

## **Complete KJV Holy Bible**

- 43 JOH 12 01 Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.
- 43 JOH 12 02 There they made him a supper; and Martha served: but Lazarus was one of them that sat at the table with him.
- 43 JOH 12 03 Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment.
- 43 JOH 12 04 Then saith one of his disciples, Judas Iscariot, Simon's [son], which should be tray him,
- 43 JOH 12 05 Why was not this ointment sold for three hundred pence, and given to the poor?
- 43 JOH 12 06 This he said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein.
- 43 JOH 12 07 Then said Jesus, Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this.
- 43 JOH 12 08 For the poor always ye have with you; but me ye have not always.
- 43 JOH 12 09 Much people of the Jews therefore knew that he was there: and they came not for Jesus' sake only, but that they might see Lazarus also, whom he had raised from the dead.
- 43 JOH 12 10 But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death;
- 43 JOH 12 11 Because that by reason of him many of the Jews went away, and believed on Jesus.
- 43 JOH 12 12 On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,
- 43 JOH 12 13 Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed [is] the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord.
- 43 JOH 12 14 And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written,
- 43 JOH 12 15 Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt.
- 43 JOH 12 16 These things understood not his disciples at the first: but when Jesus was glorified, then remembered they that these things were written of him, and [that] they had done these things unto him.
- 43 JOH 12 17 The people therefore that was with him when he called Lazarus out of his grave, and raised him from the dead, bare record.
- 43 JOH 12 18 For this cause the people also met him, for that they heard that he had done this miracle.
- 43 JOH 12 19 The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, Perceive ye how ye prevail nothing? behold, the world is gone after him.
- 43 JOH 12 20 And there were certain Greeks among them that came up to worship at the feast:
- 43 JOH 12 21 The same came therefore to Philip, which was of Bethsaida of Galilee, and desired him, saying, Sir, we would see Jesus.
- 43 JOH 12 22 Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus.
- 43 JOH 12 23 And Jesus answered them, saying, The hour is come, that the Son of man should be glorified.
- 43 JOH 12 24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

43 JOH 12 25 He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life

- 43 JOH 12 26 If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will [my] Father honour.

- 43 JOH 12 38 That the saying of Esaias the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spake, Lord, who hath believed our
- report? and to whom hath the arm of the Lord been revealed?
- 43 JOH 12 40 He hath blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with [their] eyes, nor

43 JOH 12 39 Therefore they could not believe, because that Esaias said again,

- understand with [their] heart, and be converted, and I should heal them.

43 JOH 12 41 These things said Esaias, when he saw his glory, and spake of him.

- 43 JOH 12 42 Nevertheless among the chief rulers also many believed on him; but because of the Pharisees they did not confess [him], lest they should be put out of the synagogue:
- 43 JOH 12 43 For they loved the praise of men more than the praise of God.
- 43 JOH 12 44 Jesus cried and said, He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me.
- 43 JOH 12 45 And he that seeth me seeth him that sent me.
