

Book of Psalms Chapter 60

19_PSA_60_01 To the chief Musician upon Shushaneduth, Michtam of David, to teach; when he strove with Aramnaharaim and with Aramzobah, when Joab returned, and smote of Edom in the valley of salt twelve thousand. O God, thou hast cast us off, thou hast scattered us, thou hast been displeased; O turn thyself to us again.

19_PSA_60_02 Thou hast made the earth to tremble; thou hast broken it: heal the breaches thereof; for it shaketh.

19_PSA_60_03 Thou hast showed thy people hard things: thou hast made us to drink the wine of astonishment.

19_PSA_60_04 Thou hast given a banner to them that fear thee, that it may be displayed because of the truth. Selah.

19_PSA_60_05 That thy beloved may be delivered; save [with] thy right hand, and hear me.

19_PSA_60_06 God hath spoken in his holiness; I will rejoice, I will divide Shechem, and mete out the valley of Succoth.

19_PSA_60_07 Gilead [is] mine, and Manasseh [is] mine; Ephraim also [is] the strength of mine head; Judah [is] my lawgiver;

19_PSA_60_08 Moab [is] my washpot; over Edom will I cast out my shoe: Philistia, triumph thou because of me.

19_PSA_60_09 Who will bring me [into] the strong city? who will lead me into Edom?

19_PSA_60_10 [Wilt] not thou, O God, [which] hadst cast us off? and [thou], O God, [which] didst not go out with our armies?

19_PSA_60_11 Give us help from trouble: for vain [is] the help of man.

19_PSA_60_12 Through God we shall do valiantly: for he [it is that] shall tread down our enemies.
