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**Book of Genesis Chapter 34**

01\_GEN\_34\_01 And Dinah the daughter of Leah, which she bare unto Jacob, went out to see the daughters of the land.

01\_GEN\_34\_02 And when Shechem the son of Hamor the Hivite, prince of the country, saw her, he took her, and lay with her, and defiled her.

01\_GEN\_34\_03 And his soul clave unto Dinah the daughter of Jacob, and he loved the damsel, and spake kindly unto the damsel.

01\_GEN\_34\_04 And Shechem spake unto his father Hamor, saying, Get me this damsel to wife.

01\_GEN\_34\_05 And Jacob heard that he had defiled Dinah his daughter: now his sons were with his cattle in the field: and Jacob held his peace until they were come.

01\_GEN\_34\_06 And Hamor the father of Shechem went out unto Jacob to commune with him.

01\_GEN\_34\_07 And the sons of Jacob came out of the field when they heard [it]: and the men were grieved, and they were very wroth, because he had wrought folly in Israel in lying with Jacob's daughter; which thing ought not to be done.

01\_GEN\_34\_08 And Hamor communed with them, saying, The soul of my son Shechem longeth for your daughter: I pray you give her him to wife.

01\_GEN\_34\_09 And make ye marriages with us, [and] give your daughters unto us, and take our daughters unto you.

01\_GEN\_34\_10 And ye shall dwell with us: and the land shall be before you; dwell and trade ye therein, and get you possessions therein.

01\_GEN\_34\_11 And Shechem said unto her father and unto her brethren, Let me find grace in your eyes, and what ye shall say unto me I will give.

01\_GEN\_34\_12 Ask me never so much dowry and gift, and I will give according as ye shall say unto me: but give me the damsel to wife.

01\_GEN\_34\_13 And the sons of Jacob answered Shechem and Hamor his father deceitfully, and said, because he had defiled Dinah their sister:

01\_GEN\_34\_14 And they said unto them, We cannot do this thing, to give our sister to one that is uncircumcised; for that [were] a reproach unto us:

01\_GEN\_34\_15 But in this will we consent unto you: If ye will be as we [be], that every male of you be circumcised;

01\_GEN\_34\_16 Then will we give our daughters unto you, and we will take your daughters to us, and we will dwell with you, and we will become one people.

01\_GEN\_34\_17 But if ye will not hearken unto us, to be circumcised; then will we take our daughter, and we will be gone.

01\_GEN\_34\_18 And their words pleased Hamor, and Shechem Hamor's son.

01\_GEN\_34\_19 And the young man deferred not to do the thing, because he had delight in Jacob's daughter: and he [was] more honourable than all the house of his father.

01\_GEN\_34\_20 And Hamor and Shechem his son came unto the gate of their city, and communed with the men of their city, saying,

01\_GEN\_34\_21 These men [are] peaceable with us; therefore let them dwell in the land, and trade therein; for the land, behold, [it is] large enough for them; let us take their daughters to us for wives, and let us give them our daughters.

01\_GEN\_34\_22 Only herein will the men consent unto us for to dwell with us, to be one people, if every male among us be circumcised, as they [are] circumcised.

01\_GEN\_34\_23 [Shall] not their cattle and their substance and every beast of theirs [be] ours? only let us consent unto them, and they will dwell with us.

01\_GEN\_34\_24 And unto Hamor and unto Shechem his son hearkened all that went out of the gate of his city; and every male was circumcised, all that went out of the gate of his city.

01\_GEN\_34\_25 And it came to pass on the third day, when they were sore, that two of the sons of Jacob, Simeon and Levi, Dinah's brethren, took each man his sword, and came upon the city boldly, and slew all the males.

01\_GEN\_34\_26 And they slew Hamor and Shechem his son with the edge of the sword, and took Dinah out of Shechem's house, and went out.

01\_GEN\_34\_27 The sons of Jacob came upon the slain, and spoiled the city, because they had defiled their sister.

01\_GEN\_34\_28 They took their sheep, and their oxen, and their asses, and that which [was] in the city, and that which [was] in the field,

01\_GEN\_34\_29 And all their wealth, and all their little ones, and their wives took they captive, and spoiled even all that [was] in the house.

01\_GEN\_34\_30 And Jacob said to Simeon and Levi, Ye have troubled me to make me to stink among the inhabitants of the land, among the Canaanites and the Perizzites: and I [being] few in number, they shall gather themselves together against me, and slay me; and I shall be destroyed, I and my house.

01\_GEN\_34\_31 And they said, Should he deal with our sister as with an harlot?
