

## **Complete KJV Holy Bible**

- 46 1CO 07 01 Now concerning the things whereof ye wrote unto me: [It is] good for a man not to touch a woman.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_02 Nevertheless, [to avoid] fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband.
- 46 1CO 07 03 Let the husband render unto the wife due benevolence: and likewise also the wife unto the husband.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_04 The wife hath not power of her own body, but the husband: and likewise also the husband hath not power of his own body, but the wife.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_05 Defraud ye not one the other, except [it be] with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that Satan tempt you not for your incontinency.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_06 But I speak this by permission, [and] not of commandment.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_07 For I would that all men were even as I myself. But every man hath his proper gift of God, one after this manner, and another after that.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_08 I say therefore to the unmarried and widows, It is good for them if they abide even as I.
- 46 1CO 07 09 But if they cannot contain, let them marry: for it is better to marry than to burn.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_10 And unto the married I command, [yet] not I, but the Lord, Let not the wife depart from [her] husband:
- 46\_1CO\_07\_11 But and if she depart, let her remain unmarried, or be reconciled to [her] husband: and let not the husband put away [his] wife.
- to dwell with him, let him not put her away.

46 1CO 07 12 But to the rest speak I, not the Lord: If any brother hath a wife that believeth not, and she be pleased

- 46\_1CO\_07\_13 And the woman which hath an husband that believeth not, and if he be pleased to dwell with her, let her not leave him.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_14 For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband: else were your children unclean; but now are they holy.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_15 But if the unbelieving depart, let him depart. A brother or a sister is not under bondage in such [cases]: but God hath called us to peace.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_16 For what knowest thou, O wife, whether thou shalt save [thy] husband? or how knowest thou, O man, whether thou shalt save [thy] wife?
- 46\_1CO\_07\_17 But as God hath distributed to every man, as the Lord hath called every one, so let him walk. And so ordain I in all churches.

46 1CO 07 19 Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but the keeping of the commandments of God.

- 46\_1CO\_07\_18 Is any man called being circumcised? let him not become uncircumcised. Is any called in uncircumcision? let him not be circumcised.
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- 46\_1CO\_07\_20 Let every man abide in the same calling wherein he was called.
- 46 1CO 07 21 Art thou called [being] a servant? care not for it: but if thou mayest be made free, use [it] rather.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_22 For he that is called in the Lord, [being] a servant, is the Lord's freeman: likewise also he that is called, [being] free, is Christ's servant.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_23 Ye are bought with a price; be not ye the servants of men.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_24 Brethren, let every man, wherein he is called, therein abide with God.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_25 Now concerning virgins I have no commandment of the Lord: yet I give my judgment, as one that hath obtained mercy of the Lord to be faithful.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_26 I suppose therefore that this is good for the present distress, [I say], that [it is] good for a man so to be.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_27 Art thou bound unto a wife? seek not to be loosed. Art thou loosed from a wife? seek not a wife.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_28 But and if thou marry, thou hast not sinned; and if a virgin marry, she hath not sinned. Nevertheless such shall have trouble in the flesh: but I spare you.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_29 But this I say, brethren, the time [is] short: it remaineth, that both they that have wives be as though they had none;
- 46\_1CO\_07\_30 And they that weep, as though they wept not; and they that rejoice, as though they rejoiced not; and they that buy, as though they possessed not;
- 46\_1CO\_07\_31 And they that use this world, as not abusing [it]: for the fashion of this world passeth away.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_32 But I would have you without carefulness. He that is unmarried careth for the things that belong to the Lord, how he may please the Lord:
- 46\_1CO\_07\_33 But he that is married careth for the things that are of the world, how he may please [his] wife.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_34 There is difference [also] between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit: but she that is married careth for the things of the world, how she may please [her] husband.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_35 And this I speak for your own profit; not that I may cast a snare upon you, but for that which is comely, and that ye may attend upon the Lord without distraction.
- 46\_1CO\_07\_36 But if any man think that he behaveth himself uncomely toward his virgin, if she pass the flower of [her] age, and need so require, let him do what he will, he sinneth not: let them marry.
- 46 1CO 07 37 Nevertheless he that standeth stedfast in his heart, having no necessity, but hath power over his own
- will, and hath so decreed in his heart that he will keep his virgin, doeth well.

  46 1CO 07 38 So then he that giveth [her] in marriage doeth well; but he that giveth [her] not in marriage doeth
- better.
- liberty to be married to whom she will; only in the Lord.

46 1CO 07 39 The wife is bound by the law as long as her husband liveth; but if her husband be dead, she is at
