

Complete KJV Holy Bible

16_NEH_01_01 The words of Nehemiah the son of Hachaliah. And it came to pass in the month Chisleu, in the twentieth year, as I was in Shushan the palace,

16_NEH_01_02 That Hanani, one of my brethren, came, he and [certain] men of Judah; and I asked them concerning the Jews that had escaped, which were left of the captivity, and concerning Jerusalem.

16_NEH_01_03 And they said unto me, The remnant that are left of the captivity there in the province [are] in great affliction and reproach: the wall of Jerusalem also [is] broken down, and the gates thereof are burned with fire.

16_NEH_01_04 And it came to pass, when I heard these words, that I sat down and wept, and mourned [certain] days, and fasted, and prayed before the God of heaven,

16_NEH_01_05 And said, I beseech thee, O LORD God of heaven, the great and terrible God, that keepeth covenant and mercy for them that love him and observe his commandments:

16_NEH_01_06 Let thine ear now be attentive, and thine eyes open, that thou mayest hear the prayer of thy servant, which I pray before thee now, day and night, for the children of Israel thy servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel, which we have sinned against thee: both I and my father's house have sinned.

16_NEH_01_07 We have dealt very corruptly against thee, and have not kept the commandments, nor the statutes, nor the judgments, which thou commandedst thy servant Moses.

16_NEH_01_08 Remember, I beseech thee, the word that thou commandedst thy servant Moses, saying, [If] ye transgress, I will scatter you abroad among the nations:

16_NEH_01_09 But [if] ye turn unto me, and keep my commandments, and do them; though there were of you cast out unto the uttermost part of the heaven, [yet] will I gather them from thence, and will bring them unto the place that I have chosen to set my name there.

16_NEH_01_10 Now these [are] thy servants and thy people, whom thou hast redeemed by thy great power, and by thy strong hand.

16_NEH_01_11 O Lord, I beseech thee, let now thine ear be attentive to the prayer of thy servant, and to the prayer of thy servants, who desire to fear thy name: and prosper, I pray thee, thy servant this day, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man. For I was the king's cupbearer.

16_NEH_02_01 And it came to pass in the month Nisan, in the twentieth year of Artaxerxes the king, [that] wine [was] before him: and I took up the wine, and gave [it] unto the king. Now I had not been [beforetime] sad in his presence.

16_NEH_02_02 Wherefore the king said unto me, Why [is] thy countenance sad, seeing thou [art] not sick? this [is] nothing [else] but sorrow of heart. Then I was very sore afraid,

16_NEH_02_03 And said unto the king, Let the king live for ever: why should not my countenance be sad, when the city, the place of my fathers' sepulchres, [lieth] waste, and the gates thereof are consumed with fire?

16_NEH_02_04 Then the king said unto me, For what dost thou make request? So I prayed to the God of heaven.

16_NEH_02_05 And I said unto the king, If it please the king, and if thy servant have found favour in thy sight, that thou wouldest send me unto Judah, unto the city of my fathers' sepulchres, that I may build it.

16_NEH_02_06 And the king said unto me, [the queen also sitting by him,] For how long shall thy journey be? and when wilt thou return? So it pleased the king to send me; and I set him a time.

16_NEH_02_07 Moreover I said unto the king, If it please the king, let letters be given me to the governors beyond the river, that they may convey me over till I come into Judah;

16_NEH_02_08 And a letter unto Asaph the keeper of the king's forest, that he may give me timber to make beams for the gates of the palace which [appertained] to the house, and for the wall of the city, and for the house that I shall enter into. And the king granted me, according to the good hand of my God upon me.

16_NEH_02_09 Then I came to the governors beyond the river, and gave them the king's letters. Now the king had sent captains of the army and horsemen with me.

16_NEH_02_10 When Sanballat the Horonite, and Tobiah the servant, the Ammonite, heard [of it], it grieved them exceedingly that there was come a man to seek the welfare of the children of Israel.

16_NEH_02_11 So I came to Jerusalem, and was there three days.

16_NEH_02_12 And I arose in the night, I and some few men with me; neither told I [any] man what my God had put in my heart to do at Jerusalem: neither [was there any] beast with me, save the beast that I rode upon.

16_NEH_02_13 And I went out by night by the gate of the valley, even before the dragon well, and to the dung port, and viewed the walls of Jerusalem, which were broken down, and the gates thereof were consumed with fire.

16_NEH_02_14 Then I went on to the gate of the fountain, and to the king's pool: but [there was] no place for the beast [that was] under me to pass.

16_NEH_02_15 Then went I up in the night by the brook, and viewed the wall, and turned back, and entered by the gate of the valley, and [so] returned.

16_NEH_02_16 And the rulers knew not whither I went, or what I did; neither had I as yet told [it] to the Jews, nor to the priests, nor to the nobles, nor to the rulers, nor to the rest that did the work.

16_NEH_02_17 Then said I unto them, Ye see the distress that we [are] in, how Jerusalem [lieth] waste, and the gates thereof are burned with fire: come, and let us build up the wall of Jerusalem, that we be no more a reproach.

16_NEH_02_18 Then I told them of the hand of my God which was good upon me; as also the king's words that he had spoken unto me. And they said, Let us rise up and build. So they strengthened their hands for [this] good [work].

16_NEH_02_19 But when Sanballat the Horonite, and Tobiah the servant, the Ammonite, and Geshem the Arabian, heard [it], they laughed us to scorn, and despised us, and said, What [is] this thing that ye do? will ye rebel against the king?

16_NEH_02_20 Then answered I them, and said unto them, The God of heaven, he will prosper us; therefore we his servants will arise and build: but ye have no portion, nor right, nor memorial, in Jerusalem.

16_NEH_03_01 Then Eliashib the high priest rose up with his brethren the priests, and they builded the sheep gate; they sanctified it, and set up the doors of it; even unto the tower of Meah they sanctified it, unto the tower of Hananeel.

16_NEH_03_02 And next unto him builded the men of Jericho. And next to them builded Zaccur the son of Imri.

16_NEH_03_03 But the fish gate did the sons of Hassenaah build, who [also] laid the beams thereof, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof.

16_NEH_03_04 And next unto them repaired Meremoth the son of Urijah, the son of Koz. And next unto them repaired Meshullam the son of Berechiah, the son of Meshezabeel. And next unto them repaired Zadok the son of Baana.

16_NEH_03_05 And next unto them the Tekoites repaired; but their nobles put not their necks to the work of their Lord.

16_NEH_03_06 Moreover the old gate repaired Jehoiada the son of Paseah, and Meshullam the son of Besodeiah; they laid the beams thereof, and set up the doors thereof, and the locks thereof, and the bars thereof.

16_NEH_03_07 And next unto them repaired Melatiah the Gibeonite, and Jadon the Meronothite, the men of Gibeon, and of Mizpah, unto the throne of the governor on this side the river.

16_NEH_03_08 Next unto him repaired Uzziel the son of Harhaiah, of the goldsmiths. Next unto him also repaired Hananiah the son of [one of] the apothecaries, and they fortified Jerusalem unto the broad wall.

