

- 41_MAR_01_01 The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God;
- 41_MAR_01_02 As it is written in the prophets, Behold, I send my messenger before thy face, which shall prepare thy way before thee.
- 41_MAR_01_03 The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.
- 41 MAR 01 04 John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins.
- 41_MAR_01_05 And there went out unto him all the land of Judaea, and they of Jerusalem, and were all baptized of him in the river of Jordan, confessing their sins.
- 41_MAR_01_06 And John was clothed with camel's hair, and with a girdle of a skin about his loins; and he did eat locusts and wild honey;
- 41_MAR_01_07 And preached, saying, There cometh one mightier than I after me, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to stoop down and unloose.
- 41_MAR_01_08 I indeed have baptized you with water: but he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost.
- 41_MAR_01_09 And it came to pass in those days, that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized of John in Jordan.
- 41_MAR_01_10 And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon him:
- 41 MAR 01 11 And there came a voice from heaven, [saying], Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.
- 41_MAR_01_12 And immediately the Spirit driveth him into the wilderness.
- 41_MAR_01_13 And he was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted of Satan; and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered unto him.
- 41_MAR_01_14 Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God,
- 41_MAR_01_15 And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.
- 41_MAR_01_16 Now as he walked by the sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and Andrew his brother casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers.
- 41_MAR_01_17 And Jesus said unto them, Come ye after me, and I will make you to become fishers of men.
- 41_MAR_01_18 And straightway they for sook their nets, and followed him.
- 41_MAR_01_19 And when he had gone a little farther thence, he saw James the [son] of Zebedee, and John his brother, who also were in the ship mending their nets.
- 41_MAR_01_20 And straightway he called them: and they left their father Zebedee in the ship with the hired servants, and went after him.
- 41_MAR_01_21 And they went into Capernaum; and straightway on the sabbath day he entered into the synagogue, and taught.
- 41_MAR_01_22 And they were astonished at his doctrine: for he taught them as one that had authority, and not as the scribes.
- 41_MAR_01_23 And there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit; and he cried out,
- destroy us? I know thee who thou art, the Holy One of God.

41 MAR 01 24 Saying, Let [us] alone; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to

41 MAR 01 26 And when the unclean spirit had torn him, and cried with a loud voice, he came out of him.

41 MAR 01 25 And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him.

- 41 MAR 01 27 And they were all amazed, insomuch that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is
- this? what new doctrine [is] this? for with authority commandeth he even the unclean spirits, and they do obey him.
- 41_MAR_01_28 And immediately his fame spread abroad throughout all the region round about Galilee.

 41 MAR 01 29 And forthwith, when they were come out of the synagogue, they entered into the house of Simon and
- Andrew, with James and John.
- 41 MAR 01 31 And he came and took her by the hand, and lifted her up; and immediately the fever left her, and she

41 MAR 01 30 But Simon's wife's mother lay sick of a fever, and anon they tell him of her.

ministered unto them.

41 MAR 01 32 And at even, when the sun did set, they brought unto him all that were diseased, and them that were

- possessed with devils.

 41 MAR 01 33 And all the city was gathered together at the door.
- 41_MAR_01_34 And he healed many that were sick of divers diseases, and cast out many devils; and suffered not
- the devils to speak, because they knew him.

 41 MAR 01 35 And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary
- place, and there prayed.

 41_MAR_01_36 And Simon and they that were with him followed after him.
- 41 MAR 01 37 And when they had found him, they said unto him, All [men] seek for thee.

came I forth.

thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.

- 41 MAR 01 38 And he said unto them, Let us go into the next towns, that I may preach there also: for therefore
- 41_MAR_01_39 And he preached in their synagogues throughout all Galilee, and cast out devils.
- 41 MAR 01 40 And there came a leper to him, beseeching him, and kneeling down to him, and saying unto him, If
- 41_MAR_01_41 And Jesus, moved with compassion, put forth [his] hand, and touched him, and saith unto him, I will;
- be thou clean.

