

Complete KJV Holy Bible

40\_MAT\_26\_01 And it came to pass, when Jesus had finished all these sayings, he said unto his disciples,

40\_MAT\_26\_02 Ye know that after two days is [the feast of] the passover, and the Son of man is betrayed to be crucified.

40\_MAT\_26\_03 Then assembled together the chief priests, and the scribes, and the elders of the people, unto the palace of the high priest, who was called Caiaphas,

40\_MAT\_26\_04 And consulted that they might take Jesus by subtlety, and kill [him].

40\_MAT\_26\_05 But they said, Not on the feast [day], lest there be an uproar among the people.

40\_MAT\_26\_06 Now when Jesus was in Bethany, in the house of Simon the leper,

40\_MAT\_26\_07 There came unto him a woman having an alabaster box of very precious ointment, and poured it on his head, as he sat [at meat].

40\_MAT\_26\_08 But when his disciples saw [it], they had indignation, saying, To what purpose [is] this waste?

40\_MAT\_26\_09 For this ointment might have been sold for much, and given to the poor.

40\_MAT\_26\_10 When Jesus understood [it], he said unto them, Why trouble ye the woman? for she hath wrought a good work upon me.

40\_MAT\_26\_11 For ye have the poor always with you; but me ye have not always.

40\_MAT\_26\_12 For in that she hath poured this ointment on my body, she did [it] for my burial.

40\_MAT\_26\_13 Verily I say unto you, Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached in the whole world, [there] shall also this, that this woman hath done, be told for a memorial of her.

40\_MAT\_26\_14 Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went unto the chief priests,

40\_MAT\_26\_15 And said [unto them], What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver.

40\_MAT\_26\_16 And from that time he sought opportunity to betray him.

40\_MAT\_26\_17 Now the first [day] of the [feast of] unleavened bread the disciples came to Jesus, saying unto him, Where wilt thou that we prepare for thee to eat the passover?

40\_MAT\_26\_18 And he said, Go into the city to such a man, and say unto him, The Master saith, My time is at hand; I will keep the passover at thy house with my disciples.

40\_MAT\_26\_19 And the disciples did as Jesus had appointed them; and they made ready the passover.

40\_MAT\_26\_20 Now when the even was come, he sat down with the twelve.

40\_MAT\_26\_21 And as they did eat, he said, Verily I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me.

40\_MAT\_26\_22 And they were exceeding sorrowful, and began every one of them to say unto him, Lord, is it I?

40\_MAT\_26\_23 And he answered and said, He that dippeth [his] hand with me in the dish, the same shall betray me.

40\_MAT\_26\_24 The Son of man goeth as it is written of him: but woe unto that man by whom the Son of man is betrayed! it had been good for that man if he had not been born.

40\_MAT\_26\_25 Then Judas, which betrayed him, answered and said, Master, is it I? He said unto him, Thou hast said.

40\_MAT\_26\_26 And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed [it], and brake [it], and gave [it] to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body.

40\_MAT\_26\_27 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave [it] to them, saying, Drink ye all of it;

40\_MAT\_26\_28 For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

40\_MAT\_26\_29 But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.

40\_MAT\_26\_30 And when they had sung an hymn, they went out into the mount of Olives.

40\_MAT\_26\_31 Then saith Jesus unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock shall be scattered abroad.

40\_MAT\_26\_32 But after I am risen again, I will go before you into Galilee.

40\_MAT\_26\_33 Peter answered and said unto him, Though all [men] shall be offended because of thee, [yet] will I never be offended.

40\_MAT\_26\_34 Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, That this night, before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice.

40\_MAT\_26\_35 Peter said unto him, Though I should die with thee, yet will I not deny thee. Likewise also said all the disciples.

40\_MAT\_26\_36 Then cometh Jesus with them unto a place called Gethsemane, and saith unto the disciples, Sit ye here, while I go and pray yonder.

40\_MAT\_26\_37 And he took with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to be sorrowful and very heavy.

40\_MAT\_26\_38 Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: tarry ye here, and watch with me.

40\_MAT\_26\_39 And he went a little farther, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou [wilt].

