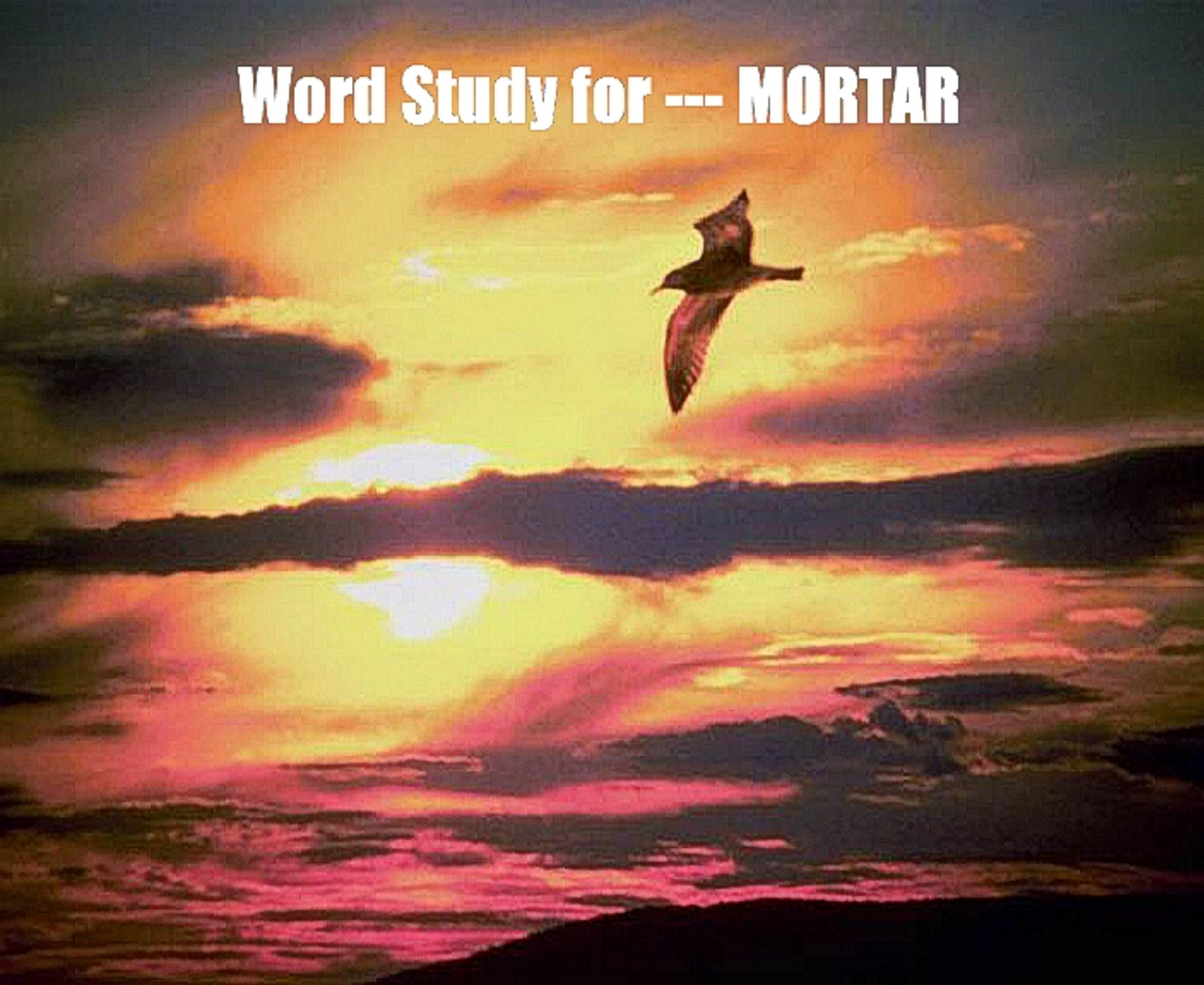






**Gen 11:03 And they said one to another,




Lev 14:42 And they shall take other stones, and put them in the place of those stones; and he shall take other mortar, and shall plaster the house.