41 MAR 01 42 And as soon as he had spoken, immediately the leprosy departed from him, and he was cleansed.

- 41 MAR 01 43 And he straitly charged him, and forthwith sent him away;
 - 41_MAR_01_44 And saith unto him, See thou say nothing to any man: but go thy way, show thyself to the priest, and offer for thy cleansing those things which Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.
- 41_MAR_01_45 But he went out, and began to publish [it] much, and to blaze abroad the matter, insomuch that Jesus could no more openly enter into the city, but was without in desert places: and they came to him from every quarter.



- 41 MAR 02 01 And again he entered into Capernaum after [some] days; and it was noised that he was in the house.
- 41_MAR_02_02 And straightway many were gathered together, insomuch that there was no room to receive [them], no, not so much as about the door: and he preached the word unto them.
- 41 MAR 02 03 And they come unto him, bringing one sick of the palsy, which was borne of four.
- 41_MAR_02_04 And when they could not come nigh unto him for the press, they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they had broken [it] up, they let down the bed wherein the sick of the palsy lay.
- 41_MAR_02_05 When Jesus saw their faith, he said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee.
- 41_MAR_02_06 But there were certain of the scribes sitting there, and reasoning in their hearts,
- 41_MAR_02_07 Why doth this [man] thus speak blasphemies? who can forgive sins but God only?
- 41_MAR_02_08 And immediately when Jesus perceived in his spirit that they so reasoned within themselves, he said unto them, Why reason ye these things in your hearts?
- 41_MAR_02_09 Whether is it easier to say to the sick of the palsy, [Thy] sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Arise, and take up thy bed, and walk?
- 41_MAR_02_10 But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, [he saith to the sick of the palsy,]
- 41_MAR_02_11 I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy bed, and go thy way into thine house.
- 41_MAR_02_12 And immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went forth before them all; insomuch that they were all amazed, and glorified God, saying, We never saw it on this fashion.
- 41_MAR_02_13 And he went forth again by the sea side; and all the multitude resorted unto him, and he taught them.
- 41_MAR_02_14 And as he passed by, he saw Levi the [son] of Alphaeus sitting at the receipt of custom, and said unto him, Follow me. And he arose and followed him.
- 41_MAR_02_15 And it came to pass, that, as Jesus sat at meat in his house, many publicans and sinners sat also together with Jesus and his disciples: for there were many, and they followed him.
- 41_MAR_02_16 And when the scribes and Pharisees saw him eat with publicans and sinners, they said unto his disciples, How is it that he eateth and drinketh with publicans and sinners?
- 41_MAR_02_17 When Jesus heard [it], he saith unto them, They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.
- 41_MAR_02_18 And the disciples of John and of the Pharisees used to fast: and they come and say unto him, Why do the disciples of John and of the Pharisees fast, but thy disciples fast not?
- 41_MAR_02_19 And Jesus said unto them, Can the children of the bridechamber fast, while the bridegroom is with them? as long as they have the bridegroom with them, they cannot fast.
- 41_MAR_02_20 But the days will come, when the bridegroom shall be taken away from them, and then shall they fast in those days.
- 41_MAR_02_21 No man also seweth a piece of new cloth on an old garment: else the new piece that filled it up taketh away from the old, and the rent is made worse.
- 41_MAR_02_22 And no man putteth new wine into old bottles: else the new wine doth burst the bottles, and the wine is spilled, and the bottles will be marred: but new wine must be put into new bottles.
- 41_MAR_02_23 And it came to pass, that he went through the corn fields on the sabbath day; and his disciples began, as they went, to pluck the ears of corn.
- 41_MAR_02_24 And the Pharisees said unto him, Behold, why do they on the sabbath day that which is not lawful?
- 41_MAR_02_25 And he said unto them, Have ye never read what David did, when he had need, and was an hungred, he, and they that were with him?
- 41_MAR_02_26 How he went into the house of God in the days of Abiathar the high priest, and did eat the showbread, which is not lawful to eat but for the priests, and gave also to them which were with him?
- 41 MAR 02 27 And he said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:
- 41 MAR 02 28 Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.



