls, man by man, was thirty and eight thousand.
- 13_1CH_23_04 Of which, twenty and four thousand [were] to set forward the work of the house of the LORD; and six thousand [were] officers and judges:
- 13_1CH_23_05 Moreover four thousand [were] porters; and four thousand praised the LORD with the instruments which I made, [said David], to praise [therewith].
- 13_1CH_23_06 And David divided them into courses among the sons of Levi, [namely], Gershon, Kohath, and Merari.
- 13_1CH_23_07 Of the Gershonites [were], Laadan, and Shimei.
- 13 1CH 23 08 The sons of Laadan; the chief [was] Jehiel, and Zetham, and Joel, three.
- 13_1CH_23_09 The sons of Shimei; Shelomith, and Haziel, and Haran, three. These [were] the chief of the fathers of Laadan.
- 13_1CH_23_10 And the sons of Shimei [were], Jahath, Zina, and Jeush, and Beriah. These four [were] the sons of Shimei.
- 13_1CH_23_11 And Jahath was the chief, and Zizah the second: but Jeush and Beriah had not many sons; therefore they were in one reckoning, according to [their] father's house.
- 13_1CH_23_12 The sons of Kohath; Amram, Izhar, Hebron, and Uzziel, four.
- 13_1CH_23_13 The sons of Amram; Aaron and Moses: and Aaron was separated, that he should sanctify the most holy things, he and his sons for ever, to burn incense before the LORD, to minister unto him, and to bless in his name for ever.
- 13 1CH 23 14 Now [concerning] Moses the man of God, his sons were named of the tribe of Levi.
- 13_1CH_23_15 The sons of Moses [were], Gershom, and Eliezer.
- 13 1CH 23 16 Of the sons of Gershom, Shebuel [was] the chief.
- 13_1CH_23_17 And the sons of Eliezer [were], Rehabiah the chief. And Eliezer had none other sons; but the sons of Rehabiah were very many.
- 13_1CH_23_18 Of the sons of Izhar; Shelomith the chief.
- 13_1CH_23_19 Of the sons of Hebron; Jeriah the first, Amariah the second, Jahaziel the third, and Jekameam the fourth.
- 13_1CH_23_20 Of the sons of Uzziel; Micah the first, and Jesiah the second.
- 13_1CH_23_21 The sons of Merari; Mahli, and Mushi. The sons of Mahli; Eleazar, and Kish.
- 13 1CH 23 22 And Eleazar died, and had no sons, but daughters: and their brethren the sons of Kish took them.
- 13_1CH_23_23 The sons of Mushi; Mahli, and Eder, and Jeremoth, three.
- 13_1CH_23_24 These [were] the sons of Levi after the house of their fathers; [even] the chief of the fathers, as they were counted by number of names by their polls, that did the work for the service of the house of the LORD, from the age of twenty years and upward.
- 13_1CH_23_25 For David said, The LORD God of Israel hath given rest unto his people, that they may dwell in Jerusalem for ever:
- 13_1CH_23_26 And also unto the Levites; they shall no [more] carry the tabernacle, nor any vessels of it for the service thereof.
- 13 1CH 23 27 For by the last words of David the Levites [were] numbered from twenty years old and above:
- 13_1CH_23_28 Because their office [was] to wait on the sons of Aaron for the service of the house of the LORD, in the courts, and in the chambers, and in the purifying of all holy things, and the work of the service of the house of God;
- 13 1CH 23 29 Both for the showbread, and for the fine flour for meat offering, and for the unleavened cakes, and for
- 13 1CH 23 30 And to stand every morning to thank and praise the LORD, and likewise at even;

[that which is baked in] the pan, and for that which is fried, and for all manner of measure and size;

- 13_1CH_23_31 And to offer all burnt sacrifices unto the LORD in the sabbaths, in the new moons, and on the set feasts, by number, according to the order commanded unto them, continually before the LORD:
- 13_1CH_23_32 And that they should keep the charge of the tabernacle of the congregation, and the charge of the holy [place], and the charge of the sons of Aaron their brethren, in the service of the house of the LORD.



- 13_1CH_24_01 Now [these are] the divisions of the sons of Aaron. The sons of Aaron; Nadab, and Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar.