16_NEH_03_09 And next unto them repaired Rephaiah the son of Hur, the ruler of the half part of Jerusalem.

16_NEH_03_10 And next unto them repaired Jedaiah the son of Harumaph, even over against his house. And next unto him repaired Hattush the son of Hashabniah.

16_NEH_03_11 Malchijah the son of Harim, and Hashub the son of Pahathmoab, repaired the other piece, and the tower of the furnaces.

16_NEH_03_12 And next unto him repaired Shallum the son of Halohesh, the ruler of the half part of Jerusalem, he and his daughters.

16_NEH_03_13 The valley gate repaired Hanun, and the inhabitants of Zanoah; they built it, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof, and a thousand cubits on the wall unto the dung gate.

16_NEH_03_14 But the dung gate repaired Malchiah the son of Rechab, the ruler of part of Bethhaccerem; he built it, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof.

16_NEH_03_15 But the gate of the fountain repaired Shallun the son of Colhozeh, the ruler of part of Mizpah; he built it, and covered it, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof, and the wall of the pool of Siloah by the king's garden, and unto the stairs that go down from the city of David.

16_NEH_03_16 After him repaired Nehemiah the son of Azbuk, the ruler of the half part of Bethzur, unto [the place] over against the sepulchres of David, and to the pool that was made, and unto the house of the mighty.

16_NEH_03_17 After him repaired the Levites, Rehum the son of Bani. Next unto him repaired Hashabiah, the ruler of the half part of Keilah, in his part.

16_NEH_03_18 After him repaired their brethren, Bavai the son of Henadad, the ruler of the half part of Keilah.

16_NEH_03_19 And next to him repaired Ezer the son of Jeshua, the ruler of Mizpah, another piece over against the going up to the armoury at the turning [of the wall].

16_NEH_03_20 After him Baruch the son of Zabbai earnestly repaired the other piece, from the turning [of the wall] unto the door of the house of Eliashib the high priest.

16_NEH_03_21 After him repaired Meremoth the son of Urijah the son of Koz another piece, from the door of the house of Eliashib even to the end of the house of Eliashib.

16_NEH_03_22 And after him repaired the priests, the men of the plain.

16_NEH_03_23 After him repaired Benjamin and Hashub over against their house. After him repaired Azariah the son of Maaseiah the son of Ananiah by his house.

16_NEH_03_24 After him repaired Binnui the son of Henadad another piece, from the house of Azariah unto the turning [of the wall], even unto the corner.

16_NEH_03_25 Palal the son of Uzai, over against the turning [of the wall], and the tower which lieth out from the king's high house, that [was] by the court of the prison. After him Pedaiah the son of Parosh.

16_NEH_03_26 Moreover the Nethinims dwelt in Ophel, unto [the place] over against the water gate toward the east, and the tower that lieth out.

16_NEH_03_27 After them the Tekoites repaired another piece, over against the great tower that lieth out, even unto the wall of Ophel.

16_NEH_03_28 From above the horse gate repaired the priests, every one over against his house.

16_NEH_03_29 After them repaired Zadok the son of Immer over against his house. After him repaired also Shemaiah the son of Shechaniah, the keeper of the east gate.

16_NEH_03_30 After him repaired Hananiah the son of Shelemiah, and Hanun the sixth son of Zalaph, another piece. After him repaired Meshullam the son of Berechiah over against his chamber.

16_NEH_03_31 After him repaired Malchiah the goldsmith's son unto the place of the Nethinims, and of the merchants, over against the gate Miphkad, and to the going up of the corner.

16_NEH_03_32 And between the going up of the corner unto the sheep gate repaired the goldsmiths and the merchants.

16_NEH_04_01 But it came to pass, that when Sanballat heard that we builded the wall, he was wroth, and took great indignation, and mocked the Jews.

16_NEH_04_02 And he spake before his brethren and the army of Samaria, and said, What do these feeble Jews? will they fortify themselves? will they sacrifice? will they make an end in a day? will they revive the stones out of the heaps of the rubbish which are burned?

16_NEH_04_03 Now Tobiah the Ammonite [was] by him, and he said, Even that which they build, if a fox go up, he shall even break down their stone wall.

16_NEH_04_04 Hear, O our God; for we are despised: and turn their reproach upon their own head, and give them for a prey in the land of captivity:

16_NEH_04_05 And cover not their iniquity, and let not their sin be blotted out from before thee: for they have provoked [thee] to anger before the builders.

16_NEH_04_06 So built we the wall; and all the wall was joined together unto the half thereof: for the people had a mind to work.

16_NEH_04_07 But it came to pass, [that] when Sanballat, and Tobiah, and the Arabians, and the Ammonites, and the Ashdodites, heard that the walls of Jerusalem were made up, [and] that the breaches began to be stopped, then they were very wroth,

16_NEH_04_08 And conspired all of them together to come [and] to fight against Jerusalem, and to hinder it.

16_NEH_04_09 Nevertheless we made our prayer unto our God, and set a watch against them day and night, because of them.

16_NEH_04_10 And Judah said, The strength of the bearers of burdens is decayed, and [there is] much rubbish; so that we are not able to build the wall.

16_NEH_04_11 And our adversaries said, They shall not know, neither see, till we come in the midst among them, and slay them, and cause the work to cease.

16_NEH_04_12 And it came to pass, that when the Jews which dwelt by them came, they said unto us ten times, From all places whence ye shall return unto us [they will be upon you].

16_NEH_04_13 Therefore set I in the lower places behind the wall, [and] on the higher places, I even set the people after their families with their swords, their spears, and their bows.

16_NEH_04_14 And I looked, and rose up, and said unto the nobles, and to the rulers, and to the rest of the people, Be not ye afraid of them: remember the Lord, [which is] great and terrible, and fight for your brethren, your sons, and your daughters, your wives, and your houses.

16_NEH_04_15 And it came to pass, when our enemies heard that it was known unto us, and God had brought their counsel to nought, that we returned all of us to the wall, every one unto his work.

16_NEH_04_16 And it came to pass from that time forth, [that] the half of my servants wrought in the work, and the other half of them held both the spears, the shields, and the bows, and the habergeons; and the rulers [were] behind all the house of Judah.

16_NEH_04_17 They which builded on the wall, and they that bare burdens, with those that laded, [every one] with one of his hands wrought in the work, and with the other [hand] held a weapon.

16_NEH_04_18 For the builders, every one had his sword girded by his side, and [so] builded. And he that sounded the trumpet [was] by me.

16_NEH_04_19 And I said unto the nobles, and to the rulers, and to the rest of the people, The work [is] great and large, and we are separated upon the wall, one far from another.

16_NEH_04_20 In what place [therefore] ye hear the sound of the trumpet, resort ye thither unto us: our God shall fight for us.

16_NEH_04_21 So we laboured in the work: and half of them held the spears from the rising of the morning till the stars appeared.

16_NEH_04_22 Likewise at the same time said I unto the people, Let every one with his servant lodge within Jerusalem, that in the night they may be a guard to us, and labour on the day.