- 41 MAR 03 01 And he entered again into the synagogue; and there was a man there which had a withered hand.
- 41 MAR 03 02 And they watched him, whether he would heal him on the sabbath day; that they might accuse him.
- 41 MAR 03 03 And he saith unto the man which had the withered hand, Stand forth.
- 41_MAR_03_04 And he saith unto them, Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil? to save life, or to kill? But they held their peace.
- 41_MAR_03_05 And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched [it] out: and his hand was restored whole as the other.
- 41_MAR_03_06 And the Pharisees went forth, and straightway took counsel with the Herodians against him, how they might destroy him.
- 41_MAR_03_07 But Jesus withdrew himself with his disciples to the sea: and a great multitude from Galilee followed him, and from Judaea,
- 41_MAR_03_08 And from Jerusalem, and from Idumaea, and [from] beyond Jordan; and they about Tyre and Sidon, a great multitude, when they had heard what great things he did, came unto him.
- 41_MAR_03_09 And he spake to his disciples, that a small ship should wait on him because of the multitude, lest they should throng him.
- 41_MAR_03_10 For he had healed many; insomuch that they pressed upon him for to touch him, as many as had plagues.
- 41_MAR_03_11 And unclean spirits, when they saw him, fell down before him, and cried, saying, Thou art the Son of God.
- 41_MAR_03_12 And he straitly charged them that they should not make him known.
- 41 MAR 03 13 And he goeth up into a mountain, and calleth [unto him] whom he would: and they came unto him.
- 41 MAR 03 14 And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach,
- 41_MAR_03_15 And to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out devils:
- 41_MAR_03_16 And Simon he surnamed Peter;
- 41_MAR_03_17 And James the [son] of Zebedee, and John the brother of James; and he surnamed them Boanerges, which is, The sons of thunder:
- 41_MAR_03_18 And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the [son] of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Canaanite,
- 41_MAR_03_19 And Judas Iscariot, which also betrayed him: and they went into an house.
- 41_MAR_03_20 And the multitude cometh together again, so that they could not so much as eat bread.
- 41_MAR_03_21 And when his friends heard [of it], they went out to lay hold on him: for they said, He is beside himself.
- 41_MAR_03_22 And the scribes which came down from Jerusalem said, He hath Beelzebub, and by the prince of the devils casteth he out devils.
- 41_MAR_03_23 And he called them [unto him], and said unto them in parables, How can Satan cast out Satan?
- 41_MAR_03_24 And if a kingdom be divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand.
- 41 MAR 03 25 And if a house be divided against itself, that house cannot stand.
- 41_MAR_03_26 And if Satan rise up against himself, and be divided, he cannot stand, but hath an end.
- 41_MAR_03_27 No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house.
- 41_MAR_03_28 Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be forgiven unto the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blaspheme:
- 41_MAR_03_29 But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation:
- 41_MAR_03_30 Because they said, He hath an unclean spirit.
- 41 MAR 03 31 There came then his brethren and his mother, and, standing without, sent unto him, calling him.
- 41_MAR_03_32 And the multitude sat about him, and they said unto him, Behold, thy mother and thy brethren without seek for thee.
- 41_MAR_03_33 And he answered them, saying, Who is my mother, or my brethren?
- 41_MAR_03_34 And he looked round about on them which sat about him, and said, Behold my mother and my brethren!
- 41 MAR 03 35 For whosoever shall do the will of God, the same is my brother, and my sister, and mother.



