

Complete KJV Holy Bible

19_PSA_92_01 A Psalm [or] Song for the sabbath day. [It is a] good [thing] to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High:

19_PSA_92_02 To show forth thy lovingkindness in the morning, and thy faithfulness every night,

19_PSA_92_03 Upon an instrument of ten strings, and upon the psaltery; upon the harp with a solemn sound.

19_PSA_92_04 For thou, LORD, hast made me glad through thy work: I will triumph in the works of thy hands.

19_PSA_92_05 O LORD, how great are thy works! [and] thy thoughts are very deep.

19_PSA_92_06 A brutish man knoweth not; neither doth a fool understand this.

19_PSA_92_07 When the wicked spring as the grass, and when all the workers of iniquity do flourish; [it is] that they shall be destroyed for ever:

19_PSA_92_08 But thou, LORD, [art most] high for evermore.

19_PSA_92_09 For, lo, thine enemies, O LORD, for, lo, thine enemies shall perish; all the workers of iniquity shall be scattered.

19_PSA_92_10 But my horn shalt thou exalt like [the horn of] an unicorn: I shall be anointed with fresh oil.

19_PSA_92_11 Mine eye also shall see [my desire] on mine enemies, [and] mine ears shall hear [my desire] of the wicked that rise up against me.

19_PSA_92_12 The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon.

19_PSA_92_13 Those that be planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God.

19_PSA_92_14 They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing;

19_PSA_92_15 To show that the LORD [is] upright: [he is] my rock, and [there is] no unrighteousness in him.