- 13_1CH_24_02 But Nadab and Abihu died before their father, and had no children: therefore Eleazar and Ithamar executed the priest's office.
- 13_1CH_24_03 And David distributed them, both Zadok of the sons of Eleazar, and Ahimelech of the sons of Ithamar, according to their offices in their service.
- 13_1CH_24_04 And there were more chief men found of the sons of Eleazar than of the sons of Ithamar; and [thus] were they divided. Among the sons of Eleazar [there were] sixteen chief men of the house of [their] fathers, and eight among the sons of Ithamar according to the house of their fathers.
- 13_1CH_24_05 Thus were they divided by lot, one sort with another; for the governors of the sanctuary, and governors [of the house] of God, were of the sons of Eleazar, and of the sons of Ithamar.
- 13_1CH_24_06 And Shemaiah the son of Nethaneel the scribe, [one] of the Levites, wrote them before the king, and the princes, and Zadok the priest, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, and [before] the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites: one principal household being taken for Eleazar, and [one] taken for Ithamar.
- 13 1CH 24 07 Now the first lot came forth to Jehoiarib, the second to Jedaiah,
- 13_1CH_24_08 The third to Harim, the fourth to Seorim,
- 13_1CH_24_09 The fifth to Malchijah, the sixth to Mijamin,
- 13_1CH_24_10 The seventh to Hakkoz, the eighth to Abijah,
- 13_1CH_24_11 The ninth to Jeshuah, the tenth to Shecaniah,
- 13_1CH_24_12 The eleventh to Eliashib, the twelfth to Jakim,
- 13_1CH_24_13 The thirteenth to Huppah, the fourteenth to Jeshebeab,
- 13_1CH_24_14 The fifteenth to Bilgah, the sixteenth to Immer,
- 13_1CH_24_15 The seventeenth to Hezir, the eighteenth to Aphses,
- 13_1CH_24_16 The nineteenth to Pethahiah, the twentieth to Jehezekel,
- 13_1CH_24_17 The one and twentieth to Jachin, the two and twentieth to Gamul,
- 13_1CH_24_18 The three and twentieth to Delaiah, the four and twentieth to Maaziah.
- 13_1CH_24_19 These [were] the orderings of them in their service to come into the house of the LORD, according to their manner, under Aaron their father, as the LORD God of Israel had commanded him.
- 13_1CH_24_20 And the rest of the sons of Levi [were these]: Of the sons of Amram; Shubael: of the sons of Shubael; Jehdeiah.
- 13 1CH 24 21 Concerning Rehabiah: of the sons of Rehabiah, the first [was] Isshiah.
- 13 1CH 24 22 Of the Izharites; Shelomoth: of the sons of Shelomoth; Jahath.
- 13_1CH_24_23 And the sons [of Hebron]; Jeriah [the first], Amariah the second, Jahaziel the third, Jekameam the fourth.
- 13_1CH_24_24 [Of] the sons of Uzziel; Michah: of the sons of Michah; Shamir.
- 13_1CH_24_25 The brother of Michah [was] Isshiah: of the sons of Isshiah; Zechariah.
- 13_1CH_24_26 The sons of Merari [were] Mahli and Mushi: the sons of Jaaziah; Beno.
- 13_1CH_24_27 The sons of Merari by Jaaziah; Beno, and Shoham, and Zaccur, and Ibri.
- 13_1CH_24_28 Of Mahli [came] Eleazar, who had no sons.
- 13_1CH_24_29 Concerning Kish: the son of Kish [was] Jerahmeel.
- 13_1CH_24_30 The sons also of Mushi; Mahli, and Eder, and Jerimoth. These [were] the sons of the Levites after the house of their fathers.
- 13_1CH_24_31 These likewise cast lots over against their brethren the sons of Aaron in the presence of David the king, and Zadok, and Ahimelech, and the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites, even the principal fathers over against their younger brethren.



- 13_1CH_25_01 Moreover David and the captains of the host separated to the service of the sons of Asaph, and of Heman, and of Jeduthun, who should prophesy with harps, with psalteries, and with cymbals: and the number of the workmen according to their service was:
- 13_1CH_25_02 Of the sons of Asaph; Zaccur, and Joseph, and Nethaniah, and Asarelah, the sons of Asaph under the hands of Asaph, which prophesied according to the order of the king.