- 41_MAR_04_01 And he began again to teach by the sea side: and there was gathered unto him a great multitude, so that he entered into a ship, and sat in the sea; and the whole multitude was by the sea on the land.
- 41_MAR_04_02 And he taught them many things by parables, and said unto them in his doctrine,
- 41 MAR 04 03 Hearken; Behold, there went out a sower to sow:
- 41_MAR_04_04 And it came to pass, as he sowed, some fell by the way side, and the fowls of the air came and devoured it up.
- 41_MAR_04_05 And some fell on stony ground, where it had not much earth; and immediately it sprang up, because it had no depth of earth:
- 41_MAR_04_06 But when the sun was up, it was scorched; and because it had no root, it withered away.
- 41 MAR 04 07 And some fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up, and choked it, and it yielded no fruit.
- 41_MAR_04_08 And other fell on good ground, and did yield fruit that sprang up and increased; and brought forth, some thirty, and some sixty, and some an hundred.
- 41 MAR 04 09 And he said unto them, He that hath ears to hear, let him hear.
- 41 MAR 04 10 And when he was alone, they that were about him with the twelve asked of him the parable.
- 41_MAR_04_11 And he said unto them, Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God: but unto them that are without, all [these] things are done in parables:
- 41_MAR_04_12 That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and [their] sins should be forgiven them.
- 41_MAR_04_13 And he said unto them, Know ye not this parable? and how then will ye know all parables?
- 41_MAR_04_14 The sower soweth the word.
- 41_MAR_04_15 And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, Satan cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.
- 41_MAR_04_16 And these are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness;
- 41_MAR_04_17 And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.
- 41 MAR 04 18 And these are they which are sown among thorns; such as hear the word,
- 41_MAR_04_19 And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.
- 41_MAR_04_20 And these are they which are sown on good ground; such as hear the word, and receive [it], and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred.
- 41_MAR_04_21 And he said unto them, Is a candle brought to be put under a bushel, or under a bed? and not to be set on a candlestick?
- 41_MAR_04_22 For there is nothing hid, which shall not be manifested; neither was any thing kept secret, but that it should come abroad.
- 41_MAR_04_23 If any man have ears to hear, let him hear.

- 41_MAR_04_24 And he said unto them, Take heed what ye hear: with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given.
- 41_MAR_04_25 For he that hath, to him shall be given: and he that hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he hath.
- 41_MAR_04_26 And he said, So is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground;
- 41_MAR_04_27 And should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how.
- 41_MAR_04_28 For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear.
- 41_MAR_04_29 But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come.
- 41 MAR 04 30 And he said, Whereunto shall we liken the kingdom of God? or with what comparison shall we
- compare it?
- 41 MAR 04 32 But when it is sown, it groweth up, and becometh greater than all herbs, and shooteth out great

41 MAR 04 31 [It is] like a grain of mustard seed, which, when it is sown in the earth, is less than all the seeds that

- branches; so that the fowls of the air may lodge under the shadow of it.
- 41_MAR_04_33 And with many such parables spake he the word unto them, as they were able to hear [it].
- 41_MAR_04_34 But without a parable spake he not unto them: and when they were alone, he expounded all things to his disciples.
- side.

41 MAR 04 35 And the same day, when the even was come, he saith unto them, Let us pass over unto the other

- 41_MAR_04_36 And when they had sent away the multitude, they took him even as he was in the ship. And there were also with him other little ships.
- 41_MAR_04_37 And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full.
- 41_MAR_04_38 And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish?
- 41 MAR 04 39 And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and
- 41 MAR 04 40 And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith?
- 41_MAR_04_41 And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the



- 41_MAR_05_01 And they came over unto the other side of the sea, into the country of the Gadarenes.
- 41_MAR_05_02 And when he was come out of the ship, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit,
- 41_MAR_05_03 Who had [his] dwelling among the tombs; and no man could bind him, no, not with chains:
- 41_MAR_05_04 Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked as under by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any [man] tame him.
- 41_MAR_05_05 And always, night and day, he was in the mountains, and in the tombs, crying, and cutting himself with stones.
- 41_MAR_05_06 But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped him,
- 41_MAR_05_07 And cried with a loud voice, and said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, [thou] Son of the most high God? I adjure thee by God, that thou torment me not.
- 41_MAR_05_08 For he said unto him, Come out of the man, [thou] unclean spirit.
- 41_MAR_05_09 And he asked him, What [is] thy name? And he answered, saying, My name [is] Legion: for we are many.
- 41_MAR_05_10 And he besought him much that he would not send them away out of the country.
- 41_MAR_05_11 Now there was there nigh unto the mountains a great herd of swine feeding.
- 41_MAR_05_12 And all the devils besought him, saying, Send us into the swine, that we may enter into them.
- 41_MAR_05_13 And forthwith Jesus gave them leave. And the unclean spirits went out, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, [they were about two thousand;] and were choked in the sea.
- 41_MAR_05_14 And they that fed the swine fled, and told [it] in the city, and in the country. And they went out to see what it was that was done.
- 41_MAR_05_15 And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.
- 41_MAR_05_16 And they that saw [it] told them how it befell to him that was possessed with the devil, and [also] concerning the swine.
- 41_MAR_05_17 And they began to pray him to depart out of their coasts.
- 41_MAR_05_18 And when he was come into the ship, he that had been possessed with the devil prayed him that he might be with him.
- 41_MAR_05_19 Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but saith unto him, Go home to thy friends, and tell them how great things the Lord hath done for thee, and hath had compassion on thee.
- 41_MAR_05_20 And he departed, and began to publish in Decapolis how great things Jesus had done for him: and all [men] did marvel.
- 41_MAR_05_21 And when Jesus was passed over again by ship unto the other side, much people gathered unto him: and he was nigh unto the sea.
- he fell at his feet,

