**19\_PSA\_91\_01 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.**

**19\_PSA\_91\_02 I will say of the LORD, [He is] my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.**

**19\_PSA\_91\_03 Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, [and] from the noisome pestilence.**

**19\_PSA\_91\_04 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth [shall be thy] shield and buckler.**

**19\_PSA\_91\_05 Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; [nor] for the arrow [that] flieth by day;**

**19\_PSA\_91\_06 [Nor] for the pestilence [that] walketh in darkness; [nor] for the destruction [that] wasteth at noonday.**

**19\_PSA\_91\_07 A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; [but] it shall not come nigh thee.**

**19\_PSA\_91\_08 Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.**

**19\_PSA\_91\_09 Because thou hast made the LORD, [which is] my refuge, [even] the most High, thy habitation;**

**19\_PSA\_91\_10 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.**

**19\_PSA\_91\_11 For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.**

**19\_PSA\_91\_12 They shall bear thee up in [their] hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.**

**19\_PSA\_91\_13 Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.**

**19\_PSA\_91\_14 Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.**

**19\_PSA\_91\_15 He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I [will be] with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.**

**19\_PSA\_91\_16 With long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation.**