- 13_1CH_25_03 Of Jeduthun: the sons of Jeduthun; Gedaliah, and Zeri, and Jeshaiah, Hashabiah, and Mattithiah, six, under the hands of their father Jeduthun, who prophesied with a harp, to give thanks and to praise the LORD.
- 13_1CH_25_04 Of Heman: the sons of Heman; Bukkiah, Mattaniah, Uzziel, Shebuel, and Jerimoth, Hananiah, Hanani, Eliathah, Giddalti, and Romamtiezer, Joshbekashah, Mallothi, Hothir, [and] Mahazioth:
- 13_1CH_25_05 All these [were] the sons of Heman the king's seer in the words of God, to lift up the horn. And God gave to Heman fourteen sons and three daughters.
- 13_1CH_25_06 All these [were] under the hands of their father for song [in] the house of the LORD, with cymbals, psalteries, and harps, for the service of the house of God, according to the king's order to Asaph, Jeduthun, and Heman.
- 13_1CH_25_07 So the number of them, with their brethren that were instructed in the songs of the LORD, [even] all that were cunning, was two hundred fourscore and eight.
- 13 1CH 25 08 And they cast lots, ward against [ward], as well the small as the great, the teacher as the scholar.
- 13_1CH_25_09 Now the first lot came forth for Asaph to Joseph: the second to Gedaliah, who with his brethren and sons [were] twelve:
- 13 1CH 25 10 The third to Zaccur, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13 1CH 25 11 The fourth to Izri, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13_1CH_25_12 The fifth to Nethaniah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13 1CH 25 13 The sixth to Bukkiah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13 1CH 25 14 The seventh to Jesharelah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13_1CH_25_15 The eighth to Jeshaiah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13_1CH_25_16 The ninth to Mattaniah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13_1CH_25_17 The tenth to Shimei, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13 1CH 25 18 The eleventh to Azareel, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13 1CH 25 19 The twelfth to Hashabiah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13_1CH_25_20 The thirteenth to Shubael, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13_1CH_25_21 The fourteenth to Mattithiah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13 1CH 25 22 The fifteenth to Jeremoth, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13 1CH 25 23 The sixteenth to Hananiah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13_1CH_25_24 The seventeenth to Joshbekashah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13 1CH 25 25 The eighteenth to Hanani, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13_1CH_25_26 The nineteenth to Mallothi, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13 1CH 25 27 The twentieth to Eliathah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13 1CH 25 28 The one and twentieth to Hothir, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13 1CH 25 29 The two and twentieth to Giddalti, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13_1CH_25_30 The three and twentieth to Mahazioth, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
- 13_1CH_25_31 The four and twentieth to Romamtiezer, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve.



- 13_1CH_26_01 Concerning the divisions of the porters: Of the Korhites [was] Meshelemiah the son of Kore, of the sons of Asaph.
- 13_1CH_26_02 And the sons of Meshelemiah [were], Zechariah the firstborn, Jediael the second, Zebadiah the third, Jathniel the fourth,
- 13_1CH_26_03 Elam the fifth, Jehohanan the sixth, Elioenai the seventh.
- 13_1CH_26_04 Moreover the sons of Obededom [were], Shemaiah the firstborn, Jehozabad the second, Joah the third, and Sacar the fourth, and Nethaneel the fifth,
- 13_1CH_26_05 Ammiel the sixth, Issachar the seventh, Peulthai the eighth: for God blessed him.
- 13_1CH_26_06 Also unto Shemaiah his son were sons born, that ruled throughout the house of their father: for they [were] mighty men of valour.
- 13_1CH_26_07 The sons of Shemaiah; Othni, and Rephael, and Obed, Elzabad, whose brethren [were] strong men, Elihu, and Semachiah.
- 13_1CH_26_08 All these of the sons of Obededom: they and their sons and their brethren, able men for strength for the service, [were] threescore and two of Obededom.
- 13 1CH 26 09 And Meshelemiah had sons and brethren, strong men, eighteen.
- 13_1CH_26_10 Also Hosah, of the children of Merari, had sons; Simri the chief, [for [though] he was not the firstborn, yet his father made him the chief;]
- 13_1CH_26_11 Hilkiah the second, Tebaliah the third, Zechariah the fourth: all the sons and brethren of Hosah [were] thirteen.
