


**Isa 01:23 Thy princes [are] rebellious,

come unto them.**


**Jer 48:27 For was not Israel a derision

**Jer 49:09 If grapegatherers come to thee, would they not leave [some] gleaning grapes? if thieves by night, they will destroy till they have enough.**




**Oba 01:05 If thieves came to thee, if

break through and steal:**

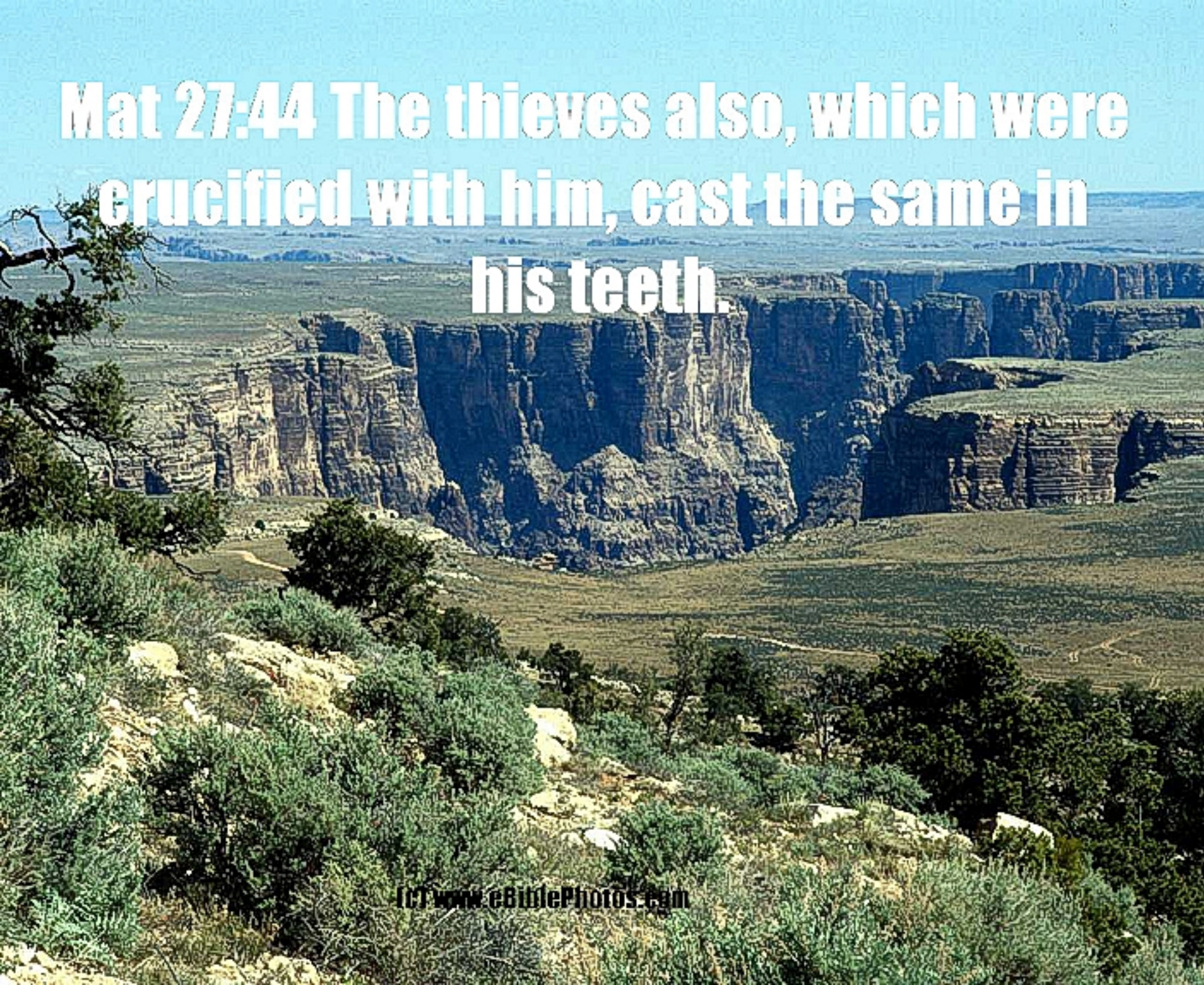
**Mat 06:20 But lay up for yourselves

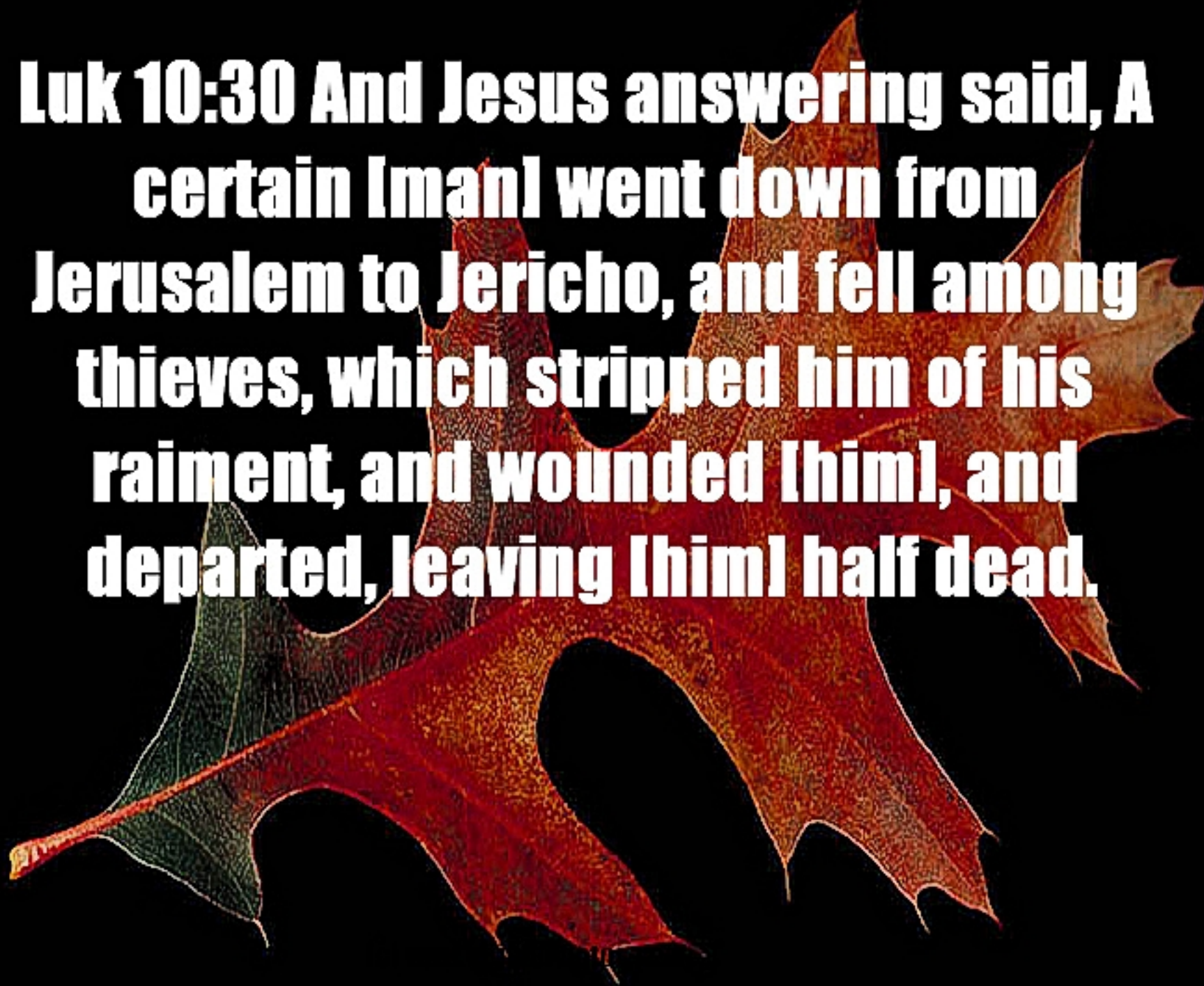


