

Complete KJV Holy Bible

- 43_JOH_19_01 Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged [him].
- 43 JOH 19 02 And the soldiers platted a crown of thorns, and put [it] on his head, and they put on him a purple robe,
- 43_JOH_19_03 And said, Hail, King of the Jews! and they smote him with their hands.
- 43_JOH_19_04 Pilate therefore went forth again, and saith unto them, Behold, I bring him forth to you, that ye may know that I find no fault in him.
- 43_JOH_19_05 Then came Jesus forth, wearing the crown of thorns, and the purple robe. And [Pilate] saith unto them, Behold the man!
- 43_JOH_19_06 When the chief priests therefore and officers saw him, they cried out, saying, Crucify [him], crucify [him]. Pilate saith unto them, Take ye him, and crucify [him]: for I find no fault in him.
- 43_JOH_19_07 The Jews answered him, We have a law, and by our law he ought to die, because he made himself the Son of God.
- 43_JOH_19_08 When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he was the more afraid;
- 43_JOH_19_09 And went again into the judgment hall, and saith unto Jesus, Whence art thou? But Jesus gave him no answer.
- 43_JOH_19_10 Then saith Pilate unto him, Speakest thou not unto me? knowest thou not that I have power to crucify thee, and have power to release thee?
- 43_JOH_19_11 Jesus answered, Thou couldest have no power [at all] against me, except it were given thee from above: therefore he that delivered me unto thee hath the greater sin.
- 43_JOH_19_12 And from thenceforth Pilate sought to release him: but the Jews cried out, saying, If thou let this man go, thou art not Caesar's friend: whosoever maketh himself a king speaketh against Caesar.

43 JOH 19 13 When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he brought Jesus forth, and sat down in the judgment seat in

- a place that is called the Pavement, but in the Hebrew, Gabbatha.

 43 JOH 19 14 And it was the preparation of the passover, and about the sixth hour: and he saith unto the Jews,
- Behold your King!
- 43_JOH_19_15 But they cried out, Away with [him], away with [him], crucify him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your King? The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar.
- 43_JOH_19_17 And he bearing his cross went forth into a place called [the place] of a skull, which is called in the Hebrew Golgotha:

43 JOH 19 16 Then delivered he him therefore unto them to be crucified. And they took Jesus, and led [him] away.

- 43_JOH_19_18 Where they crucified him, and two others with him, on either side one, and Jesus in the midst.
- 43_JOH_19_19 And Pilate wrote a title, and put [it] on the cross. And the writing was, JESUS OF NAZARETH THE KING OF THE JEWS.
- 43_JOH_19_20 This title then read many of the Jews: for the place where Jesus was crucified was night o the city: and it was written in Hebrew, [and] Greek, [and] Latin.
- 43_JOH_19_21 Then said the chief priests of the Jews to Pilate, Write not, The King of the Jews; but that he said, I am King of the Jews.
- 43_JOH_19_22 Pilate answered, What I have written I have written.

43 JOH 19 23 Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took his garments, and made four parts, to every

- 43_JOH_19_24 They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the scripture might be fulfilled, which saith, They parted my raiment among them, and for my vesture they did cast lots. These things therefore the soldiers did.

43 JOH 19 25 Now there stood by the cross of Jesus his mother, and his mother's sister, Mary the [wife] of

43 JOH 19 27 Then saith he to the disciple, Behold thy mother! And from that hour that disciple took her unto his

- 43_JOH_19_28 After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, I thirst.
- 43_JOH_19_29 Now there was set a vessel full of vinegar: and they filled a sponge with vinegar, and put [it] upon hyssop, and put [it] to his mouth.
- 43_JOH_19_30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.
- 43_JOH_19_31 The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the sabbath day, [for that sabbath day was an high day,] besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and [that] they might be taken away.
- 43 JOH 19 32 Then came the soldiers, and brake the legs of the first, and of the other which was crucified with him.
- 43_JOH_19_33 But when they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs:
- 43_JOH_19_34 But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water.

43 JOH 19 35 And he that saw [it] bare record, and his record is true: and he knoweth that he saith true, that ye

- 43_JOH_19_36 For these things were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled, A bone of him shall not be broken.
- 43 JOH 19 38 And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews,

- 43_JOH_19_40 Then took they the body of Jesus, and wound it in linen clothes with the spices, as the manner of the Jews is to bury.
- 43_JOH_19_41 Now in the place where he was crucified there was a garden; and in the garden a new sepulchre, wherein was never man yet laid.
- 43_JOH_19_42 There laid they Jesus therefore because of the Jews' preparation [day]; for the sepulchre was nigh at
