

Complete KJV Holy Bible

51_COL_02_01 For I would that ye knew what great conflict I have for you, and [for] them at Laodicea, and [for] as many as have not seen my face in the flesh;

51 COL 02 02 That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgment of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;

51 COL 02 03 In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

51 COL 02 04 And this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words.

51 COL 02 05 For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ.

51 COL 02 06 As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, [so] walk ye in him:

51_COL_02_07 Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving.

51 COL 02 08 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.

51 COL 02 09 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

51 COL 02 10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

51 COL 02 11 In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:

51 COL 02 12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with [him] through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

51 COL 02 13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;

51 COL 02 14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

51 COL 02 15 [And] having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

51 COL 02 16 Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath [days]:

51 COL 02 17 Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body [is] of Christ.

51 COL 02 18 Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshipping of angels, intruding into those things which he hath not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind,

51 COL 02 19 And not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increase th with the increase of God.

51 COL 02 20 Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances,

51 COL 02 21 [Touch not; taste not; handle not;

51 COL 02 22 Which all are to perish with the using;] after the commandments and doctrines of men?

51 COL 02 23 Which things have indeed a show of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honour to the satisfying of the flesh.
