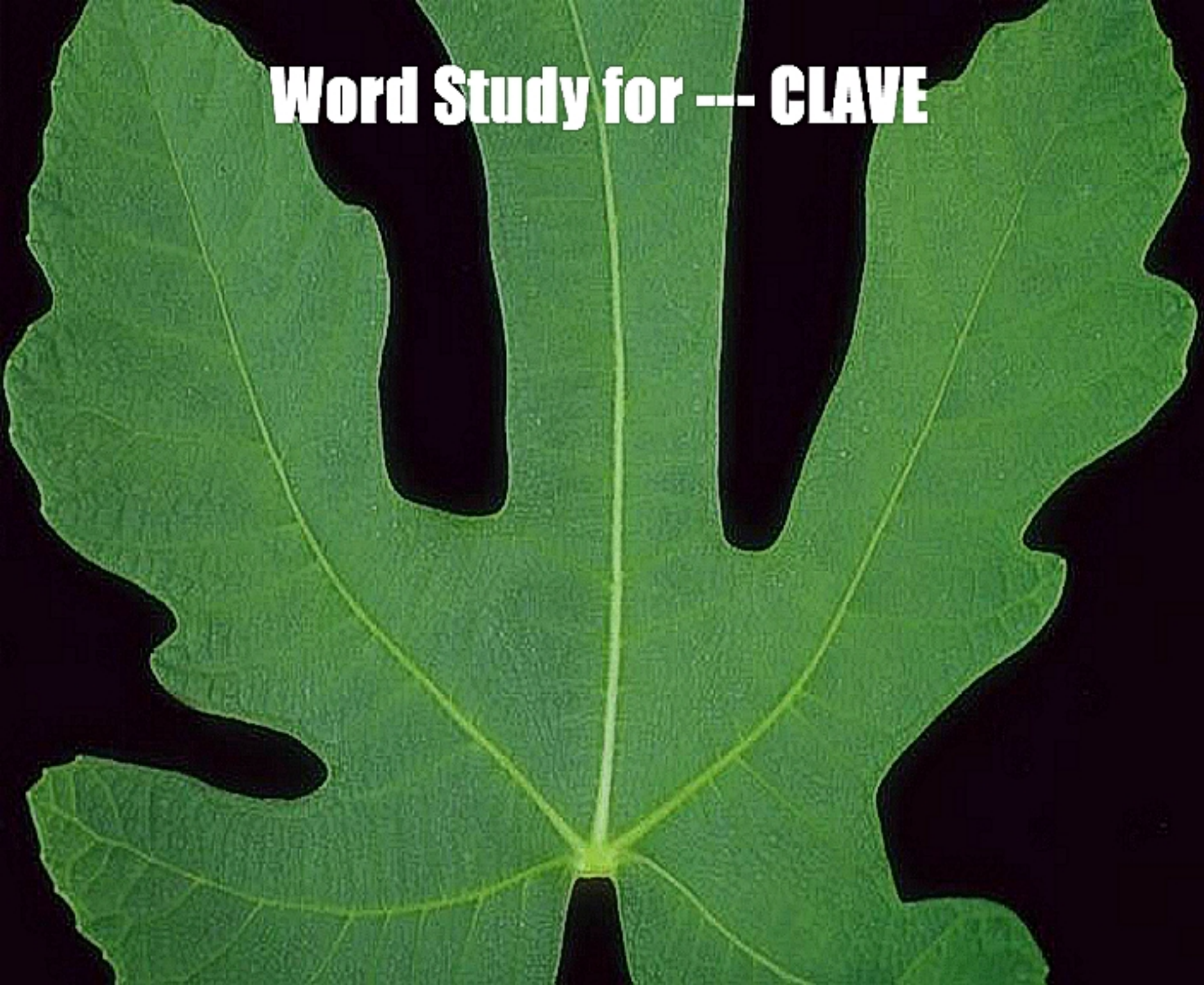

unto the damsel.**




**Num 16:31 And it came to pass, as he had made an end of speaking all these words, that the ground clave asunder that [was] under them:**


**Rut 01:14 And they lifted up their voice,


