

## **Complete KJV Holy Bible**

- 10\_2SA\_10\_01 And it came to pass after this, that the king of the children of Ammon died, and Hanun his son reigned in his stead.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_02 Then said David, I will show kindness unto Hanun the son of Nahash, as his father showed kindness unto me. And David sent to comfort him by the hand of his servants for his father. And David's servants came into the land of the children of Ammon.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_03 And the princes of the children of Ammon said unto Hanun their lord, Thinkest thou that David doth honour thy father, that he hath sent comforters unto thee? hath not David [rather] sent his servants unto thee, to search the city, and to spy it out, and to overthrow it?
- 10\_2SA\_10\_04 Wherefore Hanun took David's servants, and shaved off the one half of their beards, and cut off their garments in the middle, [even] to their buttocks, and sent them away.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_05 When they told [it] unto David, he sent to meet them, because the men were greatly ashamed: and the king said, Tarry at Jericho until your beards be grown, and [then] return.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_06 And when the children of Ammon saw that they stank before David, the children of Ammon sent and hired the Syrians of Bethrehob, and the Syrians of Zoba, twenty thousand footmen, and of king Maacah a thousand men, and of Ishtob twelve thousand men.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_07 And when David heard of [it], he sent Joab, and all the host of the mighty men.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_08 And the children of Ammon came out, and put the battle in array at the entering in of the gate: and the Syrians of Zoba, and of Rehob, and Ishtob, and Maacah, [were] by themselves in the field.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_09 When Joab saw that the front of the battle was against him before and behind, he chose of all the choice [men] of Israel, and put [them] in array against the Syrians:
- 10\_2SA\_10\_10 And the rest of the people he delivered into the hand of Abishai his brother, that he might put [them] in array against the children of Ammon.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_11 And he said, If the Syrians be too strong for me, then thou shalt help me: but if the children of Ammon be too strong for thee, then I will come and help thee.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_12 Be of good courage, and let us play the men for our people, and for the cities of our God: and the LORD do that which seemeth him good.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_13 And Joab drew nigh, and the people that [were] with him, unto the battle against the Syrians: and they fled before him.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_14 And when the children of Ammon saw that the Syrians were fled, then fled they also before Abishai, and entered into the city. So Joab returned from the children of Ammon, and came to Jerusalem.
- 10 2SA 10 15 And when the Syrians saw that they were smitten before Israel, they gathered themselves together.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_16 And Hadarezer sent, and brought out the Syrians that [were] beyond the river: and they came to Helam; and Shobach the captain of the host of Hadarezer [went] before them.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_17 And when it was told David, he gathered all Israel together, and passed over Jordan, and came to Helam. And the Syrians set themselves in array against David, and fought with him.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_18 And the Syrians fled before Israel; and David slew [the men of] seven hundred chariots of the Syrians, and forty thousand horsemen, and smote Shobach the captain of their host, who died there.
- 10\_2SA\_10\_19 And when all the kings [that were] servants to Hadarezer saw that they were smitten before Israel, they made peace with Israel, and served them. So the Syrians feared to help the children of Ammon any more.