41 MAR 05 23 And besought him greatly, saying, My little daughter lieth at the point of death: [I pray thee], come

41 MAR 05 22 And, behold, there cometh one of the rulers of the synagogue, Jairus by name; and when he saw him,

- and lay thy hands on her, that she may be healed; and she shall live.
- 41_MAR_05_24 And [Jesus] went with him; and much people followed him, and thronged him.
- 41_MAR_05_25 And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years,
- bettered, but rather grew worse,

41 MAR 05 26 And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing

- 41_MAR_05_27 When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment.
- 41_MAR_05_28 For she said, If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole.

 41 MAR 05 29 And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in [her] body that she was
- healed of that plague.

 41 MAR 05 31 And his disciples said unto him, Thou seest the multitude thronging thee, and sayest thou, Who

41 MAR 05 30 And Jesus, immediately knowing in himself that virtue had gone out of him, turned him about in the

 41 MAR 05 34 And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy
- 41 MAR 05 35 While he yet spake, there came from the ruler of the synagogue's [house certain] which said, Thy
- 41 MAR 05 36 As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, he saith unto the ruler of the synagogue, Be not
- afraid, only believe.
- 41 MAR 05 38 And he cometh to the house of the ruler of the synagogue, and seeth the tumult, and them that wept

41 MAR 05 37 And he suffered no man to follow him, save Peter, and James, and John the brother of James.

- 41 MAR 05 39 And when he was come in, he saith unto them, Why make ye this ado, and weep? the damsel is not
- dead, but sleepeth.
- mother of the damsel, and them that were with him, and entereth in where the damsel was lying.

41 MAR 05 40 And they laughed him to scorn. But when he had put them all out, he taketh the father and the

- 41_MAR_05_41 And he took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi; which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, arise.
- 41 MAR 05 42 And straightway the damsel arose, and walked; for she was [of the age] of twelve years. And they
- 41 MAR 05 43 And he charged them straitly that no man should know it; and commanded that something should be



- 41_MAR_06_01 And he went out from thence, and came into his own country; and his disciples follow him.
- 41_MAR_06_02 And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing [him] were astonished, saying, From whence hath this [man] these things? and what wisdom [is] this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands?
- 41_MAR_06_03 Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, the brother of James, and Joses, and of Juda, and Simon? and are not his sisters here with us? And they were offended at him.
- 41_MAR_06_04 But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, but in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house.
- 41_MAR_06_05 And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed [them].
- 41_MAR_06_06 And he marvelled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching.
- 41_MAR_06_07 And he called [unto him] the twelve, and began to send them forth by two and two; and gave them power over unclean spirits;
- 41_MAR_06_08 And commanded them that they should take nothing for [their] journey, save a staff only; no scrip, no bread, no money in [their] purse:
- 41_MAR_06_09 But [be] shod with sandals; and not put on two coats.
- 41_MAR_06_10 And he said unto them, In what place soever ye enter into an house, there abide till ye depart from that place.

