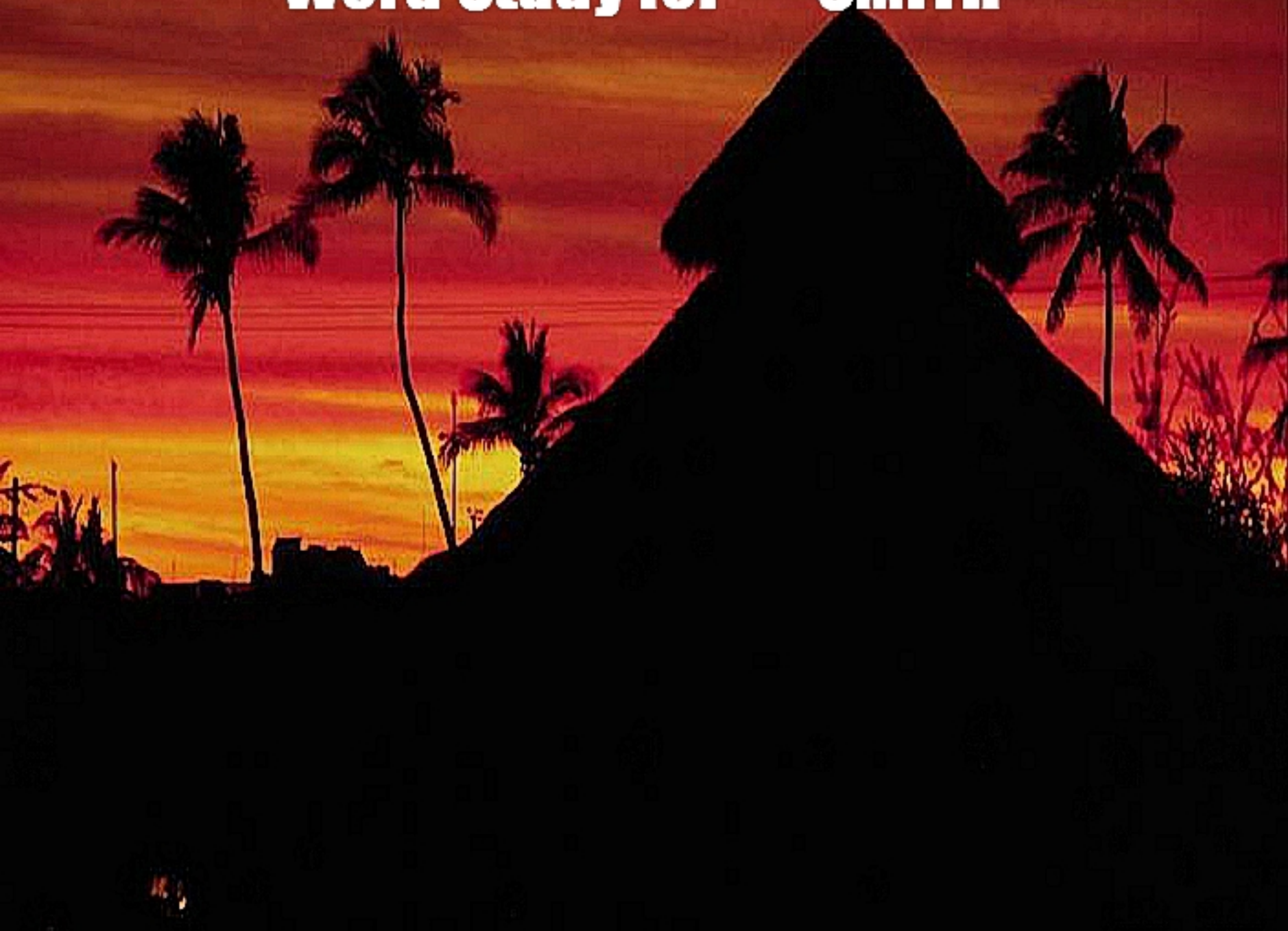




Word Study for --- SMITH