- 13_1CH_26_12 Among these [were] the divisions of the porters, [even] among the chief men, [having] wards one against another, to minister in the house of the LORD.
- 13_1CH_26_13 And they cast lots, as well the small as the great, according to the house of their fathers, for every gate.
- 13_1CH_26_14 And the lot eastward fell to Shelemiah. Then for Zechariah his son, a wise counsellor, they cast lots; and his lot came out northward.
- 13_1CH_26_15 To Obededom southward; and to his sons the house of Asuppim.
- 13_1CH_26_16 To Shuppim and Hosah [the lot came forth] westward, with the gate Shallecheth, by the causeway of the going up, ward against ward.
- 13_1CH_26_17 Eastward [were] six Levites, northward four a day, southward four a day, and toward Asuppim two [and] two.
- 13_1CH_26_18 At Parbar westward, four at the causeway, [and] two at Parbar.
- 13 1CH 26 19 These [are] the divisions of the porters among the sons of Kore, and among the sons of Merari.
- 13_1CH_26_20 And of the Levites, Ahijah [was] over the treasures of the house of God, and over the treasures of the dedicated things.
- 13_1CH_26_21 [As concerning] the sons of Laadan; the sons of the Gershonite Laadan, chief fathers, [even] of Laadan the Gershonite, [were] Jehieli.
- 13_1CH_26_22 The sons of Jehieli; Zetham, and Joel his brother, [which were] over the treasures of the house of the LORD.
- 13_1CH_26_23 Of the Amramites, [and] the Izharites, the Hebronites, [and] the Uzzielites:
- 13_1CH_26_24 And Shebuel the son of Gershom, the son of Moses, [was] ruler of the treasures.
- 13_1CH_26_25 And his brethren by Eliezer; Rehabiah his son, and Jeshaiah his son, and Joram his son, and Zichri his son, and Shelomith his son.
- 13_1CH_26_26 Which Shelomith and his brethren [were] over all the treasures of the dedicated things, which David the king, and the chief fathers, the captains over thousands and hundreds, and the captains of the host, had dedicated.
- 13_1CH_26_27 Out of the spoils won in battles did they dedicate to maintain the house of the LORD.
- 13_1CH_26_28 And all that Samuel the seer, and Saul the son of Kish, and Abner the son of Ner, and Joab the son of Zeruiah, had dedicated; [and] whosoever had dedicated [any thing, it was] under the hand of Shelomith, and of his brethren.
- 13_1CH_26_29 Of the Izharites, Chenaniah and his sons [were] for the outward business over Israel, for officers and judges.
- 13_1CH_26_30 [And] of the Hebronites, Hashabiah and his brethren, men of valour, a thousand and seven hundred, [were] officers among them of Israel on this side Jordan westward in all the business of the LORD, and in the service of the king.
- 13_1CH_26_31 Among the Hebronites [was] Jerijah the chief, [even] among the Hebronites, according to the generations of his fathers. In the fortieth year of the reign of David they were sought for, and there were found among them mighty men of valour at Jazer of Gilead.
- 13_1CH_26_32 And his brethren, men of valour, [were] two thousand and seven hundred chief fathers, whom king David made rulers over the Reubenites, the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, for every matter pertaining to God, and affairs of the king.



- 13_1CH_27_01 Now the children of Israel after their number, [to wit], the chief fathers and captains of thousands and hundreds, and their officers that served the king in any matter of the courses, which came in and went out month by month throughout all the months of the year, of every course [were] twenty and four thousand.
- 13_1CH_27_02 Over the first course for the first month [was] Jashobeam the son of Zabdiel: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.
- 13 1CH 27 03 Of the children of Perez [was] the chief of all the captains of the host for the first month.
- 13_1CH_27_04 And over the course of the second month [was] Dodai an Ahohite, and of his course [was] Mikloth also the ruler: in his course likewise [were] twenty and four thousand.
- 13_1CH_27_05 The third captain of the host for the third month [was] Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, a chief priest: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.
- 13_1CH_27_06 This [is that] Benaiah, [who was] mighty [among] the thirty, and above the thirty: and in his course [was] Ammizabad his son.
- 13_1CH_27_07 The fourth [captain] for the fourth month [was] Asahel the brother of Joab, and Zebadiah his son after him: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.
