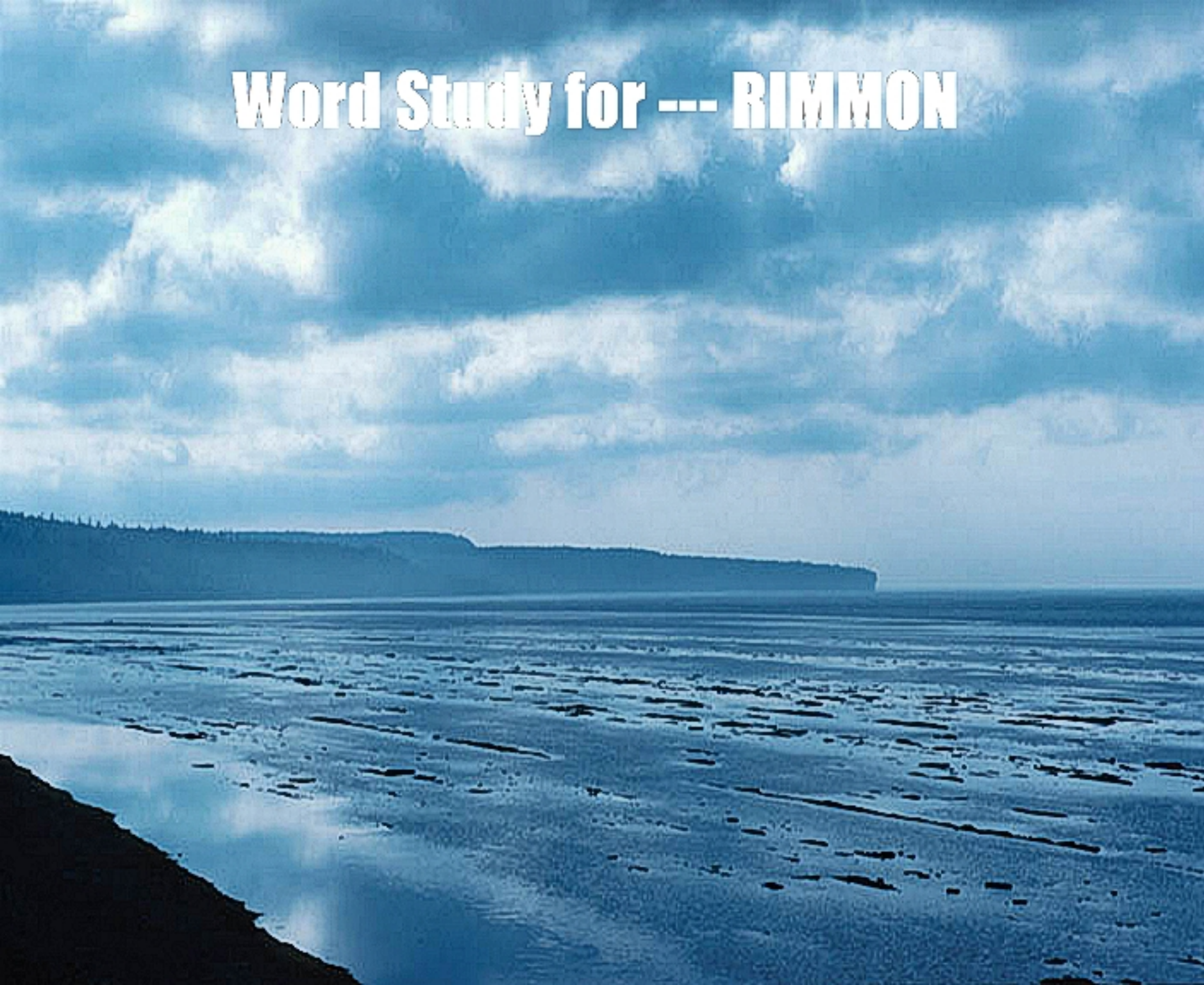



villages:**