- 41_MAR_07_02 And when they saw some of his disciples eat bread with defiled, that is to say, with unwashen, hands, they found fault.
- 41_MAR_07_03 For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash [their] hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders.
- 41_MAR_07_04 And [when they come] from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, [as] the washing of cups, and pots, brazen vessels, and of tables.
- 41_MAR_07_05 Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashen hands?
- 41_MAR_07_06 He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with [their] lips, but their heart is far from me.
- 41 MAR 07 07 Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching [for] doctrines the commandments of men.
- 41_MAR_07_08 For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, [as] the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do.
- 41_MAR_07_09 And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition.
- 41_MAR_07_10 For Moses said, Honour thy father and thy mother; and, Whoso curseth father or mother, let him die the death:
- 41_MAR_07_11 But ye say, If a man shall say to his father or mother, [It is] Corban, that is to say, a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; [he shall be free].
- 41_MAR_07_12 And ye suffer him no more to do ought for his father or his mother;
- 41_MAR_07_13 Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- 41_MAR_07_14 And when he had called all the people [unto him], he said unto them, Hearken unto me every one [of you], and understand:
- 41_MAR_07_15 There is nothing from without a man, that entering into him can defile him: but the things which come out of him, those are they that defile the man.
- 41_MAR_07_16 If any man have ears to hear, let him hear.
- 41_MAR_07_17 And when he was entered into the house from the people, his disciples asked him concerning the parable.
- 41_MAR_07_18 And he saith unto them, Are ye so without understanding also? Do ye not perceive, that whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, [it] cannot defile him;
- 41_MAR_07_19 Because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, purging all meats?
- 41_MAR_07_20 And he said, That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man.
- 41 MAR 07 21 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders,
- 41_MAR_07_22 Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness:
- 41_MAR_07_23 All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.

- 41_MAR_07_31 And again, departing from the coasts of Tyre and Sidon, he came unto the sea of Galilee, through the midst of the coasts of Decapolis.
- 41_MAR_07_32 And they bring unto him one that was deaf, and had an impediment in his speech; and they beseech
- 41_MAR_07_33 And he took him aside from the multitude, and put his fingers into his ears, and he spit, and touched his tongue;
- 41 MAR 07 34 And looking up to heaven, he sighed, and saith unto him, Ephphatha, that is, Be opened.
- 41_MAR_07_36 And he charged them that they should tell no man: but the more he charged them, so much the more a great deal they published [it];

41 MAR 07 35 And straightway his ears were opened, and the string of his tongue was loosed, and he spake plain.

41 MAR 07 37 And were beyond measure astonished, saying, He hath done all things well: he maketh both the deaf



- 41_MAR_08_01 In those days the multitude being very great, and having nothing to eat, Jesus called his disciples [unto him], and saith unto them,
- 41_MAR_08_02 I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now been with me three days, and have nothing to eat:
- 41_MAR_08_03 And if I send them away fasting to their own houses, they will faint by the way: for divers of them came from far.

- 41_MAR_08_06 And he commanded the people to sit down on the ground: and he took the seven loaves, and gave thanks, and brake, and gave to his disciples to set before [them]; and they did set [them] before the people.
- 41 MAR 08 07 And they had a few small fishes: and he blessed, and commanded to set them also before [them].
- 41_MAR_08_08 So they did eat, and were filled: and they took up of the broken [meat] that was left seven baskets.
- 41_MAR_08_09 And they that had eaten were about four thousand: and he sent them away.
- 41 MAR 08 10 And straightway he entered into a ship with his disciples, and came into the parts of Dalmanutha.
- 41_MAR_08_11 And the Pharisees came forth, and began to question with him, seeking of him a sign from heaven, tempting him.
- 41_MAR_08_12 And he sighed deeply in his spirit, and saith, Why doth this generation seek after a sign? verily I say unto you, There shall no sign be given unto this generation.
- 41_MAR_08_13 And he left them, and entering into the ship again departed to the other side.
- 41_MAR_08_14 Now [the disciples] had forgotten to take bread, neither had they in the ship with them more than one loaf.

- 41_MAR_08_21 And he said unto them, How is it that ye do not understand?
- 41_MAR_08_22 And he cometh to Bethsaida; and they bring a blind man unto him, and besought him to touch him.
- 41_MAR_08_23 And he took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon him, he asked him if he saw ought.
- 41_MAR_08_24 And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking.
- 41_MAR_08_25 After that he put [his] hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly.
- 41 MAR 08 26 And he sent him away to his house, saying, Neither go into the town, nor tell [it] to any in the town.

