

## **Complete KJV Holy Bible**

60\_1PE\_03\_01 Likewise, ye wives, [be] in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives;

60\_1PE\_03\_02 While they behold your chaste conversation [coupled] with fear.

60\_1PE\_03\_03 Whose adorning let it not be that outward [adorning] of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel;

60\_1PE\_03\_04 But [let it be] the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, [even the ornament] of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.

60\_1PE\_03\_05 For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands:

60\_1PE\_03\_06 Even as Sara obeyed Abraham, calling him lord: whose daughters ye are, as long as ye do well, and are not afraid with any amazement.

60\_1PE\_03\_07 Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with [them] according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

60\_1PE\_03\_08 Finally, [be ye] all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, [be] pitiful, [be] courteous:

60\_1PE\_03\_09 Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing.

60\_1PE\_03\_10 For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile:

60\_1PE\_03\_11 Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it.

60\_1PE\_03\_12 For the eyes of the Lord [are] over the righteous, and his ears [are open] unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord [is] against them that do evil.

60\_1PE\_03\_13 And who [is] he that will harm you, if ye be followers of that which is good?

60\_1PE\_03\_14 But and if ye suffer for righteousness' sake, happy [are ye]: and be not afraid of their terror, neither be troubled;

60\_1PE\_03\_15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and [be] ready always to [give] an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:

60\_1PE\_03\_16 Having a good conscience; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, they may be ashamed that falsely accuse your good conversation in Christ.

60\_1PE\_03\_17 For [it is] better, if the will of God be so, that ye suffer for well doing, than for evil doing.

60\_1PE\_03\_18 For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:

60\_1PE\_03\_19 By which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison;

60\_1PE\_03\_20 Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.

60\_1PE\_03\_21 The like figure whereunto [even] baptism doth also now save us [not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,] by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

60\_1PE\_03\_22 Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.