- 13_1CH_27_08 The fifth captain for the fifth month [was] Shamhuth the Izrahite: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.
- 13_1CH_27_09 The sixth [captain] for the sixth month [was] Ira the son of Ikkesh the Tekoite: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.
- 13_1CH_27_10 The seventh [captain] for the seventh month [was] Helez the Pelonite, of the children of Ephraim: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.
- 13_1CH_27_11 The eighth [captain] for the eighth month [was] Sibbecai the Hushathite, of the Zarhites: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.
- 13_1CH_27_12 The ninth [captain] for the ninth month [was] Abiezer the Anetothite, of the Benjamites: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.
- 13_1CH_27_13 The tenth [captain] for the tenth month [was] Maharai the Netophathite, of the Zarhites: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.
- 13_1CH_27_14 The eleventh [captain] for the eleventh month [was] Benaiah the Pirathonite, of the children of Ephraim: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.
- 13_1CH_27_15 The twelfth [captain] for the twelfth month [was] Heldai the Netophathite, of Othniel: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.
- 13_1CH_27_16 Furthermore over the tribes of Israel: the ruler of the Reubenites [was] Eliezer the son of Zichri: of the Simeonites, Shephatiah the son of Maachah:
- 13_1CH_27_17 Of the Levites, Hashabiah the son of Kemuel: of the Aaronites, Zadok:
- 13_1CH_27_18 Of Judah, Elihu, [one] of the brethren of David: of Issachar, Omri the son of Michael:
- 13_1CH_27_19 Of Zebulun, Ishmaiah the son of Obadiah: of Naphtali, Jerimoth the son of Azriel:
- 13_1CH_27_20 Of the children of Ephraim, Hoshea the son of Azaziah: of the half tribe of Manasseh, Joel the son of Pedaiah:
- 13_1CH_27_21 Of the half [tribe] of Manasseh in Gilead, Iddo the son of Zechariah: of Benjamin, Jaasiel the son of Abner:
- 13_1CH_27_22 Of Dan, Azareel the son of Jeroham. These [were] the princes of the tribes of Israel.
- 13_1CH_27_23 But David took not the number of them from twenty years old and under: because the LORD had said he would increase Israel like to the stars of the heavens.
- 13_1CH_27_24 Joab the son of Zeruiah began to number, but he finished not, because there fell wrath for it against Israel; neither was the number put in the account of the chronicles of king David.
- 13_1CH_27_25 And over the king's treasures [was] Azmaveth the son of Adiel: and over the storehouses in the fields, in the cities, and in the villages, and in the castles, [was] Jehonathan the son of Uzziah:
- 13 1CH 27 26 And over them that did the work of the field for tillage of the ground [was] Ezri the son of Chelub:
- 13_1CH_27_27 And over the vineyards [was] Shimei the Ramathite: over the increase of the vineyards for the wine cellars [was] Zabdi the Shiphmite:
- 13_1CH_27_28 And over the olive trees and the sycamore trees that [were] in the low plains [was] Baalhanan the Gederite: and over the cellars of oil [was] Joash:
- 13_1CH_27_29 And over the herds that fed in Sharon [was] Shitrai the Sharonite: and over the herds [that were] in the valleys [was] Shaphat the son of Adlai:
- 13_1CH_27_30 Over the camels also [was] Obil the Ishmaelite: and over the asses [was] Jehdeiah the Meronothite:
- 13_1CH_27_31 And over the flocks [was] Jaziz the Hagerite. All these [were] the rulers of the substance which [was] king David's.
- 13 1CH 27 32 Also Jonathan David's uncle was a counsellor, a wise man, and a scribe: and Jehiel the son of
- Hachmoni [was] with the king's sons:
- 13 1CH 27 34 And after Ahithophel [was] Jehoiada the son of Benaiah, and Abiathar: and the general of the king's

army [was] Joab.

13 1CH 27 33 And Ahithophel [was] the king's counsellor: and Hushai the Archite [was] the king's companion:



- 13_1CH_28_01 And David assembled all the princes of Israel, the princes of the tribes, and the captains of the companies that ministered to the king by course, and the captains over the thousands, and captains over the hundreds, and the stewards over all the substance and possession of the king, and of his sons, with the officers, and with the mighty men, and with all the valiant men, unto Jerusalem.