16_NEH_04_23 So neither I, nor my brethren, nor my servants, nor the men of the guard which followed me, none of us put off our clothes, [saving that] every one put them off for washing.

16_NEH_05_01 And there was a great cry of the people and of their wives against their brethren the Jews.

16_NEH_05_02 For there were that said, We, our sons, and our daughters, [are] many: therefore we take up corn [for them], that we may eat, and live.

16_NEH_05_03 [Some] also there were that said, We have mortgaged our lands, vineyards, and houses, that we might buy corn, because of the dearth.

16_NEH_05_04 There were also that said, We have borrowed money for the king's tribute, [and that upon] our lands and vineyards.

16_NEH_05_05 Yet now our flesh [is] as the flesh of our brethren, our children as their children: and, lo, we bring into bondage our sons and our daughters to be servants, and [some] of our daughters are brought unto bondage [already]: neither [is it] in our power [to redeem them]; for other men have our lands and vineyards.

16_NEH_05_06 And I was very angry when I heard their cry and these words.

16_NEH_05_07 Then I consulted with myself, and I rebuked the nobles, and the rulers, and said unto them, Ye exact usury, every one of his brother. And I set a great assembly against them.

16_NEH_05_08 And I said unto them, We after our ability have redeemed our brethren the Jews, which were sold unto the heathen; and will ye even sell your brethren? or shall they be sold unto us? Then held they their peace, and found nothing [to answer].

16_NEH_05_09 Also I said, It [is] not good that ye do: ought ye not to walk in the fear of our God because of the reproach of the heathen our enemies?

16_NEH_05_10 I likewise, [and] my brethren, and my servants, might exact of them money and corn: I pray you, let us leave off this usury.

16_NEH_05_11 Restore, I pray you, to them, even this day, their lands, their vineyards, their oliveyards, and their houses, also the hundredth [part] of the money, and of the corn, the wine, and the oil, that ye exact of them.

16_NEH_05_12 Then said they, We will restore [them], and will require nothing of them; so will we do as thou sayest. Then I called the priests, and took an oath of them, that they should do according to this promise.

16_NEH_05_13 Also I shook my lap, and said, So God shake out every man from his house, and from his labour, that performeth not this promise, even thus be he shaken out, and emptied. And all the congregation said, Amen, and praised the LORD. And the people did according to this promise.

16_NEH_05_14 Moreover from the time that I was appointed to be their governor in the land of Judah, from the twentieth year even unto the two and thirtieth year of Artaxerxes the king, [that is], twelve years, I and my brethren have not eaten the bread of the governor.

16_NEH_05_15 But the former governors that [had been] before me were chargeable unto the people, and had taken of them bread and wine, beside forty shekels of silver; yea, even their servants bare rule over the people: but so did not I, because of the fear of God.

16_NEH_05_16 Yea, also I continued in the work of this wall, neither bought we any land: and all my servants [were] gathered thither unto the work.

16_NEH_05_17 Moreover [there were] at my table an hundred and fifty of the Jews and rulers, beside those that came unto us from among the heathen that [are] about us.

16_NEH_05_18 Now [that] which was prepared [for me] daily [was] one ox [and] six choice sheep; also fowls were prepared for me, and once in ten days store of all sorts of wine: yet for all this required not I the bread of the governor, because the bondage was heavy upon this people.

16_NEH_05_19 Think upon me, my God, for good, [according] to all that I have done for this people.

16_NEH_06_01 Now it came to pass, when Sanballat, and Tobiah, and Geshem the Arabian, and the rest of our enemies, heard that I had builded the wall, and [that] there was no breach left therein; [though at that time I had not set up the doors upon the gates;]

16_NEH_06_02 That Sanballat and Geshem sent unto me, saying, Come, let us meet together in [some one of] the villages in the plain of Ono. But they thought to do me mischief.

16_NEH_06_03 And I sent messengers unto them, saying, I [am] doing a great work, so that I cannot come down: why should the work cease, whilst I leave it, and come down to you?

16_NEH_06_04 Yet they sent unto me four times after this sort; and I answered them after the same manner.

16_NEH_06_05 Then sent Sanballat his servant unto me in like manner the fifth time with an open letter in his hand;

16_NEH_06_06 Wherein [was] written, It is reported among the heathen, and Gashmu saith [it, that] thou and the Jews think to rebel: for which cause thou buildest the wall, that thou mayest be their king, according to these words.

16_NEH_06_07 And thou hast also appointed prophets to preach of thee at Jerusalem, saying, [There is] a king in Judah: and now shall it be reported to the king according to these words. Come now therefore, and let us take counsel together.

16_NEH_06_08 Then I sent unto him, saying, There are no such things done as thou sayest, but thou feignest them out of thine own heart.

16_NEH_06_09 For they all made us afraid, saying, Their hands shall be weakened from the work, that it be not done. Now therefore, [O God], strengthen my hands.

16_NEH_06_10 Afterward I came unto the house of Shemaiah the son of Delaiah the son of Mehetabeel, who [was] shut up; and he said, Let us meet together in the house of God, within the temple, and let us shut the doors of the temple: for they will come to slay thee; yea, in the night will they come to slay thee.

16_NEH_06_11 And I said, Should such a man as I flee? and who [is there], that, [being] as I [am], would go into the temple to save his life? I will not go in.

16_NEH_06_12 And, lo, I perceived that God had not sent him; but that he pronounced this prophecy against me: for Tobiah and Sanballat had hired him.

16_NEH_06_13 Therefore [was] he hired, that I should be afraid, and do so, and sin, and [that] they might have [matter] for an evil report, that they might reproach me.

16_NEH_06_14 My God, think thou upon Tobiah and Sanballat according to these their works, and on the prophetess Noadiah, and the rest of the prophets, that would have put me in fear.

16_NEH_06_15 So the wall was finished in the twenty and fifth [day] of [the month] Elul, in fifty and two days.

16_NEH_06_16 And it came to pass, that when all our enemies heard [thereof], and all the heathen that [were] about us saw [these things], they were much cast down in their own eyes: for they perceived that this work was wrought of our God.

16_NEH_06_17 Moreover in those days the nobles of Judah sent many letters unto Tobiah, and [the letters] of Tobiah came unto them.

16_NEH_06_18 For [there were] many in Judah sworn unto him, because he [was] the son in law of Shechaniah the son of Arah; and his son Johanan had taken the daughter of Meshullam the son of Berechiah.

16_NEH_06_19 Also they reported his good deeds before me, and uttered my words to him. [And] Tobiah sent letters to put me in fear.

16_NEH_07_01 Now it came to pass, when the wall was built, and I had set up the doors, and the porters and the singers and the Levites were appointed,

16_NEH_07_02 That I gave my brother Hanani, and Hananiah the ruler of the palace, charge over Jerusalem: for he [was] a faithful man, and feared God above many.

16_NEH_07_03 And I said unto them, Let not the gates of Jerusalem be opened until the sun be hot; and while they stand by, let them shut the doors, and bar [them]: and appoint watches of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, every one in his watch, and every one [to be] over against his house.