- 41 MAR 08 32 And he spake that saying openly. And Peter took him, and began to rebuke him.
- 41_MAR_08_33 But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.
- 41_MAR_08_34 And when he had called the people [unto him] with his disciples also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.
- 41_MAR_08_35 For whosoever will save his life shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it.
- 41 MAR 08 36 For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?

- 41 MAR 09 12 And he answered and told them, Elias verily cometh first, and restoreth all things; and how it is written of the Son of man, that he must suffer many things, and be set at nought.
- 41 MAR 09 13 But I say unto you, That Elias is indeed come, and they have done unto him whatsoever they listed, as it is written of him.
- 41 MAR 09 14 And when he came to [his] disciples, he saw a great multitude about them, and the scribes questioning with them.
- 41 MAR 09 15 And straightway all the people, when they beheld him, were greatly amazed, and running to [him] saluted him.
- 41 MAR 09 16 And he asked the scribes, What question ye with them?
- 41 MAR 09 17 And one of the multitude answered and said, Master, I have brought unto thee my son, which hath a dumb spirit;
- 41 MAR 09 18 And wheresoever he taketh him, he teareth him: and he foameth, and gnasheth with his teeth, and pineth away: and I spake to thy disciples that they should cast him out; and they could not.
- 41 MAR 09 19 He answereth him, and saith, O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him unto me.
- 41 MAR 09 20 And they brought him unto him: and when he saw him, straightway the spirit tare him; and he fell on the ground, and wallowed foaming.
- 41 MAR 09 21 And he asked his father, How long is it ago since this came unto him? And he said, Of a child.

41 MAR 14 57 And there arose certain, and bare false witness against him, saying,

41 MAR 14 52 And he left the linen cloth, and fled from them naked.

41_MAR_14_61 But he held his peace, and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked him, and said unto him, Art thou the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?

41 MAR 14 60 And the high priest stood up in the midst, and asked Jesus, saying, Answerest thou nothing? what [is

- 41_MAR_14_62 And Jesus said, I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.
- 41_MAR_14_64 Ye have heard the blasphemy: what think ye? And they all condemned him to be guilty of death.

 41 MAR 14 65 And some began to spit on him, and to cover his face, and to buffet him, and to say unto him,

41 MAR 14 67 And when she saw Peter warming himself, she looked upon him, and said, And thou also wast with

41_MAR_14_66 And as Peter was beneath in the palace, there cometh one of the maids of the high priest:

41 MAR 14 63 Then the high priest rent his clothes, and saith, What need we any further witnesses?

 41 MAR 14 68 But he denied, saying, I know not, neither understand I what thou sayest. And he went out into the
- 41_MAR_14_69 And a maid saw him again, and began to say to them that stood by, This is [one] of them.
- 41_MAR_14_70 And he denied it again. And a little after, they that stood by said again to Peter, Surely thou art [one] of them: for thou art a Galilaean, and thy speech agreeth [thereto].
- 41_MAR_14_71 But he began to curse and to swear, [saying], I know not this man of whom ye speak.
- 41_MAR_14_72 And the second time the cock crew. And Peter called to mind the word that Jesus said unto him, Before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice. And when he thought thereon, he wept.



