- 42_LUK_07_01 Now when he had ended all his sayings in the audience of the people, he entered into Capernaum.
- 42_LUK_07_02 And a certain centurion's servant, who was dear unto him, was sick, and ready to die.
- 42_LUK_07_03 And when he heard of Jesus, he sent unto him the elders of the Jews, beseeching him that he would come and heal his servant.
- 42_LUK_07_04 And when they came to Jesus, they be sought him instantly, saying, That he was worthy for whom he should do this:
- 42_LUK_07_05 For he loveth our nation, and he hath built us a synagogue.
- 42_LUK_07_06 Then Jesus went with them. And when he was now not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to him, saying unto him, Lord, trouble not thyself: for I am not worthy that thou shouldest enter under my roof:
- 42_LUK_07_07 Wherefore neither thought I myself worthy to come unto thee: but say in a word, and my servant shall be healed.
- 42_LUK_07_08 For I also am a man set under authority, having under me soldiers, and I say unto one, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth [it].
- 42_LUK_07_09 When Jesus heard these things, he marvelled at him, and turned him about, and said unto the people that followed him, I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.
- 42_LUK_07_10 And they that were sent, returning to the house, found the servant whole that had been sick.

42 LUK 07 11 And it came to pass the day after, that he went into a city called Nain; and many of his disciples went

- 42_LUK_07_17 And this rumour of him went forth throughout all Judaea, and throughout all the region round about.

42 LUK 07 18 And the disciples of John showed him of all these things.

- 42_LUK_07_19 And John calling [unto him] two of his disciples sent [them] to Jesus, saying, Art thou he that should come? or look we for another?
- 42_LUK_07_20 When the men were come unto him, they said, John Baptist hath sent us unto thee, saying, Art thou he that should come? or look we for another?
- 42_LUK_07_21 And in that same hour he cured many of [their] infirmities and plagues, and of evil spirits; and unto many [that were] blind he gave sight.
- 42_LUK_07_22 Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell John what things ye have seen and heard; how that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached.
- 42 LUK 07 24 And when the messengers of John were departed, he began to speak unto the people concerning

42 LUK 07 23 And blessed is [he], whosoever shall not be offended in me.

42_LUK_07_30 But the Pharisees and lawyers rejected the counsel of God against themselves, being not baptized of him.

42 LUK 07 33 For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine; and ye say, He hath a devil.

- 42_LUK_07_39 Now when the Pharisee which had bidden him saw [it], he spake within himself, saying, This man, if he were a prophet, would have known who and what manner of woman [this is] that toucheth him: for she is a sinner.
- 42_LUK_07_40 And Jesus answering said unto him, Simon, I have somewhat to say unto thee. And he saith, Master, say on.
- 42_LUK_07_41 There was a certain creditor which had two debtors: the one owed five hundred pence, and the other fifty.

42 LUK 07 43 Simon answered and said, I suppose that [he], to whom he forgave most. And he said unto him, Thou

42_LUK_07_42 And when they had nothing to pay, he frankly forgave them both. Tell me therefore, which of them

- 42_LUK_07_47 Wherefore I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, [the same] loveth little.