16_NEH_07_04 Now the city [was] large and great: but the people [were] few therein, and the houses [were] not builded.

16_NEH_07_05 And my God put into mine heart to gather together the nobles, and the rulers, and the people, that they might be reckoned by genealogy. And I found a register of the genealogy of them which came up at the first, and found written therein,

16_NEH_07_06 These [are] the children of the province, that went up out of the captivity, of those that had been carried away, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had carried away, and came again to Jerusalem and to Judah, every one unto his city;

16_NEH_07_07 Who came with Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Azariah, Raamiah, Nahamani, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mispereth, Bigvai, Nehum, Baanah. The number, [I say], of the men of the people of Israel [was this];

16_NEH_07_08 The children of Parosh, two thousand an hundred seventy and two.

16_NEH_07_09 The children of Shephatiah, three hundred seventy and two.

16_NEH_07_10 The children of Arah, six hundred fifty and two.

16_NEH_07_11 The children of Pahathmoab, of the children of Jeshua and Joab, two thousand and eight hundred [and] eighteen.

16_NEH_07_12 The children of Elam, a thousand two hundred fifty and four.

16_NEH_07_13 The children of Zattu, eight hundred forty and five.

16_NEH_07_14 The children of Zaccai, seven hundred and threescore.

16_NEH_07_15 The children of Binnui, six hundred forty and eight.

16_NEH_07_16 The children of Bebai, six hundred twenty and eight.

16_NEH_07_17 The children of Azgad, two thousand three hundred twenty and two.

16_NEH_07_18 The children of Adonikam, six hundred threescore and seven.

16_NEH_07_19 The children of Bigvai, two thousand threescore and seven.

16_NEH_07_20 The children of Adin, six hundred fifty and five.

16_NEH_07_21 The children of Ater of Hezekiah, ninety and eight.

16_NEH_07_22 The children of Hashum, three hundred twenty and eight.

16_NEH_07_23 The children of Bezai, three hundred twenty and four.

16_NEH_07_24 The children of Hariph, an hundred and twelve.

16_NEH_07_25 The children of Gibeon, ninety and five.

16_NEH_07_26 The men of Bethlehem and Netophah, an hundred fourscore and eight.

16_NEH_07_27 The men of Anathoth, an hundred twenty and eight.

16_NEH_07_28 The men of Bethazmaveth, forty and two.

16_NEH_07_29 The men of Kirjathjearim, Chephirah, and Beeroth, seven hundred forty and three.

16_NEH_07_30 The men of Ramah and Gaba, six hundred twenty and one.

16_NEH_07_31 The men of Michmas, an hundred and twenty and two.

16_NEH_07_32 The men of Bethel and Ai, an hundred twenty and three.

16_NEH_07_33 The men of the other Nebo, fifty and two.

16_NEH_07_34 The children of the other Elam, a thousand two hundred fifty and four.

16_NEH_07_35 The children of Harim, three hundred and twenty.

16_NEH_07_36 The children of Jericho, three hundred forty and five.

16_NEH_07_37 The children of Lod, Hadid, and Ono, seven hundred twenty and one.

16_NEH_07_38 The children of Senaah, three thousand nine hundred and thirty.

16_NEH_07_39 The priests: the children of Jedaiah, of the house of Jeshua, nine hundred seventy and three.

16_NEH_07_40 The children of Immer, a thousand fifty and two.

16_NEH_07_41 The children of Pashur, a thousand two hundred forty and seven.

16_NEH_07_42 The children of Harim, a thousand and seventeen.

16_NEH_07_43 The Levites: the children of Jeshua, of Kadmiel, [and] of the children of Hodevah, seventy and four.

16_NEH_07_44 The singers: the children of Asaph, an hundred forty and eight.

16_NEH_07_45 The porters: the children of Shallum, the children of Ater, the children of Talmon, the children of Akkub, the children of Hatita, the children of Shobai, an hundred thirty and eight.

16_NEH_07_46 The Nethinims: the children of Ziha, the children of Hashupha, the children of Tabbaoth,

16_NEH_07_47 The children of Keros, the children of Sia, the children of Padon,

16_NEH_07_48 The children of Lebana, the children of Hagaba, the children of Shalmi,

16_NEH_07_49 The children of Hanan, the children of Giddel, the children of Gahar,

16_NEH_07_50 The children of Reaiah, the children of Rezin, the children of Nekoda,

16_NEH_07_51 The children of Gazzam, the children of Uzza, the children of Phaseah,

16_NEH_07_52 The children of Besai, the children of Meunim, the children of Nephishesim,

16_NEH_07_53 The children of Bakbuk, the children of Hakupha, the children of Harhur,

16_NEH_07_54 The children of Bazlith, the children of Mehida, the children of Harsha,

16_NEH_07_55 The children of Barkos, the children of Sisera, the children of Tamah,

16_NEH_07_56 The children of Neziah, the children of Hatipha.

16_NEH_07_57 The children of Solomon's servants: the children of Sotai, the children of Sophereth, the children of Perida,

16_NEH_07_58 The children of Jaala, the children of Darkon, the children of Giddel,

16_NEH_07_59 The children of Shephatiah, the children of Hattil, the children of Pochereth of Zebaim, the children of Amon.

16_NEH_07_60 All the Nethinims, and the children of Solomon's servants, [were] three hundred ninety and two.

16_NEH_07_61 And these [were] they which went up [also] from Telmelah, Telharsa, Cherub, Addon, and Immer: but they could not show their father's house, nor their seed, whether they [were] of Israel.

16_NEH_07_62 The children of Delaiah, the children of Tobiah, the children of Nekoda, six hundred forty and two.

16_NEH_07_63 And of the priests: the children of Habaiah, the children of Koz, the children of Barzillai, which took [one] of the daughters of Barzillai the Gileadite to wife, and was called after their name.

16_NEH_07_64 These sought their register [among] those that were reckoned by genealogy, but it was not found: therefore were they, as polluted, put from the priesthood.

16_NEH_07_65 And the Tirshatha said unto them, that they should not eat of the most holy things, till there stood [up] a priest with Urim and Thummim.

16_NEH_07_66 The whole congregation together [was] forty and two thousand three hundred and threescore,

16_NEH_07_67 Beside their manservants and their maidservants, of whom [there were] seven thousand three hundred thirty and seven: and they had two hundred forty and five singing men and singing women.

16_NEH_07_68 Their horses, seven hundred thirty and six: their mules, two hundred forty and five:

16_NEH_07_69 [Their] camels, four hundred thirty and five: six thousand seven hundred and twenty asses.

16_NEH_07_70 And some of the chief of the fathers gave unto the work. The Tirshatha gave to the treasure a thousand drams of gold, fifty basins, five hundred and thirty priests' garments.

16_NEH_07_71 And [some] of the chief of the fathers gave to the treasure of the work twenty thousand drams of gold, and two thousand and two hundred pound of silver.

