

Complete KJV Holy Bible

**58\_HEB\_03\_01** Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus;

**58\_HEB\_03\_02** Who was faithful to him that appointed him, as also Moses [was faithful] in all his house.

**58\_HEB\_03\_03** For this [man] was counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as he who hath builded the house hath more honour than the house.

**58\_HEB\_03\_04** For every house is builded by some [man]; but he that built all things [is] God.

**58\_HEB\_03\_05** And Moses verily [was] faithful in all his house, as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken after;

**58\_HEB\_03\_06** But Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end.

**58\_HEB\_03\_07** Wherefore [as the Holy Ghost saith, To day if ye will hear his voice,

**58\_HEB\_03\_08** Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness:

**58\_HEB\_03\_09** When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my works forty years.

**58\_HEB\_03\_10** Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do alway err in [their] heart; and they have not known my ways.

**58\_HEB\_03\_11** So I swear in my wrath, They shall not enter into my rest.]

**58\_HEB\_03\_12** Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God.

**58\_HEB\_03\_13** But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

**58\_HEB\_03\_14** For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;

**58\_HEB\_03\_15** While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation.

**58\_HEB\_03\_16** For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by Moses.

**58\_HEB\_03\_17** But with whom was he grieved forty years? [was it] not with them that had sinned, whose carcasses fell in the wilderness?

**58\_HEB\_03\_18** And to whom swore he that they should not enter into his rest, but to them that believed not?

**58\_HEB\_03\_19** So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.