- 13_1CH_28_02 Then David the king stood up upon his feet, and said, Hear me, my brethren, and my people: [As for me], I [had] in mine heart to build an house of rest for the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and for the footstool of our God, and had made ready for the building:
- 13_1CH_28_03 But God said unto me, Thou shalt not build an house for my name, because thou [hast been] a man of war, and hast shed blood.
- 13_1CH_28_04 Howbeit the LORD God of Israel chose me before all the house of my father to be king over Israel for ever: for he hath chosen Judah [to be] the ruler; and of the house of Judah, the house of my father; and among the sons of my father he liked me to make [me] king over all Israel:
- 13_1CH_28_05 And of all my sons, [for the LORD hath given me many sons,] he hath chosen Solomon my son to sit upon the throne of the kingdom of the LORD over Israel.
- 13_1CH_28_06 And he said unto me, Solomon thy son, he shall build my house and my courts: for I have chosen him [to be] my son, and I will be his father.
- 13_1CH_28_07 Moreover I will establish his kingdom for ever, if he be constant to do my commandments and my judgments, as at this day.
- 13_1CH_28_08 Now therefore in the sight of all Israel the congregation of the LORD, and in the audience of our God, keep and seek for all the commandments of the LORD your God: that ye may possess this good land, and leave [it] for an inheritance for your children after you for ever.
- 13_1CH_28_09 And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee; but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off for ever.
- 13_1CH_28_10 Take heed now; for the LORD hath chosen thee to build an house for the sanctuary: be strong, and do [it].
- 13_1CH_28_11 Then David gave to Solomon his son the pattern of the porch, and of the houses thereof, and of the treasuries thereof, and of the upper chambers thereof, and of the inner parlours thereof, and of the place of the mercy seat,
- 13_1CH_28_12 And the pattern of all that he had by the spirit, of the courts of the house of the LORD, and of all the chambers round about, of the treasuries of the house of God, and of the treasuries of the dedicated things:
- 13_1CH_28_13 Also for the courses of the priests and the Levites, and for all the work of the service of the house of the LORD, and for all the vessels of service in the house of the LORD.
- 13_1CH_28_14 [He gave] of gold by weight for [things] of gold, for all instruments of all manner of service; [silver also] for all instruments of silver by weight, for all instruments of every kind of service:
- 13_1CH_28_15 Even the weight for the candlesticks of gold, and for their lamps of gold, by weight for every candlestick, and for the lamps thereof: and for the candlesticks of silver by weight, [both] for the candlestick, and [also] for the lamps thereof, according to the use of every candlestick.
- 13_1CH_28_16 And by weight [he gave] gold for the tables of showbread, for every table; and [likewise] silver for the tables of silver:
- 13_1CH_28_17 Also pure gold for the fleshhooks, and the bowls, and the cups: and for the golden basins [he gave gold] by weight for every basin; and [likewise silver] by weight for every basin of silver:
- 13_1CH_28_18 And for the altar of incense refined gold by weight; and gold for the pattern of the chariot of the cherubims, that spread out [their wings], and covered the ark of the covenant of the LORD.
- 13_1CH_28_19 All [this, said David], the LORD made me understand in writing by [his] hand upon me, [even] all the works of this pattern.
- 13_1CH_28_20 And David said to Solomon his son, Be strong and of good courage, and do [it]: fear not, nor be dismayed: for the LORD God, [even] my God, [will be] with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee, until thou hast finished all the work for the service of the house of the LORD.
- 13_1CH_28_21 And, behold, the courses of the priests and the Levites, [even they shall be with thee] for all the service of the house of God: and [there shall be] with thee for all manner of workmanship every willing skilful man, for any manner of service: also the princes and all the people [will be] wholly at thy commandment.



- 13_1CH_29_01 Furthermore David the king said unto all the congregation, Solomon my son, whom alone God hath chosen, [is yet] young and tender, and the work [is] great: for the palace [is] not for man, but for the LORD God.
- 13_1CH_29_02 Now I have prepared with all my might for the house of my God the gold for [things to be made] of gold, and the silver for [things] of silver, and the brass for [things] of brass, the iron for [things] of iron, and wood for [things] of wood; onyx stones, and [stones] to be set, glistering stones, and of divers colours, and all manner of precious stones, and marble stones in abundance.
