51\_COL\_04\_01 Masters, give unto [your] servants that which is just and equal; knowing that ye also have a Master in heaven.

51\_COL\_04\_02 Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving;

51\_COL\_04\_03 Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in bonds:

51\_COL\_04\_04 That I may make it manifest, as I ought to speak.

51\_COL\_04\_05 Walk in wisdom toward them that are without, redeeming the time.

51\_COL\_04\_06 Let your speech [be] alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.

51\_COL\_04\_07 All my state shall Tychicus declare unto you, [who is] a beloved brother, and a faithful minister and fellowservant in the Lord:

51\_COL\_04\_08 Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that he might know your estate, and comfort your hearts;

51\_COL\_04\_09 With Onesimus, a faithful and beloved brother, who is [one] of you. They shall make known unto you all things which [are done] here.

51\_COL\_04\_10 Aristarchus my fellowprisoner saluteth you, and Marcus, sister's son to Barnabas, [touching whom ye received commandments: if he come unto you, receive him;]

51\_COL\_04\_11 And Jesus, which is called Justus, who are of the circumcision. These only [are my] fellowworkers unto the kingdom of God, which have been a comfort unto me.

51\_COL\_04\_12 Epaphras, who is [one] of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you, always labouring fervently for you in prayers, that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God.

51\_COL\_04\_13 For I bear him record, that he hath a great zeal for you, and them [that are] in Laodicea and them in Hierapolis.

51\_COL\_04\_14 Luke, the beloved physician, and Demas, greet you.

51\_COL\_04\_15 Salute the brethren which are in Laodicea, and Nymphas, and the church which is in his house.

51\_COL\_04\_16 And when this epistle is read among you, cause that it be read also in the church of the Laodiceans; and that ye likewise read the [epistle] from Laodicea.

51\_COL\_04\_17 And say to Archippus, Take heed to the ministry which thou hast received in the Lord, that thou fulfil it.

51\_COL\_04\_18 The salutation by the hand of me Paul. Remember my bonds. Grace [be] with you. Amen.