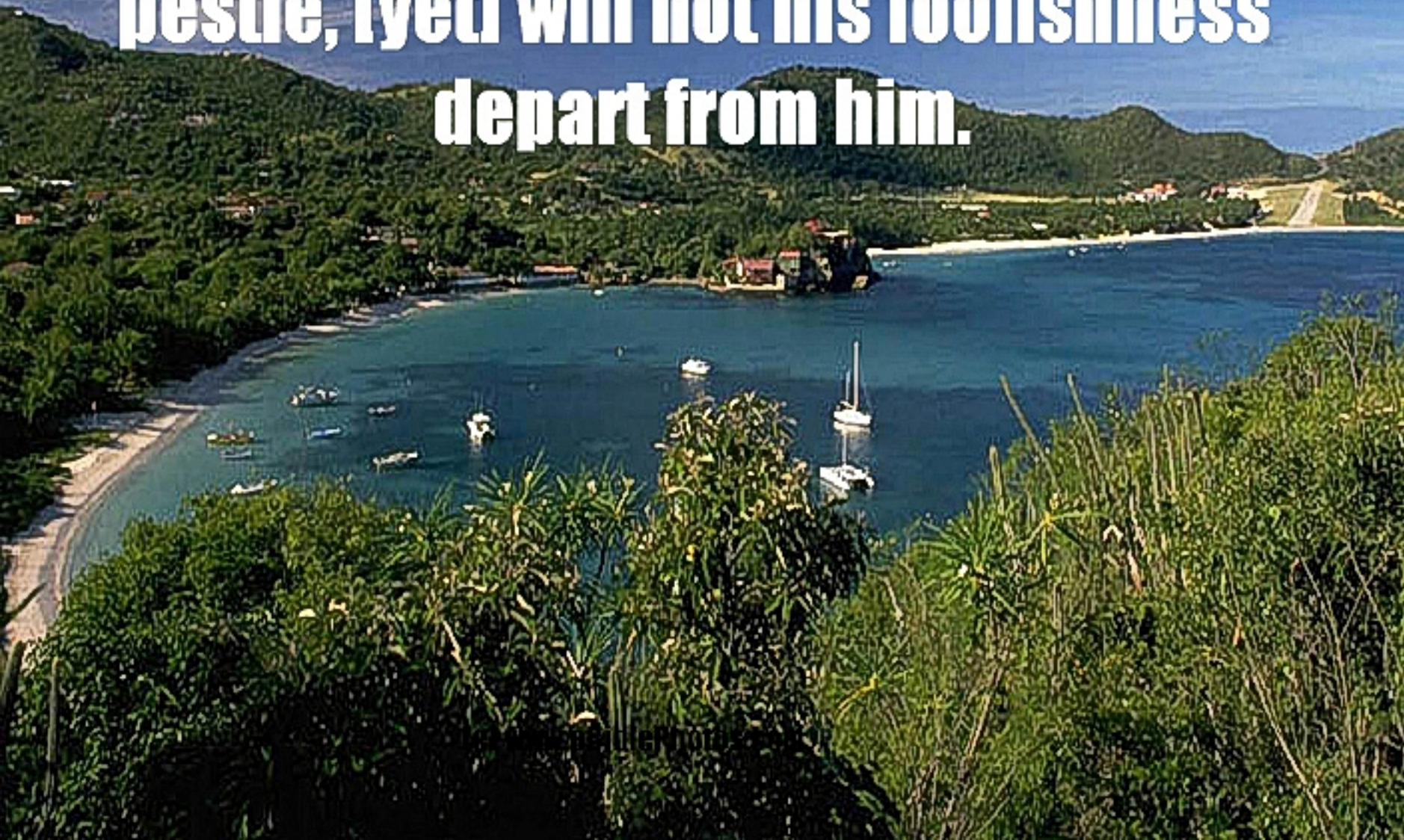



