## Page 1 Book of Exodus Chapter 01

- 02\_EXO\_01\_01 Now these [are] the names of the children of Israel, which came into Egypt; every man and his household came with Jacob.
- 02\_EXO\_01\_02 Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah,
- 02\_EXO\_01\_03 Issachar, Zebulun, and Benjamin,
- 02\_EXO\_01\_04 Dan, and Naphtali, Gad, and Asher.
- 02\_EXO\_01\_05 And all the souls that came out of the loins of Jacob were seventy souls: for Joseph was in Egypt [already].
- 02\_EXO\_01\_06 And Joseph died, and all his brethren, and all that generation.
- 02\_EXO\_01\_07 And the children of Israel were fruitful, and increased abundantly, and multiplied, and waxed exceeding mighty; and the land was filled with them.
- $02\_EXO\_01\_08$  Now there arose up a new king over Egypt, which knew not Joseph.
- $02\_EXO\_01\_09 \ And \ he \ said \ unto \ his \ people, \ Behold, \ the \ people \ of \ the \ children \ of \ Israel \ [are] \ more \ and \ mightier \ than \ we:$
- 02\_EXO\_01\_10 Come on, let us deal wisely with them; lest they multiply, and it come to pass, that, when there falleth out any war, they join also unto our enemies, and fight against us, and [so] get them up out of the land.
- 02\_EXO\_01\_11 Therefore they did set over them taskmasters to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses.
- 02\_EXO\_01\_12 But the more they afflicted them, the more they multiplied and grew. And they were grieved because of the children of Israel.
- $02\_EXO\_01\_13$  And the Egyptians made the children of Israel to serve with rigour:
- 02\_EXO\_01\_14 And they made their lives bitter with hard bondage, in mortar, and in brick, and in all manner of service in the field: all their service, wherein they made them serve, [was] with rigour.
- 02\_EXO\_01\_15 And the king of Egypt spake to the Hebrew midwives, of which the name of the one [was] Shiphrah, and the name of the other Puah:
- 02\_EXO\_01\_16 And he said, When ye do the office of a midwife to the Hebrew women, and see [them] upon the stools; if it [be] a son, then ye shall kill him: but if it [be] a daughter, then she shall live.
- 02\_EXO\_01\_17 But the midwives feared God, and did not as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the men children alive.
- 02\_EXO\_01\_18 And the king of Egypt called for the midwives, and said unto them, Why have ye done this thing, and have saved the men children alive?
- 02\_EXO\_01\_19 And the midwives said unto Pharaoh, Because the Hebrew women [are] not as the Egyptian women; for they [are] lively, and are delivered ere the midwives come in unto them.
- $02\_EXO\_01\_20$  Therefore God dealt well with the midwives: and the people multiplied, and waxed very mighty.
- 02\_EXO\_01\_21 And it came to pass, because the midwives feared God, that he made them houses.
- 02\_EXO\_01\_22 And Pharaoh charged all his people, saying, Every son that is born ye shall cast into the river, and every daughter ye shall save alive.
