

## **Complete KJV Holy Bible**

23 ISA 03 01 For, behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, doth take away from Jerusalem and from Judah the stay and the staff, the whole stay of bread, and the whole stay of water.

23 ISA 03 02 The mighty man, and the man of war, the judge, and the prophet, and the prudent, and the ancient,

23 ISA 03 03 The captain of fifty, and the honourable man, and the counsellor, and the cunning artificer, and the eloquent orator.

23 ISA 03 04 And I will give children [to be] their princes, and babes shall rule over them.

23 ISA 03 05 And the people shall be oppressed, every one by another, and every one by his neighbour: the child shall behave himself proudly against the ancient, and the base against the honourable.

23 ISA 03 06 When a man shall take hold of his brother of the house of his father, [saying], Thou hast clothing, be thou our ruler, and [let] this ruin [be] under thy hand:

23\_ISA\_03\_07 In that day shall he swear, saying, I will not be an healer; for in my house [is] neither bread nor clothing: make me not a ruler of the people.

23 ISA 03 08 For Jerusalem is ruined, and Judah is fallen: because their tongue and their doings [are] against the LORD, to provoke the eyes of his glory.

23 ISA 03 09 The show of their countenance doth witness against them; and they declare their sin as Sodom, they hide [it] not. Woe unto their soul! for they have rewarded evil unto themselves.

23 ISA 03 10 Say ye to the righteous, that [it shall be] well [with him]: for they shall eat the fruit of their doings.

23 ISA 03 11 Woe unto the wicked! [it shall be] ill [with him]: for the reward of his hands shall be given him.

23 ISA 03 12 [As for] my people, children [are] their oppressors, and women rule over them. O my people, they which lead thee cause [thee] to err, and destroy the way of thy paths.

23 ISA 03 13 The LORD standeth up to plead, and standeth to judge the people.

23 ISA 03 14 The LORD will enter into judgment with the ancients of his people, and the princes thereof: for ye have eaten up the vineyard; the spoil of the poor [is] in your houses.

23 ISA 03 15 What mean ye [that] ye beat my people to pieces, and grind the faces of the poor? saith the Lord GOD of hosts.

23 ISA 03 16 Moreover the LORD saith, Because the daughters of Zion are haughty, and walk with stretched forth necks and wanton eyes, walking and mincing [as] they go, and making a tinkling with their feet:

23 ISA 03 17 Therefore the Lord will smite with a scab the crown of the head of the daughters of Zion, and the LORD will discover their secret parts.

23\_ISA\_03\_18 In that day the Lord will take away the bravery of [their] tinkling ornaments [about their feet], and [their] cauls, and [their] round tires like the moon,

23 ISA 03 19 The chains, and the bracelets, and the mufflers,

23 ISA 03 20 The bonnets, and the ornaments of the legs, and the headbands, and the tablets, and the earrings,

23 ISA 03 21 The rings, and nose jewels,

23 ISA 03 22 The changeable suits of apparel, and the mantles, and the wimples, and the crisping pins,

23 ISA 03 23 The glasses, and the fine linen, and the hoods, and the veils.

23 ISA 03 24 And it shall come to pass, [that] instead of sweet smell there shall be stink; and instead of a girdle a rent; and instead of well set hair baldness; and instead of a stomacher a girding of sackcloth; [and] burning instead of beauty.

23 ISA 03 25 Thy men shall fall by the sword, and thy mighty in the war.

23 ISA 03 26 And her gates shall lament and mourn; and she [being] desolate shall sit upon the ground.
