

## **Complete KJV Holy Bible**

03\_LEV\_25\_01 And the LORD spake unto Moses in mount Sinai, saying,

03\_LEV\_25\_02 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye come into the land which I give you, then shall the land keep a sabbath unto the LORD.

03\_LEV\_25\_03 Six years thou shalt sow thy field, and six years thou shalt prune thy vineyard, and gather in the fruit thereof;

03\_LEV\_25\_04 But in the seventh year shall be a sabbath of rest unto the land, a sabbath for the LORD: thou shalt neither sow thy field, nor prune thy vineyard.

03\_LEV\_25\_05 That which groweth of its own accord of thy harvest thou shalt not reap, neither gather the grapes of thy vine undressed: [for] it is a year of rest unto the land.

03\_LEV\_25\_06 And the sabbath of the land shall be meat for you; for thee, and for thy servant, and for thy maid, and for thy hired servant, and for thy stranger that sojourneth with thee,

03\_LEV\_25\_07 And for thy cattle, and for the beast that [are] in thy land, shall all the increase thereof be meat.

03\_LEV\_25\_08 And thou shalt number seven sabbaths of years unto thee, seven times seven years; and the space of the seven sabbaths of years shall be unto thee forty and nine years.

03\_LEV\_25\_09 Then shalt thou cause the trumpet of the jubilee to sound on the tenth [day] of the seventh month, in the day of atonement shall ye make the trumpet sound throughout all your land.

03\_LEV\_25\_10 And ye shall hallow the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout [all] the land unto all the inhabitants thereof: it shall be a jubilee unto you; and ye shall return every man unto his possession, and ye shall return every man unto his family.

03\_LEV\_25\_11 A jubilee shall that fiftieth year be unto you: ye shall not sow, neither reap that which groweth of itself in it, nor gather [the grapes] in it of thy vine undressed.

03\_LEV\_25\_12 For it [is] the jubilee; it shall be holy unto you: ye shall eat the increase thereof out of the field.

03\_LEV\_25\_13 In the year of this jubilee ye shall return every man unto his possession.

03\_LEV\_25\_14 And if thou sell ought unto thy neighbour, or buyest [ought] of thy neighbour's hand, ye shall not oppress one another:

03\_LEV\_25\_15 According to the number of years after the jubilee thou shalt buy of thy neighbour, [and] according unto the number of years of the fruits he shall sell unto thee:

03\_LEV\_25\_16 According to the multitude of years thou shalt increase the price thereof, and according to the fewness of years thou shalt diminish the price of it: for [according] to the number [of the years] of the fruits doth he sell unto thee.

03\_LEV\_25\_17 Ye shall not therefore oppress one another; but thou shalt fear thy God: for I [am] the LORD your God.

03\_LEV\_25\_18 Wherefore ye shall do my statutes, and keep my judgments, and do them; and ye shall dwell in the land in safety.

03\_LEV\_25\_19 And the land shall yield her fruit, and ye shall eat your fill, and dwell therein in safety.

03\_LEV\_25\_20 And if ye shall say, What shall we eat the seventh year? behold, we shall not sow, nor gather in our increase:

03\_LEV\_25\_21 Then I will command my blessing upon you in the sixth year, and it shall bring forth fruit for three years.

03\_LEV\_25\_22 And ye shall sow the eighth year, and eat [yet] of old fruit until the ninth year; until her fruits come in ye shall eat [of] the old [store].

03\_LEV\_25\_23 The land shall not be sold for ever: for the land [is] mine; for ye [are] strangers and sojourners with me.

03\_LEV\_25\_24 And in all the land of your possession ye shall grant a redemption for the land.

03\_LEV\_25\_25 If thy brother be waxen poor, and hath sold away [some] of his possession, and if any of his kin come to redeem it, then shall he redeem that which his brother sold.

03\_LEV\_25\_26 And if the man have none to redeem it, and himself be able to redeem it;

03\_LEV\_25\_27 Then let him count the years of the sale thereof, and restore the overplus unto the man to whom he sold it; that he may return unto his possession.

03\_LEV\_25\_28 But if he be not able to restore [it] to him, then that which is sold shall remain in the hand of him that hath bought it until the year of jubilee: and in the jubilee it shall go out, and he shall return unto his possession.

