



**Lev 19:29 Do not prostitute thy daughter, to cause her to be a whore; lest the land fall to whoredom, and the land become full of wickedness.**







**Lev 20:05 Then I will set my face

commit whoredom with them,**


**Eze 16:33 They give gifts to all whores:


**Eze 23:08 Neither left she her

poured their whoredom upon her.**






