

## **Complete KJV Holy Bible**

- 43 JOH 04 01 When therefore the Lord knew how the Pharisees had heard that Jesus made and baptized more disciples than John,
- 43\_JOH\_04\_02 [Though Jesus himself baptized not, but his disciples,]
- 43 JOH 04 03 He left Judaea, and departed again into Galilee.
- 43 JOH 04 04 And he must needs go through Samaria.
- 43 JOH 04 05 Then cometh he to a city of Samaria, which is called Sychar, near to the parcel of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph.
- 43 JOH 04 06 Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied with [his] journey, sat thus on the well: [and] it was about the sixth hour.
- 43 JOH 04 07 There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, Give me to drink.
- 43 JOH 04 08 [For his disciples were gone away unto the city to buy meat.]
- 43 JOH 04 09 Then saith the woman of Samaria unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans.
- 43 JOH 04 10 Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.
- 43 JOH 04 11 The woman saith unto him, Sir, thou hast nothing to draw with, and the well is deep: from whence then hast thou that living water?
- 43 JOH 04 12 Art thou greater than our father Jacob, which gave us the well, and drank thereof himself, and his children, and his cattle?
- 43\_JOH\_04\_13 Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:
- 43 JOH 04 14 But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.
- 43 JOH 04 15 The woman saith unto him, Sir, give me this water, that I thirst not, neither come hither to draw.
- 43\_JOH\_04\_16 Jesus saith unto her, Go, call thy husband, and come hither.
- 43 JOH 04 17 The woman answered and said, I have no husband. Jesus said unto her, Thou hast well said, I have no husband:
- 43 JOH 04 18 For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly.
- 43 JOH 04 19 The woman saith unto him, Sir, I perceive that thou art a prophet.
- 43 JOH 04 20 Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and ye say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship.
- 43 JOH 04 21 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father.
- 43 JOH 04 22 Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.
- 43 JOH 04 23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.
- 43 JOH 04 25 The woman saith unto him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he

43 JOH 04 24 God [is] a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship [him] in spirit and in truth.

- will tell us all things.
- 43 JOH 04 27 And upon this came his disciples, and marvelled that he talked with the woman: yet no man said,

43 JOH 04 26 Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am [he].

- What seekest thou? or, Why talkest thou with her?
- 43 JOH 04 29 Come, see a man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ?

43 JOH 04 28 The woman then left her waterpot, and went her way into the city, and saith to the men,

- 43 JOH 04 30 Then they went out of the city, and came unto him.
- 43 JOH 04 32 But he said unto them, I have meat to eat that ye know not of.

your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest.

43 JOH 04 33 Therefore said the disciples one to another, Hath any man brought him [ought] to eat?

43 JOH 04 31 In the mean while his disciples prayed him, saying, Master, eat.

43 JOH 04 35 Say not ye, There are yet four months, and [then] cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up

43 JOH 04 34 Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.

- 43 JOH 04 36 And he that reapeth receiveth wages, and gathereth fruit unto life eternal: that both he that soweth and he that reapeth may rejoice together.
- 43 JOH 04 38 I sent you to reap that whereon ye bestowed no labour: other men laboured, and ye are entered into

43 JOH 04 37 And herein is that saying true, One soweth, and another reapeth.

- their labours.
- 43 JOH 04 40 So when the Samaritans were come unto him, they be sought him that he would tarry with them: and he abode there two days.

43 JOH 04 39 And many of the Samaritans of that city believed on him for the saying of the woman, which testified,

- 43 JOH 04 41 And many more believed because of his own word;
- ourselves, and know that this is indeed the Christ, the Saviour of the world.

He told me all that ever I did.

43 JOH 04 43 Now after two days he departed thence, and went into Galilee.

43 JOH 04 42 And said unto the woman, Now we believe, not because of thy saying: for we have heard [him]

- 43\_JOH\_04\_45 Then when he was come into Galilee, the Galilaeans received him, having seen all the things that he
- did at Jerusalem at the feast: for they also went unto the feast. 43 JOH 04 46 So Jesus came again into Cana of Galilee, where he made the water wine. And there was a certain

43 JOH 04 44 For Jesus himself testified, that a prophet hath no honour in his own country.

- nobleman, whose son was sick at Capernaum.
- 43 JOH 04 47 When he heard that Jesus was come out of Judaea into Galilee, he went unto him, and besought him that he would come down, and heal his son: for he was at the point of death.
- 43 JOH 04 49 The nobleman saith unto him, Sir, come down ere my child die.

43 JOH 04 48 Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.

- 43 JOH 04 50 Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had
- spoken unto him, and he went his way.
- 43 JOH 04 51 And as he was now going down, his servants met him, and told [him], saying, Thy son liveth.
- 43 JOH 04 52 Then inquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him.
- 43 JOH 04 53 So the father knew that [it was] at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house.
- 43\_JOH\_04\_54 This [is] again the second miracle [that] Jesus did, when he was come out of Judaea into Galilee.
