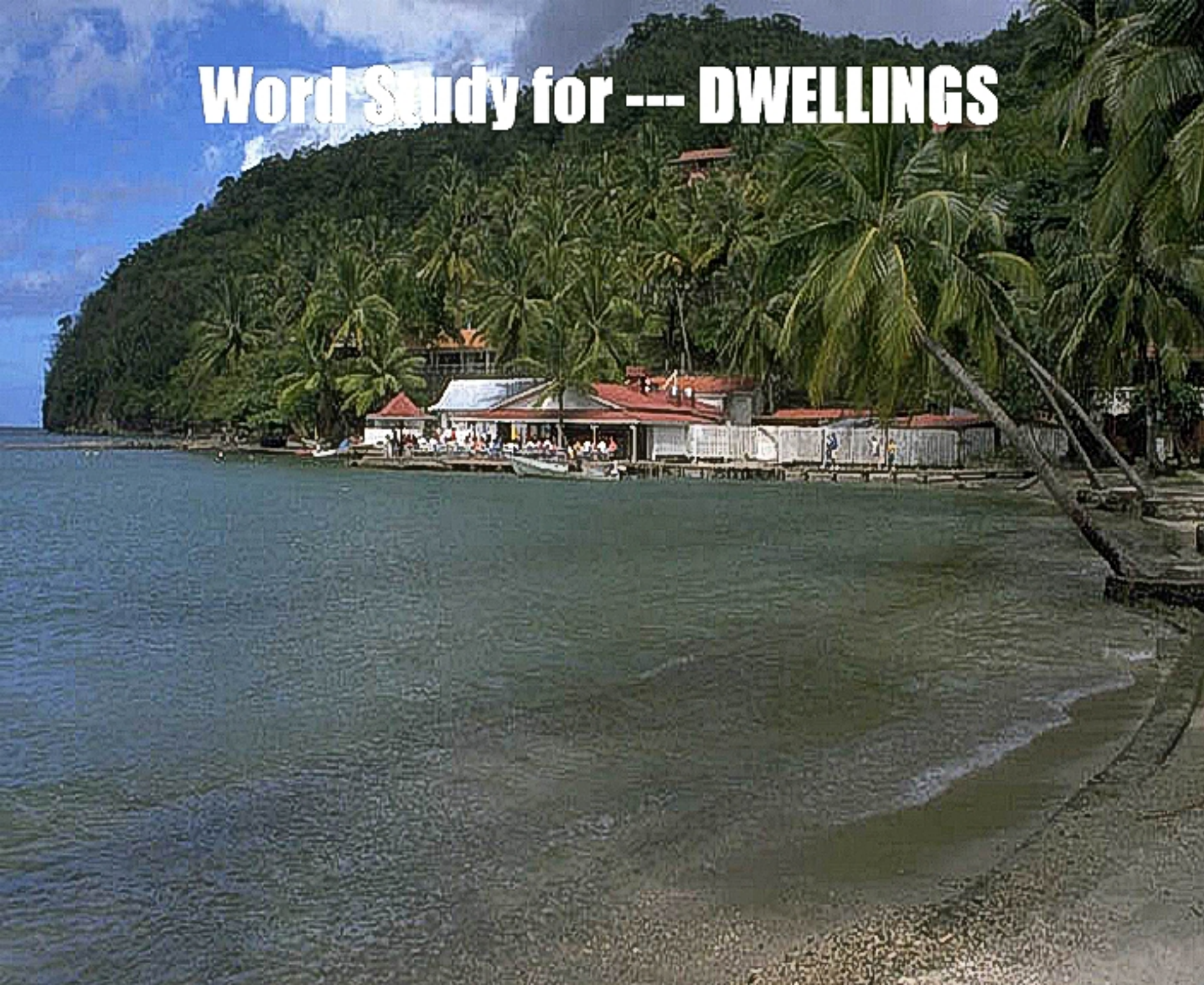




**Exo 10:23 They saw not one another,

your dwellings.**






