

Complete KJV Holy Bible

13 1CH 16 01 So they brought the ark of God, and set it in the midst of the tent that David had pitched for it: and they offered burnt sacrifices and peace offerings before God.

13 1CH 16 02 And when David had made an end of offering the burnt offerings and the peace offerings, he blessed the people in the name of the LORD.

13 1CH 16 03 And he dealt to every one of Israel, both man and woman, to every one a loaf of bread, and a good piece of flesh, and a flagon [of wine].

13 1CH 16 04 And he appointed [certain] of the Levites to minister before the ark of the LORD, and to record, and to thank and praise the LORD God of Israel:

13_1CH_16_05 Asaph the chief, and next to him Zechariah, Jeiel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehiel, and Mattithiah, and Eliab, and Benaiah, and Obededom: and Jeiel with psalteries and with harps; but Asaph made a sound with cymbals;

13 1CH 16 06 Benaiah also and Jahaziel the priests with trumpets continually before the ark of the covenant of God.

13 1CH 16 07 Then on that day David delivered first [this psalm] to thank the LORD into the hand of Asaph and his brethren.

13 1CH 16 08 Give thanks unto the LORD, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the people.

13 1CH 16 09 Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him, talk ye of all his wondrous works.

13 1CH 16 10 Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD.

13_1CH_16_11 Seek the LORD and his strength, seek his face continually.

13 1CH 16 12 Remember his marvellous works that he hath done, his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth;

13_1CH_16_13 O ye seed of Israel his servant, ye children of Jacob, his chosen ones.

13_1CH_16_14 He [is] the LORD our God; his judgments [are] in all the earth.

13 1CH 16 15 Be ye mindful always of his covenant; the word [which] he commanded to a thousand generations;

13 1CH 16 16 [Even of the covenant] which he made with Abraham, and of his oath unto Isaac;

13 1CH 16 17 And hath confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, [and] to Israel [for] an everlasting covenant,

13 1CH 16 18 Saying, Unto thee will I give the land of Canaan, the lot of your inheritance;

13 1CH 16 19 When ye were but few, even a few, and strangers in it.

13 1CH 16 20 And [when] they went from nation to nation, and from [one] kingdom to another people;

13 1CH 16 21 He suffered no man to do them wrong: yea, he reproved kings for their sakes,

13 1CH 16 22 [Saying], Touch not mine anointed, and do my prophets no harm.

13 1CH 16 23 Sing unto the LORD, all the earth; show forth from day to day his salvation.

13 1CH 16 24 Declare his glory among the heathen; his marvellous works among all nations.

13 1CH 16 25 For great [is] the LORD, and greatly to be praised: he also [is] to be feared above all gods.

13 1CH 16 26 For all the gods of the people [are] idols: but the LORD made the heavens.

13 1CH 16 27 Glory and honour [are] in his presence; strength and gladness [are] in his place.

13 1CH 16 28 Give unto the LORD, ye kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD glory and strength.

13 1CH 16 29 Give unto the LORD the glory [due] unto his name: bring an offering, and come before him: worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.

13 1CH 16 30 Fear before him, all the earth: the world also shall be stable, that it be not moved.

13 1CH 16 31 Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice: and let [men] say among the nations, The LORD reigneth.

13 1CH 16 32 Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof: let the fields rejoice, and all that [is] therein.

13 1CH 16 33 Then shall the trees of the wood sing out at the presence of the LORD, because he cometh to judge the earth.

13 1CH 16 34 O give thanks unto the LORD; for [he is] good; for his mercy [endureth] for ever.

13 1CH 16 35 And say ye, Save us, O God of our salvation, and gather us together, and deliver us from the heathen, that we may give thanks to thy holy name, [and] glory in thy praise.

13 1CH 16 36 Blessed [be] the LORD God of Israel for ever and ever. And all the people said, Amen, and praised the LORD.

13 1CH 16 37 So he left there before the ark of the covenant of the LORD Asaph and his brethren, to minister before the ark continually, as every day's work required:

13 1CH 16 38 And Obededom with their brethren, threescore and eight; Obededom also the son of Jeduthun and Hosah [to be] porters:

13 1CH 16 39 And Zadok the priest, and his brethren the priests, before the tabernacle of the LORD in the high place that [was] at Gibeon,

13 1CH 16 40 To offer burnt offerings unto the LORD upon the altar of the burnt offering continually morning and evening, and [to do] according to all that is written in the law of the LORD, which he commanded Israel;

13 1CH 16 41 And with them Heman and Jeduthun, and the rest that were chosen, who were expressed by name, to give thanks to the LORD, because his mercy [endureth] for ever;

13 1CH 16 42 And with them Heman and Jeduthun with trumpets and cymbals for those that should make a sound, and with musical instruments of God. And the sons of Jeduthun [were] porters.

13 1CH 16 43 And all the people departed every man to his house: and David returned to bless his house.
