**32\_JON\_03\_01** And the word of the LORD came unto Jonah the second time, saying,

**32\_JON\_03\_02** Arise, go unto Nineveh, that great city, and preach unto it the preaching that I bid thee.

**32\_JON\_03\_03** So Jonah arose, and went unto Nineveh, according to the word of the LORD. Now Nineveh was an exceeding great city of three days' journey.

**32\_JON\_03\_04** And Jonah began to enter into the city a day's journey, and he cried, and said, Yet forty days, and Nineveh shall be overthrown.

**32\_JON\_03\_05** So the people of Nineveh believed God, and proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them even to the least of them.

**32\_JON\_03\_06** For word came unto the king of Nineveh, and he arose from his throne, and he laid his robe from him, and covered [him] with sackcloth, and sat in ashes.

**32\_JON\_03\_07** And he caused [it] to be proclaimed and published through Nineveh by the decree of the king and his nobles, saying, Let neither man nor beast, herd nor flock, taste any thing: let them not feed, nor drink water:

**32\_JON\_03\_08** But let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and cry mightily unto God: yea, let them turn every one from his evil way, and from the violence that [is] in their hands.

**32\_JON\_03\_09** Who can tell [if] God will turn and repent, and turn away from his fierce anger, that we perish not?

**32\_JON\_03\_10** And God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God repented of the evil, that he had said that he would do unto them; and he did [it] not.
