

## **Complete KJV Holy Bible**

- 44 ACT 12 01 Now about that time Herod the king stretched forth [his] hands to vex certain of the church.
- 44 ACT 12 02 And he killed James the brother of John with the sword.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_03 And because he saw it pleased the Jews, he proceeded further to take Peter also. [Then were the days of unleavened bread.]
- 44\_ACT\_12\_04 And when he had apprehended him, he put [him] in prison, and delivered [him] to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after Easter to bring him forth to the people.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_05 Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_06 And when Herod would have brought him forth, the same night Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains: and the keepers before the door kept the prison.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_07 And, behold, the angel of the Lord came upon [him], and a light shined in the prison: and he smote Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise up quickly. And his chains fell off from [his] hands.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_08 And the angel said unto him, Gird thyself, and bind on thy sandals. And so he did. And he saith unto him, Cast thy garment about thee, and follow me.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_09 And he went out, and followed him; and wist not that it was true which was done by the angel; but thought he saw a vision.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_10 When they were past the first and the second ward, they came unto the iron gate that leadeth unto the city; which opened to them of his own accord: and they went out, and passed on through one street; and forthwith the angel departed from him.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_11 And when Peter was come to himself, he said, Now I know of a surety, that the Lord hath sent his angel, and hath delivered me out of the hand of Herod, and [from] all the expectation of the people of the Jews.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_12 And when he had considered [the thing], he came to the house of Mary the mother of John, whose surname was Mark; where many were gathered together praying.
- 44 ACT 12 13 And as Peter knocked at the door of the gate, a damsel came to hearken, named Rhoda.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_14 And when she knew Peter's voice, she opened not the gate for gladness, but ran in, and told how Peter stood before the gate.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_15 And they said unto her, Thou art mad. But she constantly affirmed that it was even so. Then said they, It is his angel.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_16 But Peter continued knocking: and when they had opened [the door], and saw him, they were astonished.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_17 But he, beckoning unto them with the hand to hold their peace, declared unto them how the Lord had brought him out of the prison. And he said, Go show these things unto James, and to the brethren. And he departed, and went into another place.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_18 Now as soon as it was day, there was no small stir among the soldiers, what was become of Peter.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_19 And when Herod had sought for him, and found him not, he examined the keepers, and commanded that [they] should be put to death. And he went down from Judaea to Caesarea, and [there] abode.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_20 And Herod was highly displeased with them of Tyre and Sidon: but they came with one accord to him, and, having made Blastus the king's chamberlain their friend, desired peace; because their country was nourished by the king's [country].
- 44\_ACT\_12\_21 And upon a set day Herod, arrayed in royal apparel, sat upon his throne, and made an oration unto them.
- 44 ACT 12 22 And the people gave a shout, [saying, It is] the voice of a god, and not of a man.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_23 And immediately the angel of the Lord smote him, because he gave not God the glory: and he was eaten of worms, and gave up the ghost.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_24 But the word of God grew and multiplied.
- 44\_ACT\_12\_25 And Barnabas and Saul returned from Jerusalem, when they had fulfilled [their] ministry, and took with them John, whose surname was Mark.
