




Word Study for --- FOURSQUARE





**Exo 27:01 And thou shalt make an altar I
of shittim wood, five cubits long and
five cubits broad; the altar shall be
foursquare: and the height thereof
shall be three cubits.**

**Exo 28:16 Foursquare it shall be [being]
doubled; a span [shall be] the length
thereof, and a span [shall be] the
breadth thereof.**

Exo 30:02 A cubit I shall be the length thereof, and a cubit the breadth thereof; foursquare shall it be: and two cubits I shall be the height thereof: the horns thereof I shall be of the same.

Exo 37:25 And he made the incense altar [of] shittim wood: the length of it [was] a cubit, and the breadth of it a cubit; [it was] foursquare; and two cubits [was] the height of it; the horns thereof were of the same.

Exo 38:01 And he made the altar of burnt offering [of] shittim wood; five cubits [was] the length thereof, and five cubits the breadth thereof; [it was] foursquare; and three cubits the height thereof.

**Exo 39:09 It was foursquare; they
made the breastplate double; a span [
was] the length thereof, and a span
the breadth thereof, [being] doubled.**

1Ki 07:31 And the mouth of it within the chapter and above [was] a cubit: but the mouth thereof [was] round [after] the work of the base, a cubit and an half: and also upon the mouth of it [were] gravings with their borders, foursquare, not round.

Eze 40:47 So he measured the court, an hundred cubits long, and an hundred cubits broad, foursquare; and the altar [that was] before the house.

**Eze 48:20 All the oblation [shall be]
five and twenty thousand by five and
twenty thousand: ye shall offer the
holy oblation foursquare, with the
possession of the city.**

**Rev 21:16 And the city lieth foursquare,
and the length is as large as the
breadth: and he measured the city
with the reed, twelve thousand
furlongs. The length and the breadth
and the height of it are equal.**