16_NEH_07_72 And [that] which the rest of the people gave [was] twenty thousand drams of gold, and two thousand pound of silver, and threescore and seven priests' garments.

16_NEH_07_73 So the priests, and the Levites, and the porters, and the singers, and [some] of the people, and the Nethinims, and all Israel, dwelt in their cities; and when the seventh month came, the children of Israel [were] in their cities.

16_NEH_08_01 And all the people gathered themselves together as one man into the street that [was] before the water gate; and they spake unto Ezra the scribe to bring the book of the law of Moses, which the LORD had commanded to Israel.

16_NEH_08_02 And Ezra the priest brought the law before the congregation both of men and women, and all that could hear with understanding, upon the first day of the seventh month.

16_NEH_08_03 And he read therein before the street that [was] before the water gate from the morning until midday, before the men and the women, and those that could understand; and the ears of all the people [were attentive] unto the book of the law.

16_NEH_08_04 And Ezra the scribe stood upon a pulpit of wood, which they had made for the purpose; and beside him stood Mattithiah, and Shema, and Anaiah, and Urijah, and Hilkiyah, and Maaseiah, on his right hand; and on his left hand, Pedaiah, and Mishael, and Malchiah, and Hashum, and Hashbadana, Zechariah, [and] Meshullam.

16_NEH_08_05 And Ezra opened the book in the sight of all the people; [for he was above all the people;] and when he opened it, all the people stood up:

16_NEH_08_06 And Ezra blessed the LORD, the great God. And all the people answered, Amen, Amen, with lifting up their hands: and they bowed their heads, and worshipped the LORD with [their] faces to the ground.

16_NEH_08_07 Also Jeshua, and Bani, and Sherebiah, Jamin, Akkub, Shabbethai, Hodijah, Maaseiah, Kelita, Azariah, Jozabad, Hanan, Pelaiah, and the Levites, caused the people to understand the law: and the people [stood] in their place.

16_NEH_08_08 So they read in the book in the law of God distinctly, and gave the sense, and caused [them] to understand the reading.

16_NEH_08_09 And Nehemiah, which [is] the Tirshatha, and Ezra the priest the scribe, and the Levites that taught the people, said unto all the people, This day [is] holy unto the LORD your God; mourn not, nor weep. For all the people wept, when they heard the words of the law.

16_NEH_08_10 Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for [this] day [is] holy unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the LORD is your strength.

16_NEH_08_11 So the Levites stilled all the people, saying, Hold your peace, for the day [is] holy; neither be ye grieved.

16_NEH_08_12 And all the people went their way to eat, and to drink, and to send portions, and to make great mirth, because they had understood the words that were declared unto them.

16_NEH_08_13 And on the second day were gathered together the chief of the fathers of all the people, the priests, and the Levites, unto Ezra the scribe, even to understand the words of the law.

16_NEH_08_14 And they found written in the law which the LORD had commanded by Moses, that the children of Israel should dwell in booths in the feast of the seventh month:

16_NEH_08_15 And that they should publish and proclaim in all their cities, and in Jerusalem, saying, Go forth unto the mount, and fetch olive branches, and pine branches, and myrtle branches, and palm branches, and branches of thick trees, to make booths, as [it is] written.

16_NEH_08_16 So the people went forth, and brought [them], and made themselves booths, every one upon the roof of his house, and in their courts, and in the courts of the house of God, and in the street of the water gate, and in the street of the gate of Ephraim.

16_NEH_08_17 And all the congregation of them that were come again out of the captivity made booths, and sat under the booths: for since the days of Jeshua the son of Nun unto that day had not the children of Israel done so. And there was very great gladness.

16_NEH_08_18 Also day by day, from the first day unto the last day, he read in the book of the law of God. And they kept the feast seven days; and on the eighth day [was] a solemn assembly, according unto the manner.

16_NEH_09_01 Now in the twenty and fourth day of this month the children of Israel were assembled with fasting, and with sackclothes, and earth upon them.

16_NEH_09_06 Thou, [even] thou, [art] LORD alone; thou hast made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth, and all [things] that [are] therein, the seas, and all that [is] therein, and thou preservest them all; and the host of heaven worshippeth thee.

16_NEH_09_07 Thou [art] the LORD the God, who didst choose Abram, and broughtest him forth out of Ur of the Chaldees, and gavest him the name of Abraham;

16_NEH_09_08 And foundest his heart faithful before thee, and madest a covenant with him to give the land of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Jebusites, and the Girgashites, to give [it, I say], to his seed, and hast performed thy words; for thou [art] righteous:

16_NEH_09_09 And didst see the affliction of our fathers in Egypt, and heardest their cry by the Red sea;

16_NEH_09_10 And showedst signs and wonders upon Pharaoh, and on all his servants, and on all the people of his land: for thou knewest that they dealt proudly against them. So didst thou get thee a name, as [it is] this day.

16_NEH_09_11 And thou didst divide the sea before them, so that they went through the midst of the sea on the dry land; and their persecutors thou threwest into the deeps, as a stone into the mighty waters.

16_NEH_09_12 Moreover thou leddest them in the day by a cloudy pillar; and in the night by a pillar of fire, to give them light in the way wherein they should go.

16_NEH_09_13 Thou camest down also upon mount Sinai, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right judgments, and true laws, good statutes and commandments:

16_NEH_09_14 And madest known unto them thy holy sabbath, and commandedst them precepts, statutes, and laws, by the hand of Moses thy servant:

16_NEH_09_15 And gavest them bread from heaven for their hunger, and broughtest forth water for them out of the rock for their thirst, and promisedst them that they should go in to possess the land which thou hadst sworn to give them.

16_NEH_09_16 But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to thy commandments,

16_NEH_09_17 And refused to obey, neither were mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou [art] a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not.

16_NEH_09_18 Yea, when they had made them a molten calf, and said, This [is] thy God that brought thee up out of Egypt, and had wrought great provocations;

16_NEH_09_19 Yet thou in thy manifold mercies forsookest them not in the wilderness: the pillar of the cloud departed not from them by day, to lead them in the way; neither the pillar of fire by night, to show them light, and the way wherein they should go.

16_NEH_09_20 Thou gavest also thy good spirit to instruct them, and withheldest not thy manna from their mouth, and gavest them water for their thirst.

16_NEH_09_21 Yea, forty years didst thou sustain them in the wilderness, [so that] they lacked nothing; their clothes waxed not old, and their feet swelled not.

16_NEH_09_22 Moreover thou gavest them kingdoms and nations, and didst divide them into corners: so they possessed the land of Sihon, and the land of the king of Heshbon, and the land of Og king of Bashan.

16_NEH_09_23 Their children also multipliedst thou as the stars of heaven, and broughtest them into the land, concerning which thou hadst promised to their fathers, that they should go in to possess [it].

16_NEH_09_24 So the children went in and possessed the land, and thou subduedst before them the inhabitants of the land, the Canaanites, and gavest them into their hands, with their kings, and the people of the land, that they might do with them as they would.

