

Complete KJV Holy Bible

42 LUK 02 01 And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed.

42 LUK 02 02 [[And] this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.]

42 LUK 02 03 And all went to be taxed, every one into his own city.

42 LUK 02 04 And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; [because he was of the house and lineage of David:]

42 LUK 02 05 To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child.

42 LUK 02 06 And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered.

42 LUK 02 07 And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn.

42 LUK 02 08 And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night.

42 LUK 02 09 And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.

42 LUK 02 10 And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.

42 LUK 02 11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.

42 LUK 02 12 And this [shall be] a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.

42 LUK 02 13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying,

42 LUK 02 14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

42 LUK 02 15 And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds said one to another, Let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made known unto us.

42 LUK 02 16 And they came with haste, and found Mary, and Joseph, and the babe lying in a manger.

42 LUK 02 17 And when they had seen [it], they made known abroad the saying which was told them concerning this child.

42 LUK 02 18 And all they that heard [it] wondered at those things which were told them by the shepherds.

42 LUK 02 19 But Mary kept all these things, and pondered [them] in her heart.

42 LUK 02 20 And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them.

42 LUK 02 21 And when eight days were accomplished for the circumcising of the child, his name was called JESUS, which was so named of the angel before he was conceived in the womb.

42 LUK 02 22 And when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were accomplished, they brought him to Jerusalem, to present [him] to the Lord;

42 LUK 02 23 [As it is written in the law of the Lord, Every male that openeth the womb shall be called holy to the Lord;]

42 LUK 02 24 And to offer a sacrifice according to that which is said in the law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons.

42 LUK 02 25 And, behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name [was] Simeon; and the same man [was] just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him.

42 LUK 02 26 And it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ.

42 LUK 02 27 And he came by the Spirit into the temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law,

42 LUK 02 28 Then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said,

42 LUK 02 29 Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word:

42 LUK 02 30 For mine eyes have seen thy salvation,

42 LUK 02 31 Which thou hast prepared before the face of all people;

42 LUK 02 32 A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel.

42 LUK 02 33 And Joseph and his mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him.

42 LUK 02 34 And Simeon blessed them, and said unto Mary his mother, Behold, this [child] is set for the fall and rising again of many in Israel; and for a sign which shall be spoken against;

42 LUK 02 35 [Yea, a sword shall pierce through thy own soul also,] that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed.

42 LUK 02 36 And there was one Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Aser: she was of a great age, and had lived with an husband seven years from her virginity;

42_LUK_02_37 And she [was] a widow of about fourscore and four years, which departed not from the temple, but served [God] with fastings and prayers night and day.

42 LUK 02 38 And she coming in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of him to all them that looked for redemption in Jerusalem.

42_LUK_02_39 And when they had performed all things according to the law of the Lord, they returned into Galilee, to their own city Nazareth.

42 LUK 02 40 And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom: and the grace of God was upon him.

42 LUK 02 41 Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the passover.

42_LUK_02_42 And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the feast.

42_LUK_02_43 And when they had fulfilled the days, as they returned, the child Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem; and Joseph and his mother knew not [of it].

42 LUK 02 44 But they, supposing him to have been in the company, went a day's journey; and they sought him among [their] kinsfolk and acquaintance.

42_LUK_02_45 And when they found him not, they turned back again to Jerusalem, seeking him.

42 LUK 02 46 And it came to pass, that after three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions.

42 LUK 02 47 And all that heard him were astonished at his understanding and answers.

42 LUK 02 48 And when they saw him, they were amazed: and his mother said unto him, Son, why hast thou thus dealt with us? behold, thy father and I have sought thee sorrowing.

42 LUK 02 49 And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business?

42 LUK 02 50 And they understood not the saying which he spake unto them.

42 LUK 02 51 And he went down with them, and came to Nazareth, and was subject unto them: but his mother kept all these sayings in her heart.

42 LUK 02 52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.
