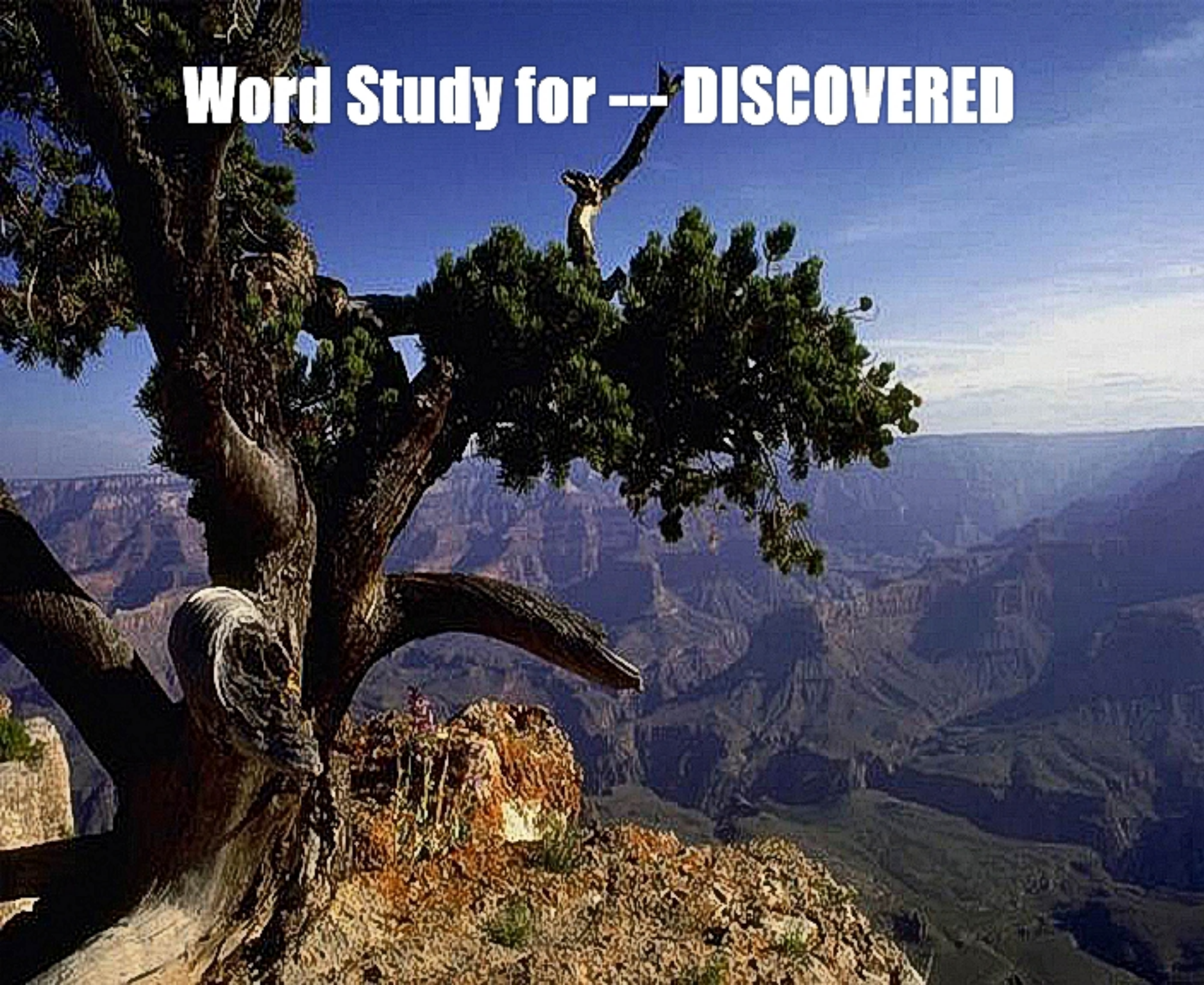




**Exo 20:26 Neither shalt thou go up by






**Eze 21:24 Therefore thus saith the Lord
