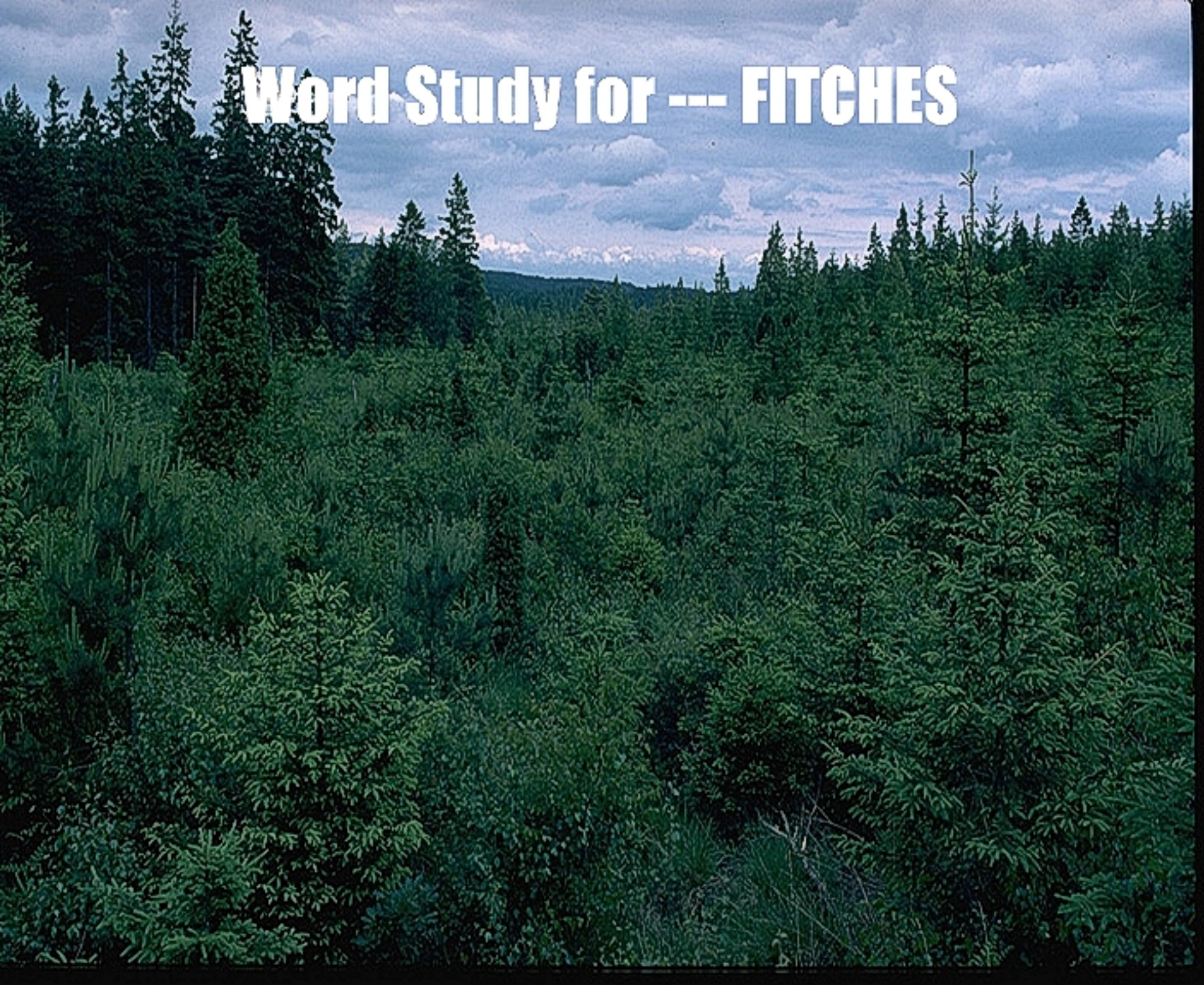








Word Study for --- FITCHES