16_NEH_09_25 And they took strong cities, and a fat land, and possessed houses full of all goods, wells digged, vineyards, and oliveyards, and fruit trees in abundance: so they did eat, and were filled, and became fat, and delighted themselves in thy great goodness.

16_NEH_09_26 Nevertheless they were disobedient, and rebelled against thee, and cast thy law behind their backs, and slew thy prophets which testified against them to turn them to thee, and they wrought great provocations.

16_NEH_09_27 Therefore thou deliveredst them into the hand of their enemies, who vexed them: and in the time of their trouble, when they cried unto thee, thou heardest [them] from heaven; and according to thy manifold mercies thou gavest them saviours, who saved them out of the hand of their enemies.

16_NEH_09_28 But after they had rest, they did evil again before thee: therefore leftest thou them in the hand of their enemies, so that they had the dominion over them: yet when they returned, and cried unto thee, thou heardest [them] from heaven; and many times didst thou deliver them according to thy mercies;

16_NEH_09_29 And testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy judgments, [which if a man do, he shall live in them;] and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.

16_NEH_09_30 Yet many years didst thou forbear them, and testifiedst against them by thy spirit in thy prophets: yet would they not give ear: therefore gavest thou them into the hand of the people of the lands.

16_NEH_09_31 Nevertheless for thy great mercies' sake thou didst not utterly consume them, nor forsake them; for thou [art] a gracious and merciful God.

16_NEH_09_32 Now therefore, our God, the great, the mighty, and the terrible God, who keepest covenant and mercy, let not all the trouble seem little before thee, that hath come upon us, on our kings, on our princes, and on our priests, and on our prophets, and on our fathers, and on all thy people, since the time of the kings of Assyria unto this day.

16_NEH_09_33 Howbeit thou [art] just in all that is brought upon us; for thou hast done right, but we have done wickedly:

16_NEH_09_34 Neither have our kings, our princes, our priests, nor our fathers, kept thy law, nor hearkened unto thy commandments and thy testimonies, wherewith thou didst testify against them.

16_NEH_09_35 For they have not served thee in their kingdom, and in thy great goodness that thou gavest them, and in the large and fat land which thou gavest before them, neither turned they from their wicked works.

16_NEH_09_36 Behold, we [are] servants this day, and [for] the land that thou gavest unto our fathers to eat the fruit thereof and the good thereof, behold, we [are] servants in it:

16_NEH_09_37 And it yieldeth much increase unto the kings whom thou hast set over us because of our sins: also they have dominion over our bodies, and over our cattle, at their pleasure, and we [are] in great distress.

16_NEH_09_38 And because of all this we make a sure [covenant], and write [it]; and our princes, Levites, [and] priests, seal [unto it].

16_NEH_10_14 The chief of the people; Parosh, Pahathmoab, Elam, Zattu, Bani,

16_NEH_10_15 Bunni, Azgad, Bebai,

16_NEH_10_16 Adonijah, Bigvai, Adin,

16_NEH_10_17 Ater, Hizkijah, Azzur,

16_NEH_10_18 Hodijah, Hashum, Bezai,

16_NEH_10_19 Hariph, Anathoth, Nebai,

16_NEH_10_20 Magpiash, Meshullam, Hezir,

16_NEH_10_21 Meshezabeel, Zadok, Jaddua,

16_NEH_10_22 Pelatiah, Hanan, Anaiah,

16_NEH_10_23 Hoshea, Hananiah, Hashub,

16_NEH_10_24 Hallohesh, Pileha, Shobek,

16_NEH_10_25 Rehum, Hashabnah, Maaseiah,

16_NEH_10_26 And Ahijah, Hanan, Anan,

16_NEH_10_27 Malluch, Harim, Baanah.

16_NEH_10_28 And the rest of the people, the priests, the Levites, the porters, the singers, the Nethinims, and all they that had separated themselves from the people of the lands unto the law of God, their wives, their sons, and their daughters, every one having knowledge, and having understanding;

16_NEH_10_29 They clave to their brethren, their nobles, and entered into a curse, and into an oath, to walk in God's law, which was given by Moses the servant of God, and to observe and do all the commandments of the LORD our Lord, and his judgments and his statutes;

16_NEH_10_30 And that we would not give our daughters unto the people of the land, nor take their daughters for our sons:

16_NEH_10_31 And [if] the people of the land bring ware or any victuals on the sabbath day to sell, [that] we would not buy it of them on the sabbath, or on the holy day: and [that] we would leave the seventh year, and the exaction of every debt.

16_NEH_10_32 Also we made ordinances for us, to charge ourselves yearly with the third part of a shekel for the service of the house of our God;

16_NEH_10_33 For the showbread, and for the continual meat offering, and for the continual burnt offering, of the sabbaths, of the new moons, for the set feasts, and for the holy [things], and for the sin offerings to make an atonement for Israel, and [for] all the work of the house of our God.

16_NEH_10_34 And we cast the lots among the priests, the Levites, and the people, for the wood offering, to bring [it] into the house of our God, after the houses of our fathers, at times appointed year by year, to burn upon the altar of the LORD our God, as [it is] written in the law:

16_NEH_10_35 And to bring the firstfruits of our ground, and the firstfruits of all fruit of all trees, year by year, unto the house of the LORD:

16_NEH_10_36 Also the firstborn of our sons, and of our cattle, as [it is] written in the law, and the firstlings of our herds and of our flocks, to bring to the house of our God, unto the priests that minister in the house of our God:

16_NEH_10_37 And [that] we should bring the firstfruits of our dough, and our offerings, and the fruit of all manner of trees, of wine and of oil, unto the priests, to the chambers of the house of our God; and the tithes of our ground unto the Levites, that the same Levites might have the tithes in all the cities of our tillage.

16_NEH_10_38 And the priest the son of Aaron shall be with the Levites, when the Levites take tithes: and the Levites shall bring up the tithe of the tithes unto the house of our God, to the chambers, into the treasure house.

16_NEH_10_39 For the children of Israel and the children of Levi shall bring the offering of the corn, of the new wine, and the oil, unto the chambers, where [are] the vessels of the sanctuary, and the priests that minister, and the porters, and the singers: and we will not forsake the house of our God.

16_NEH_11_07 And these [are] the sons of Benjamin; Sallu the son of Meshullam, the son of Joed, the son of Pedaiah, the son of Kolaiah, the son of Maaseiah, the son of Ithiel, the son of Jesaiah.

16_NEH_11_08 And after him Gabbai, Sallai, nine hundred twenty and eight.

16_NEH_11_09 And Joel the son of Zichri [was] their overseer: and Judah the son of Senuah [was] second over the city.

16_NEH_11_10 Of the priests: Jedaiah the son of Joiarib, Jachin.

16_NEH_11_11 Seraiah the son of Hilkiyah, the son of Meshullam, the son of Zadok, the son of Meraioth, the son of Ahitub, [was] the ruler of the house of God.

