

## **Complete KJV Holy Bible**

- 45\_ROM\_02\_01 Therefore thou art inexcusable, O man, whosoever thou art that judgest: for wherein thou judgest another, thou condemnest thyself; for thou that judgest doest the same things.
- 45\_ROM\_02\_02 But we are sure that the judgment of God is according to truth against them which commit such things.
- 45\_ROM\_02\_03 And thinkest thou this, O man, that judgest them which do such things, and doest the same, that thou shalt escape the judgment of God?
- 45\_ROM\_02\_04 Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance?
- 45\_ROM\_02\_05 But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God;
- 45\_ROM\_02\_06 Who will render to every man according to his deeds:
- 45\_ROM\_02\_07 To them who by patient continuance in well doing seek for glory and honour and immortality, eternal life:
- 45\_ROM\_02\_08 But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath,
- 45\_ROM\_02\_09 Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile;
- 45\_ROM\_02\_10 But glory, honour, and peace, to every man that worketh good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile:
- 45\_ROM\_02\_11 For there is no respect of persons with God.
- 45\_ROM\_02\_12 For as many as have sinned without law shall also perish without law: and as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law;
- 45\_ROM\_02\_13 [For not the hearers of the law [are] just before God, but the doers of the law shall be justified.
- 45\_ROM\_02\_14 For when the Gentiles, which have not the law, do by nature the things contained in the law, these, having not the law, are a law unto themselves:
- 45\_ROM\_02\_15 Which show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and [their] thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;]
- 45\_ROM\_02\_16 In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.
- 45 ROM 02 17 Behold, thou art called a Jew, and restest in the law, and makest thy boast of God,
- 45\_ROM\_02\_18 And knowest [his] will, and approvest the things that are more excellent, being instructed out of the law;
- 45 ROM 02 19 And art confident that thou thyself art a guide of the blind, a light of them which are in darkness,
- 45\_ROM\_02\_20 An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which hast the form of knowledge and of the truth in the law.
- 45\_ROM\_02\_21 Thou therefore which teachest another, teachest thou not thyself? thou that preachest a man should not steal, dost thou steal?
- 45\_ROM\_02\_22 Thou that sayest a man should not commit adultery, dost thou commit adultery? thou that abhorrest idols, dost thou commit sacrilege?
- 45\_ROM\_02\_23 Thou that makest thy boast of the law, through breaking the law dishonourest thou God?
- 45\_ROM\_02\_24 For the name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is written.
- 45\_ROM\_02\_25 For circumcision verily profiteth, if thou keep the law: but if thou be a breaker of the law, thy circumcision is made uncircumcision.
- 45\_ROM\_02\_26 Therefore if the uncircumcision keep the righteousness of the law, shall not his uncircumcision be counted for circumcision?
- 45\_ROM\_02\_27 And shall not uncircumcision which is by nature, if it fulfil the law, judge thee, who by the letter and circumcision dost transgress the law?
- 45\_ROM\_02\_28 For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither [is that] circumcision, which is outward in the flesh:
- 45\_ROM\_02\_29 But he [is] a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision [is that] of the heart, in the spirit, [and] not in the letter; whose praise [is] not of men, but of God.
