**Psa 32:01 A Psalm of David, Maschil.  
Blessed is he whose transgression is  
forgiven, whose sin is covered.**

**Psa 42:01 To the chief Musician,  
Maschil, for the sons of Korah. As the  
hart panteth after the water brooks, so  
panteth my soul after thee, O God.**

**Psa 44:01 To the chief Musician for the  
sons of Korah, Maschil. We have  
heard with our ears, O God, our fathers  
have told us, [what] work thou didst in  
their days, in the times of old.**



**Psa 45:01 To the chief Musician upon  
Shoshannim, for the sons of Korah,  
Maschil, A Song of loves. My heart is  
inditing a good matter: I speak of the  
things which I have made touching the  
king: my tongue is] the pen of a ready  
writer.**


**Psa 52:01 To the chief Musician,  
Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when Doeg  
the Edomite came and told Saul, and  
said unto him, David is come to the  
house of Ahimelech. Why boastest  
thou thyself in mischief, O mighty

continually.**

**Psa 53:01 To the chief Musician upon  
Mahalath, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David.  
The fool hath said in his heart, [There  
is] no God. Corrupt are they, and have  
done abominable iniquity: [There is]  
none that doeth good.**

**Psa 54:01 To the chief Musician on  
Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David,  
when the Ziphims came and said to  
Saul, Doth not David hide himself with  
us? Save me, O God, by thy name, and  
judge me by thy strength.**

**Psa 55:01 To the chief Musician on  
Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David.  
Give ear to my prayer, O God; and hide  
not thyself from my supplication.**

**Psa 74:01 Maschil of Asaph. O God, why  
hast thou cast [us] off for ever? [why]  
doth thine anger smoke against the  
sheep of thy pasture?**



**Psa 78:01 Maschil of Asaph. Give ear, O  
my people, I tol my law: incline your  
ears to the words of my mouth.**

**Psa 88:01 A Song [or] Psalm for the  
sons of Korah, to the chief Musician  
upon Mahalath Leannoth, Maschil of  
Heman the Ezrahite. O LORD God of my  
salvation, I have cried day [and] night  
before thee:**

**Psa 89:01 Maschil of Ethan the Ezrahite.  
I will sing of the mercies of the LORD  
for ever: with my mouth will I make  
known thy faithfulness to all  
generations.**

**Psa 142:01 Maschil of David; A Prayer  
when he was in the cave. I cried unto  
the LORD with my voice; with my voice  
unto the LORD did I make my  
supplication.**