- 41_MAR_15_01 And straightway in the morning the chief priests held a consultation with the elders and scribes and the whole council, and bound Jesus, and carried [him] away, and delivered [him] to Pilate.
- 41_MAR_15_02 And Pilate asked him, Art thou the King of the Jews? And he answering said unto him, Thou sayest [it].
- 41_MAR_15_03 And the chief priests accused him of many things: but he answered nothing.
- 41_MAR_15_04 And Pilate asked him again, saying, Answerest thou nothing? behold how many things they witness against thee.
- 41_MAR_15_05 But Jesus yet answered nothing; so that Pilate marvelled.
- 41 MAR 15 06 Now at [that] feast he released unto them one prisoner, whomsoever they desired.
- 41_MAR_15_07 And there was [one] named Barabbas, [which lay] bound with them that had made insurrection with him, who had committed murder in the insurrection.
- 41_MAR_15_08 And the multitude crying aloud began to desire [him to do] as he had ever done unto them.
- 41_MAR_15_09 But Pilate answered them, saying, Will ye that I release unto you the King of the Jews?
- 41_MAR_15_10 For he knew that the chief priests had delivered him for envy.
- 41 MAR 15 11 But the chief priests moved the people, that he should rather release Barabbas unto them.
- 41_MAR_15_12 And Pilate answered and said again unto them, What will ye then that I shall do [unto him] whom ye call the King of the Jews?
- 41_MAR_15_13 And they cried out again, Crucify him.
- 41_MAR_15_14 Then Pilate said unto them, Why, what evil hath he done? And they cried out the more exceedingly, Crucify him.
- 41_MAR_15_15 And [so] Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged [him], to be crucified.
- 41_MAR_15_16 And the soldiers led him away into the hall, called Praetorium; and they call together the whole band.
- 41_MAR_15_17 And they clothed him with purple, and platted a crown of thorns, and put it about his [head],
- 41_MAR_15_18 And began to salute him, Hail, King of the Jews!
- 41_MAR_15_19 And they smote him on the head with a reed, and did spit upon him, and bowing [their] knees worshipped him.
- 41_MAR_15_20 And when they had mocked him, they took off the purple from him, and put his own clothes on him, and led him out to crucify him.
- 41_MAR_15_21 And they compel one Simon a Cyrenian, who passed by, coming out of the country, the father of Alexander and Rufus, to bear his cross.
- 41_MAR_15_22 And they bring him unto the place Golgotha, which is, being interpreted, The place of a skull.
- 41_MAR_15_23 And they gave him to drink wine mingled with myrrh: but he received [it] not.
- 41_MAR_15_24 And when they had crucified him, they parted his garments, casting lots upon them, what every man should take.
- 41_MAR_15_25 And it was the third hour, and they crucified him.
- 41_MAR_15_26 And the superscription of his accusation was written over, THE KING OF THE JEWS.
- 41_MAR_15_27 And with him they crucify two thieves; the one on his right hand, and the other on his left.

41 MAR 15 28 And the scripture was fulfilled, which saith, And he was numbered with the transgressors.

- 41 MAR 15 29 And they that passed by railed on him, wagging their heads, and saying, Ah, thou that destroyest the
- temple, and buildest [it] in three days,
- 41 MAR 15 31 Likewise also the chief priests mocking said among themselves with the scribes, He saved others;

41 MAR 15 30 Save thyself, and come down from the cross.

41_MAR_15_32 Let Christ the King of Israel descend now from the cross, that we may see and believe. And they

- 41_MAR_16_01 And when the sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the [mother] of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him.
- 41_MAR_16_02 And very early in the morning the first [day] of the week, they came unto the sepulchre at the rising of the sun.
- 41_MAR_16_03 And they said among themselves, Who shall roll us away the stone from the door of the sepulchre?
- 41 MAR 16 04 And when they looked, they saw that the stone was rolled away: for it was very great.
- 41_MAR_16_05 And entering into the sepulchre, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, clothed in a long white garment; and they were affrighted.
- 41_MAR_16_06 And he saith unto them, Be not affrighted: Ye seek Jesus of Nazareth, which was crucified: he is risen; he is not here: behold the place where they laid him.
- 41_MAR_16_07 But go your way, tell his disciples and Peter that he goeth before you into Galilee: there shall ye see him, as he said unto you.
- 41_MAR_16_08 And they went out quickly, and fled from the sepulchre; for they trembled and were amazed: neither said they any thing to any [man]; for they were afraid.
- 41_MAR_16_09 Now when [Jesus] was risen early the first [day] of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils.
- 41_MAR_16_10 [And] she went and told them that had been with him, as they mourned and wept.
- 41_MAR_16_11 And they, when they had heard that he was alive, and had been seen of her, believed not.
- 41_MAR_16_12 After that he appeared in another form unto two of them, as they walked, and went into the country.
- 41_MAR_16_13 And they went and told [it] unto the residue: neither believed they them.
- 41_MAR_16_14 Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.
- 41 MAR 16 15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.
- 41_MAR_16_16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- 41_MAR_16_17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- 41_MAR_16_18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- 41_MAR_16_19 So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God.
- 41_MAR_16_20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with [them], and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.