- 13_1CH_29_03 Moreover, because I have set my affection to the house of my God, I have of mine own proper good, of gold and silver, [which] I have given to the house of my God, over and above all that I have prepared for the holy house,
- 13_1CH_29_04 [Even] three thousand talents of gold, of the gold of Ophir, and seven thousand talents of refined silver, to overlay the walls of the houses [withal]:
- 13_1CH_29_05 The gold for [things] of gold, and the silver for [things] of silver, and for all manner of work [to be made] by the hands of artificers. And who [then] is willing to consecrate his service this day unto the LORD?
- 13_1CH_29_06 Then the chief of the fathers and princes of the tribes of Israel, and the captains of thousands and of hundreds, with the rulers of the king's work, offered willingly,
- 13_1CH_29_07 And gave for the service of the house of God of gold five thousand talents and ten thousand drams, and of silver ten thousand talents, and of brass eighteen thousand talents, and one hundred thousand talents of iron.
- 13_1CH_29_08 And they with whom [precious] stones were found gave [them] to the treasure of the house of the LORD, by the hand of Jehiel the Gershonite.
- 13_1CH_29_09 Then the people rejoiced, for that they offered willingly, because with perfect heart they offered willingly to the LORD: and David the king also rejoiced with great joy.
- 13_1CH_29_10 Wherefore David blessed the LORD before all the congregation: and David said, Blessed [be] thou, LORD God of Israel our father, for ever and ever.
- 13_1CH_29_11 Thine, O LORD, [is] the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all [that is] in the heaven and in the earth [is thine]; thine [is] the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all.
- 13_1CH_29_12 Both riches and honour [come] of thee, and thou reignest over all; and in thine hand [is] power and might; and in thine hand [it is] to make great, and to give strength unto all.
- 13_1CH_29_13 Now therefore, our God, we thank thee, and praise thy glorious name.
- 13_1CH_29_14 But who [am] I, and what [is] my people, that we should be able to offer so willingly after this sort? for all things [come] of thee, and of thine own have we given thee.
- 13_1CH_29_15 For we [are] strangers before thee, and sojourners, as [were] all our fathers: our days on the earth [are] as a shadow, and [there is] none abiding.
- 13_1CH_29_16 O LORD our God, all this store that we have prepared to build thee an house for thine holy name [cometh] of thine hand, and [is] all thine own.
- 13_1CH_29_17 I know also, my God, that thou triest the heart, and hast pleasure in uprightness. As for me, in the uprightness of mine heart I have willingly offered all these things: and now have I seen with joy thy people, which are present here, to offer willingly unto thee.
- 13_1CH_29_18 O LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, our fathers, keep this for ever in the imagination of the thoughts of the heart of thy people, and prepare their heart unto thee:
- 13_1CH_29_19 And give unto Solomon my son a perfect heart, to keep thy commandments, thy testimonies, and thy statutes, and to do all [these things], and to build the palace, [for] the which I have made provision.
- 13_1CH_29_20 And David said to all the congregation, Now bless the LORD your God. And all the congregation blessed the LORD God of their fathers, and bowed down their heads, and worshipped the LORD, and the king.
- 13_1CH_29_21 And they sacrificed sacrifices unto the LORD, and offered burnt offerings unto the LORD, on the morrow after that day, [even] a thousand bullocks, a thousand rams, [and] a thousand lambs, with their drink offerings, and sacrifices in abundance for all Israel:
- 13_1CH_29_22 And did eat and drink before the LORD on that day with great gladness. And they made Solomon the son of David king the second time, and anointed [him] unto the LORD [to be] the chief governor, and Zadok [to be] priest.
- 13_1CH_29_23 Then Solomon sat on the throne of the LORD as king instead of David his father, and prospered; and all Israel obeyed him.
- 13_1CH_29_24 And all the princes, and the mighty men, and all the sons likewise of king David, submitted themselves unto Solomon the king.
- 13_1CH_29_25 And the LORD magnified Solomon exceedingly in the sight of all Israel, and bestowed upon him [such] royal majesty as had not been on any king before him in Israel.
- 13_1CH_29_26 Thus David the son of Jesse reigned over all Israel.
