Book of Exodus Chapter 20

02\_EXO\_20\_01 And God spake all these words, saying,

02\_EXO\_20\_02 I [am] the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

02\_EXO\_20\_03 Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

02\_EXO\_20\_04 Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness [of any thing] that [is] in heaven above, or that [is] in the earth beneath, or that [is] in the water under the earth:

02\_EXO\_20\_05 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God [am] a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth [generation] of them that hate me;

02\_EXO\_20\_06 And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

02\_EXO\_20\_07 Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

02\_EXO\_20\_08 Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.

02\_EXO\_20\_09 Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work:

02\_EXO\_20\_10 But the seventh day [is] the sabbath of the LORD thy God: [in it] thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that [is] within thy gates:

02\_EXO\_20\_11 For [in] six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them [is], and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

02\_EXO\_20\_12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

02\_EXO\_20\_13 Thou shalt not kill.

02\_EXO\_20\_14 Thou shalt not commit adultery.

02\_EXO\_20\_15 Thou shalt not steal.

02\_EXO\_20\_16 Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

02\_EXO\_20\_17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that [is] thy neighbour's.

02\_EXO\_20\_18 And all the people saw the thunderings, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw [it], they removed, and stood afar off.

02\_EXO\_20\_19 And they said unto Moses, Speak thou with us, and we will hear: but let not God speak with us, lest we die.

02\_EXO\_20\_20 And Moses said unto the people, Fear not: for God is come to prove you, and that his fear may be before your faces, that ye sin not.

02\_EXO\_20\_21 And the people stood afar off, and Moses drew near unto the thick darkness where God [was].

02\_EXO\_20\_22 And the LORD said unto Moses, Thus thou shalt say unto the children of Israel, Ye have seen that I have talked with you from heaven.

02\_EXO\_20\_23 Ye shall not make with me gods of silver, neither shall ye make unto you gods of gold.

02\_EXO\_20\_24 An altar of earth thou shalt make unto me, and shalt sacrifice thereon thy burnt offerings, and thy peace offerings, thy sheep, and thine oxen: in all places where I record my name I will come unto thee, and I will bless thee.

02\_EXO\_20\_25 And if thou wilt make me an altar of stone, thou shalt not build it of hewn stone: for if thou lift up thy tool upon it, thou hast polluted it.

02\_EXO\_20\_26 Neither shalt thou go up by steps unto mine altar, that thy nakedness be not discovered thereon.