03\_LEV\_25\_29 And if a man sell a dwelling house in a walled city, then he may redeem it within a whole year after it is sold; [within] a full year may he redeem it.

03\_LEV\_25\_30 And if it be not redeemed within the space of a full year, then the house that [is] in the walled city shall be established for ever to him that bought it throughout his generations: it shall not go out in the jubilee.

03\_LEV\_25\_31 But the houses of the villages which have no wall round about them shall be counted as the fields of

the country: they may be redeemed, and they shall go out in the jubilee.

03\_LEV\_25\_32 Notwithstanding the cities of the Levites, [and] the houses of the cities of their possession, may the Levites redeem at any time.

03\_LEV\_25\_33 And if a man purchase of the Levites, then the house that was sold, and the city of his possession, shall go out in [the year of] jubilee: for the houses of the cities of the Levites [are] their possession among the children of Israel.

03\_LEV\_25\_34 But the field of the suburbs of their cities may not be sold; for it [is] their perpetual possession.

03\_LEV\_25\_35 And if thy brother be waxen poor, and fallen in decay with thee; then thou shalt relieve him: [yea, though he be] a stranger, or a sojourner; that he may live with thee.

03\_LEV\_25\_36 Take thou no usury of him, or increase: but fear thy God; that thy brother may live with thee.

03\_LEV\_25\_37 Thou shalt not give him thy money upon usury, nor lend him thy victuals for increase.

03\_LEV\_25\_38 I [am] the LORD your God, which brought you forth out of the land of Egypt, to give you the land of Canaan, [and] to be your God.

03\_LEV\_25\_39 And if thy brother [that dwelleth] by thee be waxen poor, and be sold unto thee; thou shalt not compel him to serve as a bondservant:

03\_LEV\_25\_40 [But] as an hired servant, [and] as a sojourner, he shall be with thee, [and] shall serve thee unto the year of jubilee:

03\_LEV\_25\_41 And [then] shall he depart from thee, [both] he and his children with him, and shall return unto his own family, and unto the possession of his fathers shall he return.

03\_LEV\_25\_42 For they [are] my servants, which I brought forth out of the land of Egypt: they shall not be sold as bondmen.

03\_LEV\_25\_43 Thou shalt not rule over him with rigour; but shalt fear thy God.

03\_LEV\_25\_44 Both thy bondmen, and thy bondmaids, which thou shalt have, [shall be] of the heathen that are round about you; of them shall ye buy bondmen and bondmaids.

03\_LEV\_25\_45 Moreover of the children of the strangers that do sojourn among you, of them shall ye buy, and of their families that [are] with you, which they begat in your land: and they shall be your possession.

03\_LEV\_25\_46 And ye shall take them as an inheritance for your children after you, to inherit [them for] a possession; they shall be your bondmen for ever: but over your brethren the children of Israel, ye shall not rule one over another with rigour.

03\_LEV\_25\_47 And if a sojourner or stranger wax rich by thee, and thy brother [that dwelleth] by him wax poor, and sell himself unto the stranger [or] sojourner by thee, or to the stock of the stranger's family:

03\_LEV\_25\_48 After that he is sold he may be redeemed again; one of his brethren may redeem him:

03\_LEV\_25\_49 Either his uncle, or his uncle's son, may redeem him, or [any] that is nigh of kin unto him of his family may redeem him; or if he be able, he may redeem himself.

03\_LEV\_25\_50 And he shall reckon with him that bought him from the year that he was sold to him unto the year of jubilee: and the price of his sale shall be according unto the number of years, according to the time of an hired servant shall it be with him.

03\_LEV\_25\_51 If [there be] yet many years [behind], according unto them he shall give again the price of his redemption out of the money that he was bought for.

03\_LEV\_25\_52 And if there remain but few years unto the year of jubilee, then he shall count with him, [and] according unto his years shall he give him again the price of his redemption.

03\_LEV\_25\_53 [And] as a yearly hired servant shall he be with him: [and the other] shall not rule with rigour over him in thy sight.

03\_LEV\_25\_54 And if he be not redeemed in these [years], then he shall go out in the year of jubilee, [both] he, and his children with him.

03\_LEV\_25\_55 For unto me the children of Israel [are] servants; they [are] my servants whom I brought forth out of the land of Egypt: I [am] the LORD your God.