16_NEH_11_12 And their brethren that did the work of the house [were] eight hundred twenty and two: and Adaiah the son of Jeroham, the son of Pelaliah, the son of Amzi, the son of Zechariah, the son of Pashur, the son of Malchiah,

16_NEH_11_13 And his brethren, chief of the fathers, two hundred forty and two: and Amashai the son of Azareel, the son of Ahasai, the son of Meshillemoth, the son of Immer,

16_NEH_11_14 And their brethren, mighty men of valour, an hundred twenty and eight: and their overseer [was] Zabdiel, the son of [one of] the great men.

16_NEH_11_15 Also of the Levites: Shemaiah the son of Hashub, the son of Azrikam, the son of Hashabiah, the son of Bunni;

16_NEH_11_16 And Shabbethai and Jozabad, of the chief of the Levites, [had] the oversight of the outward business of the house of God.

16_NEH_11_17 And Mattaniah the son of Micha, the son of Zabdi, the son of Asaph, [was] the principal to begin the thanksgiving in prayer: and Bakbukiah the second among his brethren, and Abda the son of Shammua, the son of Galal, the son of Jeduthun.

16_NEH_11_18 All the Levites in the holy city [were] two hundred fourscore and four.

16_NEH_11_19 Moreover the porters, Akkub, Talmon, and their brethren that kept the gates, [were] an hundred seventy and two.

16_NEH_11_20 And the residue of Israel, of the priests, [and] the Levites, [were] in all the cities of Judah, every one in his inheritance.

16_NEH_11_21 But the Nethinims dwelt in Ophel: and Ziha and Gispa [were] over the Nethinims.

16_NEH_11_22 The overseer also of the Levites at Jerusalem [was] Uzzi the son of Bani, the son of Hashabiah, the son of Mattaniah, the son of Micha. Of the sons of Asaph, the singers [were] over the business of the house of God.

16_NEH_11_23 For [it was] the king's commandment concerning them, that a certain portion should be for the singers, due for every day.

16_NEH_11_24 And Pethahiah the son of Meshezabeel, of the children of Zerah the son of Judah, [was] at the king's hand in all matters concerning the people.

16_NEH_11_25 And for the villages, with their fields, [some] of the children of Judah dwelt at Kirjatharba, and [in] the villages thereof, and at Dibon, and [in] the villages thereof, and at Jekabzeel, and [in] the villages thereof,

16_NEH_11_26 And at Jeshua, and at Moladah, and at Bethphelet,

16_NEH_11_27 And at Hazarshual, and at Beersheba, and [in] the villages thereof,

16_NEH_11_28 And at Ziklag, and at Mekonah, and in the villages thereof,

16_NEH_11_29 And at Enrimmon, and at Zareah, and at Jarmuth,

16_NEH_11_30 Zanoah, Adullam, and [in] their villages, at Lachish, and the fields thereof, at Azekah, and [in] the villages thereof. And they dwelt from Beersheba unto the valley of Hinnom.

16_NEH_11_31 The children also of Benjamin from Geba [dwelt] at Michmash, and Aija, and Bethel, and [in] their villages,

16_NEH_11_32 [And] at Anathoth, Nob, Ananiah,

16_NEH_11_33 Hazor, Ramah, Gittaim,

16_NEH_11_34 Hadid, Zeboim, Neballat,

16_NEH_11_35 Lod, and Ono, the valley of craftsmen.

16_NEH_11_36 And of the Levites [were] divisions [in] Judah, [and] in Benjamin.

16_NEH_12_09 Also Bakbukiah and Unni, their brethren, [were] over against them in the watches.

16_NEH_12_10 And Jeshua begat Joiakim, Joiakim also begat Eliashib, and Eliashib begat Joiada,

16_NEH_12_11 And Joiada begat Jonathan, and Jonathan begat Jaddua.

16_NEH_12_12 And in the days of Joiakim were priests, the chief of the fathers: of Seraiah, Meraiah; of Jeremiah, Hananiah;

16_NEH_12_13 Of Ezra, Meshullam; of Amariah, Jehohanan;

16_NEH_12_14 Of Melicu, Jonathan; of Shebaniah, Joseph;

16_NEH_12_15 Of Harim, Adna; of Meraioth, Helkai;

16_NEH_12_16 Of Iddo, Zechariah; of Ginnethon, Meshullam;

16_NEH_12_17 Of Abijah, Zichri; of Miniamin, of Moadiah, Piltai;

16_NEH_12_18 Of Bilgah, Shammua; of Shemaiah, Jehonathan;

16_NEH_12_19 And of Joiarib, Mattenai; of Jedaiah, Uzzi;

16_NEH_12_20 Of Sallai, Kallai; of Amok, Eber;

16_NEH_12_21 Of Hilkiyah, Hashabiah; of Jedaiah, Nethaneel.

16_NEH_12_22 The Levites in the days of Eliashib, Joiada, and Johanan, and Jaddua, [were] recorded chief of the fathers: also the priests, to the reign of Darius the Persian.

16_NEH_12_23 The sons of Levi, the chief of the fathers, [were] written in the book of the chronicles, even until the days of Johanan the son of Eliashib.

16_NEH_12_24 And the chief of the Levites: Hashabiah, Sherebiah, and Jeshua the son of Kadmiel, with their brethren over against them, to praise [and] to give thanks, according to the commandment of David the man of God, ward over against ward.

16_NEH_12_25 Mattaniah, and Bakbukiah, Obadiah, Meshullam, Talmon, Akkub, [were] porters keeping the ward at the thresholds of the gates.

16_NEH_12_26 These [were] in the days of Joiakim the son of Jeshua, the son of Jozadak, and in the days of Nehemiah the governor, and of Ezra the priest, the scribe.

16_NEH_12_27 And at the dedication of the wall of Jerusalem they sought the Levites out of all their places, to bring them to Jerusalem, to keep the dedication with gladness, both with thanksgivings, and with singing, [with] cymbals, psalteries, and with harps.

16_NEH_12_28 And the sons of the singers gathered themselves together, both out of the plain country round about Jerusalem, and from the villages of Netophathi;

16_NEH_12_29 Also from the house of Gilgal, and out of the fields of Geba and Azmaveth: for the singers had builded them villages round about Jerusalem.

16_NEH_12_30 And the priests and the Levites purified themselves, and purified the people, and the gates, and the wall.

16_NEH_12_31 Then I brought up the princes of Judah upon the wall, and appointed two great [companies of them that gave] thanks, [whereof one] went on the right hand upon the wall toward the dung gate:

16_NEH_12_32 And after them went Hoshaiah, and half of the princes of Judah,

16_NEH_12_33 And Azariah, Ezra, and Meshullam,

16_NEH_12_34 Judah, and Benjamin, and Shemaiah, and Jeremiah,

16_NEH_12_35 And [certain] of the priests' sons with trumpets; [namely], Zechariah the son of Jonathan, the son of Shemaiah, the son of Mattaniah, the son of Michaiah, the son of Zaccur, the son of Asaph:

16_NEH_12_36 And his brethren, Shemaiah, and Azrael, Milalai, Gilalai, Maai, Nethaneel, and Judah, Hanani, with the musical instruments of David the man of God, and Ezra the scribe before them.

