- 28\_HOS\_06\_01 Come, and let us return unto the LORD: for he hath torn, and he will heal us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up.
- 28 HOS 06 02 After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight.
- 28\_HOS\_06\_03 Then shall we know, [if] we follow on to know the LORD: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter [and] former rain unto the earth.