40\_MAT\_26\_40 And he cometh unto the disciples, and findeth them asleep, and saith unto Peter, What, could ye not watch with me one hour?

40\_MAT\_26\_41 Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed [is] willing, but the flesh [is] weak.

40\_MAT\_26\_42 He went away again the second time, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if this cup may not pass away from me, except I drink it, thy will be done.

40\_MAT\_26\_43 And he came and found them asleep again: for their eyes were heavy.

40\_MAT\_26\_44 And he left them, and went away again, and prayed the third time, saying the same words.

40\_MAT\_26\_45 Then cometh he to his disciples, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take [your] rest: behold, the hour is at hand, and the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.

40\_MAT\_26\_46 Rise, let us be going: behold, he is at hand that doth betray me.

40\_MAT\_26\_47 And while he yet spake, lo, Judas, one of the twelve, came, and with him a great multitude with swords and staves, from the chief priests and elders of the people.

40\_MAT\_26\_48 Now he that betrayed him gave them a sign, saying, Whomsoever I shall kiss, that same is he: hold him fast.

40\_MAT\_26\_49 And forthwith he came to Jesus, and said, Hail, master; and kissed him.

40\_MAT\_26\_50 And Jesus said unto him, Friend, wherefore art thou come? Then came they, and laid hands on Jesus, and took him.

40\_MAT\_26\_51 And, behold, one of them which were with Jesus stretched out [his] hand, and drew his sword, and struck a servant of the high priest's, and smote off his ear.

40\_MAT\_26\_52 Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword.

40\_MAT\_26\_53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?

40\_MAT\_26\_54 But how then shall the scriptures be fulfilled, that thus it must be?

40\_MAT\_26\_55 In that same hour said Jesus to the multitudes, Are ye come out as against a thief with swords and staves for to take me? I sat daily with you teaching in the temple, and ye laid no hold on me.

40\_MAT\_26\_56 But all this was done, that the scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled. Then all the disciples forsook him, and fled.

40\_MAT\_26\_57 And they that had laid hold on Jesus led [him] away to Caiaphas the high priest, where the scribes and the elders were assembled.

40\_MAT\_26\_58 But Peter followed him afar off unto the high priest's palace, and went in, and sat with the servants, to see the end.

40\_MAT\_26\_59 Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against Jesus, to put him to death;

40\_MAT\_26\_60 But found none: yea, though many false witnesses came, [yet] found they none. At the last came two false witnesses,

40\_MAT\_26\_61 And said, This [fellow] said, I am able to destroy the temple of God, and to build it in three days.

40\_MAT\_26\_62 And the high priest arose, and said unto him, Answerest thou nothing? what [is it which] these witness against thee?

40\_MAT\_26\_63 But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.

40\_MAT\_26\_64 Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

40\_MAT\_26\_65 Then the high priest rent his clothes, saying, He hath spoken blasphemy; what further need have we of witnesses? behold, now ye have heard his blasphemy.

40\_MAT\_26\_66 What think ye? They answered and said, He is guilty of death.

40\_MAT\_26\_67 Then did they spit in his face, and buffeted him; and others smote [him] with the palms of their hands,

40\_MAT\_26\_68 Saying, Prophecy unto us, thou Christ, Who is he that smote thee?

40\_MAT\_26\_69 Now Peter sat without in the palace: and a damsel came unto him, saying, Thou also wast with Jesus of Galilee.

40\_MAT\_26\_70 But he denied before [them] all, saying, I know not what thou sayest.

40\_MAT\_26\_71 And when he was gone out into the porch, another [maid] saw him, and said unto them that were there, This [fellow] was also with Jesus of Nazareth.

40\_MAT\_26\_72 And again he denied with an oath, I do not know the man.

40\_MAT\_26\_73 And after a while came unto [him] they that stood by, and said to Peter, Surely thou also art [one] of them; for thy speech bewrayeth thee.

40\_MAT\_26\_74 Then began he to curse and to swear, [saying], I know not the man. And immediately the cock crew.

40\_MAT\_26\_75 And Peter remembered the word of Jesus, which said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice. And he went out, and wept bitterly.