16_NEH_12_37 And at the fountain gate, which was over against them, they went up by the stairs of the city of David, at the going up of the wall, above the house of David, even unto the water gate eastward.

16_NEH_12_38 And the other [company of them that gave] thanks went over against [them], and I after them, and the half of the people upon the wall, from beyond the tower of the furnaces even unto the broad wall;

16_NEH_12_39 And from above the gate of Ephraim, and above the old gate, and above the fish gate, and the tower of Hananeel, and the tower of Meah, even unto the sheep gate: and they stood still in the prison gate.

16_NEH_12_40 So stood the two [companies of them that gave] thanks in the house of God, and I, and the half of the rulers with me:

16_NEH_12_41 And the priests; Eliakim, Maaseiah, Miniamin, Michaiah, Elioenai, Zechariah, [and] Hananiah, with trumpets;

16_NEH_12_42 And Maaseiah, and Shemaiah, and Eleazar, and Uzzi, and Jehohanan, and Malchijah, and Elam, and Ezer. And the singers sang loud, with Jezrahiah [their] overseer.

16_NEH_12_43 Also that day they offered great sacrifices, and rejoiced: for God had made them rejoice with great joy: the wives also and the children rejoiced: so that the joy of Jerusalem was heard even afar off.

16_NEH_12_44 And at that time were some appointed over the chambers for the treasures, for the offerings, for the firstfruits, and for the tithes, to gather into them out of the fields of the cities the portions of the law for the priests and Levites: for Judah rejoiced for the priests and for the Levites that waited.

16_NEH_12_45 And both the singers and the porters kept the ward of their God, and the ward of the purification, according to the commandment of David, [and] of Solomon his son.

16_NEH_12_46 For in the days of David and Asaph of old [there were] chief of the singers, and songs of praise and thanksgiving unto God.

16_NEH_12_47 And all Israel in the days of Zerubbabel, and in the days of Nehemiah, gave the portions of the singers and the porters, every day his portion: and they sanctified [holy things] unto the Levites; and the Levites sanctified [them] unto the children of Aaron.

Complete KJV Holy Bible

16_NEH_13_01 On that day they read in the book of Moses in the audience of the people; and therein was found written, that the Ammonite and the Moabite should not come into the congregation of God for ever;

16_NEH_13_02 Because they met not the children of Israel with bread and with water, but hired Balaam against them, that he should curse them: howbeit our God turned the curse into a blessing.

16_NEH_13_03 Now it came to pass, when they had heard the law, that they separated from Israel all the mixed multitude.

16_NEH_13_04 And before this, Eliashib the priest, having the oversight of the chamber of the house of our God, [was] allied unto Tobiah:

16_NEH_13_05 And he had prepared for him a great chamber, where aforetime they laid the meat offerings, the frankincense, and the vessels, and the tithes of the corn, the new wine, and the oil, which was commanded [to be given] to the Levites, and the singers, and the porters; and the offerings of the priests.

16_NEH_13_06 But in all this [time] was not I at Jerusalem: for in the two and thirtieth year of Artaxerxes king of Babylon came I unto the king, and after certain days obtained I leave of the king:

16_NEH_13_07 And I came to Jerusalem, and understood of the evil that Eliashib did for Tobiah, in preparing him a chamber in the courts of the house of God.

16_NEH_13_08 And it grieved me sore: therefore I cast forth all the household stuff of Tobiah out of the chamber.

16_NEH_13_09 Then I commanded, and they cleansed the chambers: and thither brought I again the vessels of the house of God, with the meat offering and the frankincense.

16_NEH_13_10 And I perceived that the portions of the Levites had not been given [them]: for the Levites and the singers, that did the work, were fled every one to his field.

16_NEH_13_11 Then contended I with the rulers, and said, Why is the house of God forsaken? And I gathered them together, and set them in their place.

16_NEH_13_12 Then brought all Judah the tithes of the corn and the new wine and the oil unto the treasuries.

16_NEH_13_13 And I made treasurers over the treasuries, Shelemiah the priest, and Zadok the scribe, and of the Levites, Pedaiah: and next to them [was] Hanan the son of Zaccur, the son of Mattaniah: for they were counted faithful, and their office [was] to distribute unto their brethren.

16_NEH_13_14 Remember me, O my God, concerning this, and wipe not out my good deeds that I have done for the house of my God, and for the offices thereof.

16_NEH_13_15 In those days saw I in Judah [some] treading wine presses on the sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all [manner of] burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath day: and I testified [against them] in the day wherein they sold victuals.

16_NEH_13_16 There dwelt men of Tyre also therein, which brought fish, and all manner of ware, and sold on the sabbath unto the children of Judah, and in Jerusalem.

16_NEH_13_17 Then I contended with the nobles of Judah, and said unto them, What evil thing [is] this that ye do, and profane the sabbath day?

16_NEH_13_18 Did not your fathers thus, and did not our God bring all this evil upon us, and upon this city? yet ye bring more wrath upon Israel by profaning the sabbath.

16_NEH_13_19 And it came to pass, that when the gates of Jerusalem began to be dark before the sabbath, I commanded that the gates should be shut, and charged that they should not be opened till after the sabbath: and [some] of my servants set I at the gates, [that] there should no burden be brought in on the sabbath day.

16_NEH_13_20 So the merchants and sellers of all kind of ware lodged without Jerusalem once or twice.

16_NEH_13_21 Then I testified against them, and said unto them, Why lodge ye about the wall? if ye do [so] again, I will lay hands on you. From that time forth came they no [more] on the sabbath.

16_NEH_13_22 And I commanded the Levites that they should cleanse themselves, and [that] they should come [and] keep the gates, to sanctify the sabbath day. Remember me, O my God, [concerning] this also, and spare me according to the greatness of thy mercy.

16_NEH_13_23 In those days also saw I Jews [that] had married wives of Ashdod, of Ammon, [and] of Moab:

16_NEH_13_24 And their children spake half in the speech of Ashdod, and could not speak in the Jews' language, but according to the language of each people.

16_NEH_13_25 And I contended with them, and cursed them, and smote certain of them, and plucked off their hair, and made them swear by God, [saying], Ye shall not give your daughters unto their sons, nor take their daughters unto your sons, or for yourselves.

16_NEH_13_26 Did not Solomon king of Israel sin by these things? yet among many nations was there no king like him, who was beloved of his God, and God made him king over all Israel: nevertheless even him did outlandish women cause to sin.

16_NEH_13_27 Shall we then hearken unto you to do all this great evil, to transgress against our God in marrying strange wives?

16_NEH_13_28 And [one] of the sons of Joiada, the son of Eliashib the high priest, [was] son in law to Sanballat the Horonite: therefore I chased him from me.

16_NEH_13_29 Remember them, O my God, because they have defiled the priesthood, and the covenant of the priesthood, and of the Levites.

16_NEH_13_30 Thus cleansed I them from all strangers, and appointed the wards of the priests and the Levites, every one in his business;

16_NEH_13_31 And for the wood offering, at times appointed, and for the firstfruits. Remember me, O my God, for good.
